### YMCA LAUNCHES FREE VETERANS INITIATIVE THIS SPRING

The Gateway Family YMCA

The Gateway Family YMCA is launching a Veterans Wellness Initiative, offered for the first time at the Wellness Center Branch in Union, NJ. Beginning this Spring, the free Veterans Wellness Initiative program will meet weekly for in-person exercise and wellness, led by a wellness coach, as well as virtually, online to discuss their health in mind, body and spirit.



The Cub Scouts started their trip by walking two boardwalk trails to bird blinds at the Wildlife Observation Center.In spite of some wind, the Cubs used binoculars to look for birds at the blind, and learned to identify several trees, bushes and other plants along their walk. They learned that you can make birch beer from black birch trees.

Pack 23's next stop in the Great Swamp was the Helen C. Fenske Visitor Center, where the Cubs saw exhibits about wildlife and habitat and visited the gift shop. The Scouts ate their lunch at a pavilion behind the Visitor Center.

Then Pack 23 drove to its final stop of the day – the Raptor Trust. Located on the southern border of the Great Swamp National Wildlife Refuge, the Raptor Trust is a private, volunteer-staffed hospital and rehabilitation center for injured and orphaned birds. The Cub Scouts strolled the grounds, where many hawks, owls, and even bald eagles are housed in enclosed pens.




### **ANNUAL YOUTH FISHING DERBY - APRIL 12**






