

As his Eagle Scout Project Spencer, along with the help of his fellow scouts from BSA Troop 145 of Clark Township, enhanced the outdoor classroom at the Early Learning Center at the Westfield YMCA, providing more enriching activities for the children.

Spencer and his team transformed the space by painting a tricycle trail on the macadam, creating a basketball court, building music boards, installing a chalk wall, and a magnet wall. This project not only improves the area but also provides children with opportunities to develop their fine motor skills, improve color and letter recognition, boost their imagination and creativity. Additionally, it advances hand-eye coordination, physical strength, and teamwork, ensuring a well-rounded experience for all the kids who will benefit from this engaging outdoor classroom. These skills will help young children grow with confidence.

As a former preschooler at the Westfield YMCA, Spencer viewed this as his way of giving back to the organization that helped shape the early years of his life.

Eagle Scout is the highest achievement or rank attainable in the Scouts BSA program of the Boy Scouts of America. Since its inception in 1911, only four percent of Scouts have earned this rank after a lengthy review process. Reaching Eagle Scout Rank entails years of dedication, including earning a minimum of 21 merit badges, and the completion of a community project that demonstrates leadership, careful planning, and hard work.



## EARTH DAY RAHWAY RIVER CLEAN-UP – SATURDAY, APRIL 26

#### **Rahway River Association**

All volunteers are invited to celebrate Earth Day 2025 with a clean-up of the Rahway River within Union County Parks and Recreation's Rahway River Park on Saturday, April 26th (with a rain date of Sunday, April 27th).

Please join the Rahway River Watershed Association, Boy Scouts, Cub Scouts, local officials and environmental commissions, fisherman and other stakeholders in this annual event. The clean-up will focus on areas upstream and downstream of the dam at Winfield Park, New Jersey in Cranford, Clark, Linden, and Rahway.

Please come by the parking area adjacent to the waterfall of the Rahway River by the Bloodgood Dam at Winfield Park at 8:45 a.m. to register, pick up bags, gloves, bottled water and snacks, and receive safety information. Teams will be encouraged to travel to any part of the river within the park where they would like to perform cleanup activities. We specifically ask all folks to register and to work in small groups for safety purposes. Everyone under 18 must have their parent's signature on the attached Individual

Waiver form as well as adult supervision to areas with large volumes of floatable debris. participate.

Cleaning up a river and park area is a great way to celebrate Earth Day and if you haven't participated in an event like this before, you will find it invigorating, and you will feel good about what you have accomplished...it is also fun and educational...especially for Scouts and young adults as they always find something interesting. Over the 25+ years this cleanup has occurred thousands of folks have participated, and pulled some amazing things from the river improving its quality. The Rahway River watershed is a better place thanks to the commitment of so many great volunteers over the last quarter century!

The clean-up will generally be between 9-12, but any amount of time or effort that folks can volunteer is appreciated. There is always a large volume of floatable debris to pick up. The team working registration will provide suggestions on

All participants should wear jeans, longsleeved shirts, gloves and boots, Waders are welcome for folks who like to get a little wet. Each participant should bring a standard 5-gallon carry bucket with a handle (put your name on the bottom)... this makes for easy carrying of "stuff" for transfer to the large garbage bags. A mulching rake is also a great asset to have to enable reaching out and pulling debris into shore from the riverbank.

After the event there is an inventory of the debris removed, and within approximately 24 hours Union County Parks and Recreation removes and disposes of all the trash.

exceeds the cost will be used for the future maintenance and upkeep of all our military memorials and monuments in Clark, as well as to support other initiatives that honor our veterans.







## **FESTIVAL CELEBRATES THE BEST IN SHORT FILM**

The fifth annual Cranford Film Festival will showcase selected short films from rising and established filmmakers at the Cranford Theater on Saturday, April 26. Filmmakers and enthusiasts alike are invited to participate in an evening celebrating the best and most creative voices in short film.

The festival champions diverse voices and innovative storytelling by curating a selection of films that span genres from filmmakers across the globe. This year, the festival received nearly 100 submissions across categories including fiction, documentary, animation, iPhone, music videos and student films. "Best of Festival Awards," "Cranford Cougar Awards," and "Laurels" will be given in each of the six categories.

"As we celebrate the fifth anniversary of our film festival, I'm filled with gratitude and excitement for the incredible filmmakers, passionate audiences, and dedicated team that have made this journey possible," said Stephanie Levine, festival director and Cranford Schools Friends of the Performing Arts president. "This milestone is not just a reflection of our past achievements but a testament to our commitment to showcasing diverse voices and inspiring stories."

The festival screening will occur from 6-10 p.m. at the Cranford Theater, located at 25 North Ave W in Cranford. A pre-screening celebration will be hosted at Cranford's Yale Terrace Brewery for selected filmmakers and VIP ticket holders. A post-show Q&A session for audience members to ask questions of filmmakers about their films will take place after the screening. The full schedule of this year's films will be available online in April. Tickets are now available for purchase at the Cranford Film Festival website. They start at \$25 for the screening of the short film block. VIP tickets, which include admittance to the pre-party and a festival T-shirt, will cost \$45 for one and \$75 for two. The festival historically is a sellout event, so attendees are encouraged to purchase their tickets early.

The festival also offers an entirely virtual screening of selected short films for viewing online from April 27 to May 11. The virtual ticket also costs \$25.

The 4th annual Arts Day, a free companion event held in the afternoon before the film festival screening in downtown Cranford, will celebrate the performing and visual arts from within Cranford and beyond. It will feature performances from local groups, including Cranford High School's performing arts ensembles, at the Eastman Clock Plaza and student visual art on display in nearby downtown locations.

This year, the festival is expected to be sponsored by over 50 businesses, many of them local to the Cranford area, who have generously donated funds and products to support the festival. A full list of festival sponsors can be found on the website.

The proceeds generated by the film festival's ticket sales, donations and sponsorships support the non-profit organization Cranford Schools Friends of Performing Arts (FOPA). FOPA's purpose is to enhance the experience of the students participating in all performing arts programs in Cranford's school district. All funds raised benefit Cranford's performing arts students directly.
