GBPD TIPS ON PREVENTING VEHICLE THEFTS AND HOME BURGLARIES

Green Brook Township Police Department

Vehicle thefts and residential burglaries are not unique to our township, as they are happening throughout the entire State of New Jersey. These incidents are crimes of opportunity. To help you protect your family and neighbors, we provide below some simple actions that you can take right away.

Most Importantly, Report Suspicious Activity Immediately! If you see a suspicious person or vehicle, contact the Police Department without delay at 732-968-1188 or dial 911 in the event of an emergency. Even if you think it might not be significant, it is better to report it to the police rather than just posting it on social media or a community page.

Below are additional actions that all residents can take to protect one another:

Make your home look occupied and difficult to break in by illuminate your home. Beginning at sunset, leave both interior and exterior lights on whether your home is occupied or not.

Secure your vehicle. Always remove key fobs and garage door openers from your vehicle. Lock the car doors. If possible, park your vehicle in the garage overnight.

Activate your alarms. Always set your home and vehicle alarms.

Do not leave vehicles running and unattended. Never leave a running vehicle unattended. Never leave valuable items, such as purses and wallets, inside the vehicle and visible from the outside.

Protect valuables. Do not keep large amounts of cash at home. Secure jewelry or other valuables.

Check your security cameras. Test and confirm that your security cameras are functional and properly positioned to monitor key areas.

Lock all doors and windows in your home, and keep garage doors closed and locked.

Install deadbolts on exterior doors. Place a secondary locking device on sliding glass doors, such as a door stop lock or a bar in the sliding track.

Remove all packages delivered to your home as soon as possible. Activate electronic delivery notifications so you know when packages arrive.

Remove garbage and recycling cans from the street soon after pickup.

Remove mail from your mailboxes daily.

Keep your cell phone nearby. Have your phone within reach, so you can quickly contact the police if needed.

Spread awareness. Share this information with friends, family, and neighbors.



These are the start dates - it does not mean that the branches and leaves will be picked up on this date or by this date. Please place your material at the curb by the date for your zone.

PLEASE KEEP YOUR LEAVES AND BRANCHES IN SEPARATE PILES.

MIXED PILES WILL NOT BE PICKED UP.

Please refrain from putting the piles in the street, which creates traffic concerns and also impacts street drainage by forcing water into the travel lanes and clogging catch basins. Please refrain from calling Town Hall to ask when your piles are going to be picked up. If you believe your pile has been missed, please e-mail dpw@greenbrooktwp.org. If you do not have email access, you may call 732-968-1023 x6602 and leave a message with your name and address. You will not receive a return call, but your info will be given to DPW.

- Pile leaves curbside for pick-up by the leaf vacuum – Do not place in street
- Place bagged leaves curbside

BELOVED UNCLE'S LIFE HONORED

Imagine, A Center for Coping with Loss

The Toriello Family honored the life of Matthew Toriello, who died in 2019, with the dedication of "Uncle Matt's Room" at Imagine, A Center for Coping with Loss. The room is home to grief support groups for 6-9-year-olds who experienced the loss of a parent, sibling, or other family member. Known as the "Orange Group" these children make up Imagine's largest group of participants and the group most likely to run a waitlist at the organization.

Uncle Matt's Room contains multiple spaces for therapeutic play designed to provide a safe place for the bereaved children to mourn their loss, develop healthy coping skills, and integrate the loss into their lives. As one young Imagine participant expressed, "At school, I didn't know anyone else whose dad died. But when I come to Imagine, other kids lost their dad too and it feels good to know I'm not alone."

Executive Director Lindsay Schambach said, "We're so grateful for the Toriello family's commitment to Imagine, first as Board members and volunteers and now through this incredible gift to our Imagine children. We are honored to host a space that recognizes the important role aunts and uncles play in the lives of young people and the incredible impact they can make both while living and after their passing. Thank you to the Toriello Family for their continued trust, belief and support for this mission."

Imagine's Nights of Support provide free yearround trauma-informed peer grief support for children ages 3-18 and young adults 18-30 who are coping with loss due to the death of a close family member. Support groups are also available for the parents and care givers of children in Imagine's groups. Last year, Imagine served over 600 individual participants on a bi-weekly basis who came from 85 towns across New Jersey. In January 2024, Imagine opened a second location at 570 Broad Street in Newark and is the only family bereavement center in the state that offers services in Spanish. Imagine is also called upon to respond to schools and workplaces when an unexpected or tragic death occurs, and the

community needs support. Imagine also worked Matthew's name and reminds us that while life is closely with Senator Bramnick and Senator Cryan to draft the Grief Awareness Bill (S3330) allowing schools to provide grief education to NJ students in grades 8-12. The bill was passed unanimously and signed into law by Governor William Murphy in January 2024.

Kristen Sonnek-Schmelz, Imagine Board member and sister of Matthew Toriello said, "As Mackelmore says in one of Matthew's favorite songs, Glorious, 'I heard you die twice, once when they bury you in the grave, And the second time is the last time that somebody mentions your name.' Uncle Matt's Room keeps us saying

different now, we can continue to change the world for the better in his honor."

Imagine, A Center for Coping with Loss is a 501c3 that offers grief and loss education and training to the community and free year-round grief support groups for children ages 3-18 and young adults 19-30 who are coping with a loss due to death. Concurrently, support groups are available for the parents and caregivers of the children in the groups and offered in English and Spanish.
