As his Eagle Scout Project Spencer, along with the help of his fellow scouts from BSA Troop 145 of Clark Township, enhanced the outdoor classroom at the Early Learning Center at the Westfield YMCA, providing more enriching activities for the children.

Spencer and his team transformed the space by painting a tricycle trail on the macadam, creating a basketball court, building music boards, installing a chalk wall, and a magnet wall. This project not only improves the area but also provides children with opportunities to develop their fine motor skills, improve color and letter recognition, boost their imagination and creativity. Additionally, it advances hand-eye coordination, physical strength, and

teamwork, ensuring a well-rounded experience for all the kids who will benefit from this engaging outdoor classroom. These skills will help young children grow with confidence.

As a former preschooler at the Westfield YMCA, Spencer viewed this as his way of giving back to the organization that helped shape the early years of his life.

Eagle Scout is the highest achievement or rank attainable in the Scouts BSA program of the Boy Scouts of America. Since its inception in 1911, only four percent of Scouts have earned this rank after a lengthy review process. Reaching Eagle Scout Rank entails years of dedication, including earning a minimum of 21 merit badges, and the completion of a community project that demonstrates leadership, careful planning, and hard work.

# EARTH DAY RAHWAY RIVER CLEAN-UP – SATURDAY, APRIL 26

## Rahway River Association

All volunteers are invited to celebrate Earth Day 2025 with a clean-up of the Rahway River within Union County Parks and Recreation's Rahway River Park on Saturday, April 26th (with a rain date of Sunday, April 27th).

Please join the Rahway River Watershed Association, Boy Scouts, Cub Scouts, local officials and environmental commissions, fisherman and other stakeholders in this annual event. The clean-up will focus on areas upstream and downstream of the dam at Winfield Park, New Jersey in Cranford, Clark, Linden, and Rahway.

Please come by the parking area adjacent to the waterfall of the Rahway River by the Bloodgood Dam at Winfield Park at 8:45 a.m. to register, pick up bags, gloves, bottled water and snacks, and receive safety information. Teams will be encouraged to travel to any part of the river within the park where they would like to perform cleanup activities. We specifically ask all folks to register and to work in small groups for safety purposes. Everyone under 18 must have their parent's signature on the attached Individual

Waiver form as well as adult supervision to participate.

Cleaning up a river and park area is a great way to celebrate Earth Day and if you haven't participated in an event like this before, you will find it invigorating, and you will feel good about what you have accomplished...it is also fun and educational...especially for Scouts and young adults as they always find something interesting. Over the 25+ years this cleanup has occurred thousands of folks have participated, and pulled some amazing things from the river improving its quality. The Rahway River watershed is a better place thanks to the commitment of so many great volunteers over the last quarter century!

The clean-up will generally be between 9-12, but any amount of time or effort that folks can volunteer is appreciated. There is always a large volume of floatable debris to pick up. The team working registration will provide suggestions on

areas with large volumes of floatable debris.

All participants should wear jeans, long-sleeved shirts, gloves and boots, Waders are welcome for folks who like to get a little wet. Each participant should bring a standard 5-gallon carry bucket with a handle (put your name on the bottom)... this makes for easy carrying of "stuff" for transfer to the large garbage bags. A mulching rake is also a great asset to have to enable reaching out and pulling debris into shore from the riverbank.

After the event there is an inventory of the debris removed, and within approximately 24 hours Union County Parks and Recreation removes and disposes of all the trash.

It has been brought to my attention by Mr. William Duffy that there are no monuments to memorialize five of our Fallen Heroes lost in other conflicts and no separate memorial honoring our four Vietnam Fallen Heroes. With your help we would like to commission the creation of several bronze plaques memorializing these heroes and have them affixed to the boulders surrounding the World War II monument.

I hope you will assist me in this endeavor by providing a donation. 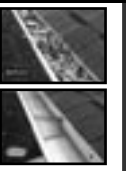

FESTIVAL CELEBRATES THE BEST IN SHORT FILM

The fifth annual Cranford Film Festival will showcase selected short films from rising and established filmmakers at the Cranford Theater on Saturday, April 26. Filmmakers and enthusiasts alike are invited to participate in an evening celebrating the best and most creative voices in short film.

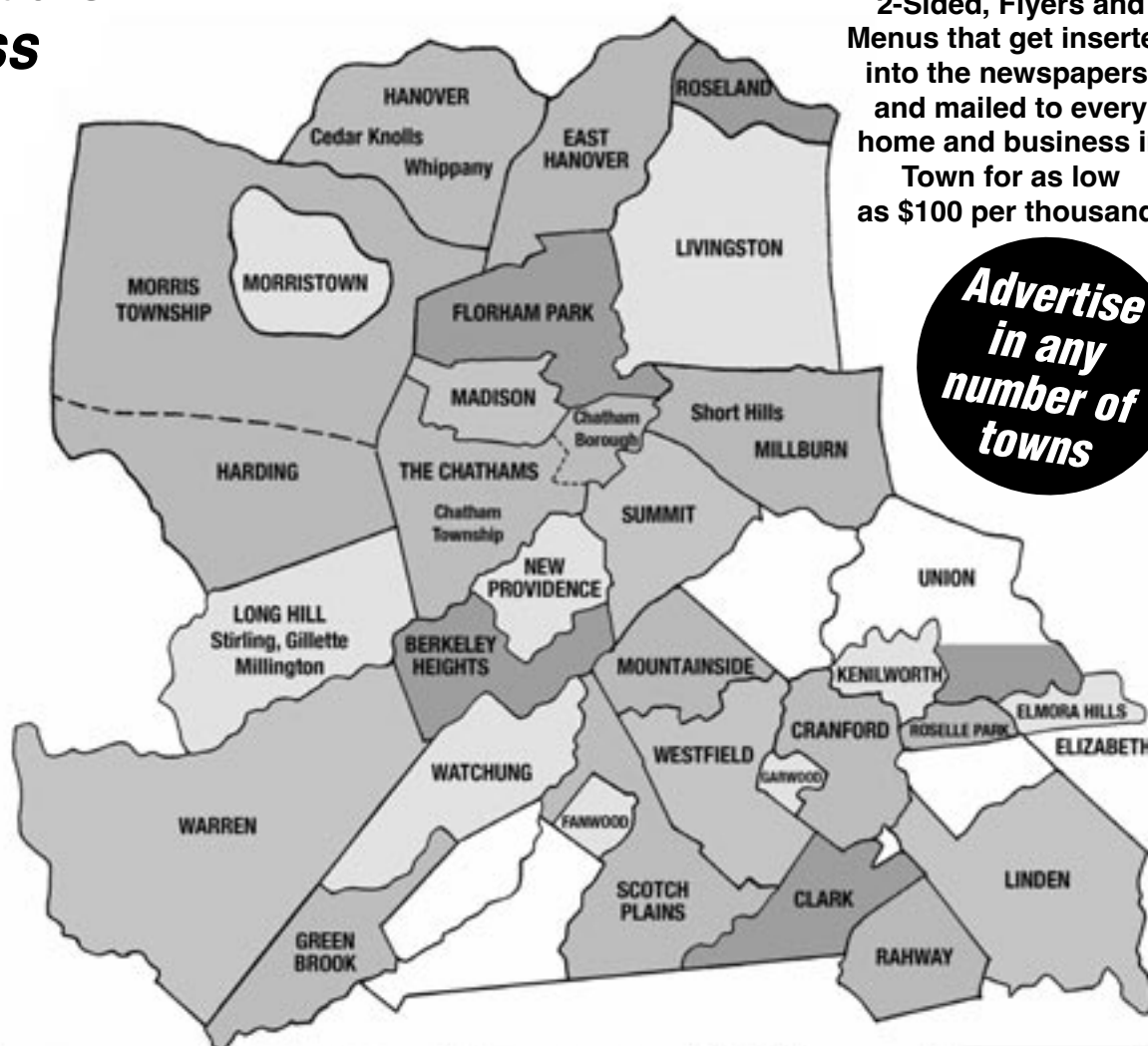
