GARY MILLER NAMED CITIZEN OF THE YEAR BY ELKS LODGE

Lifelong Linden resident Gary Miller has been chosen as the 2025 Citizen of the Year by the Piscataway Elks Lodge No. 2414.

Miller was honored in a ceremony on Saturday, March 8, at the Woodbridge Elks Lodge along with 10 other winners from Central Jersey lodges. He was selected for his work as public information officer and webmaster for Piscataway Township Schools.

Miller formerly held a similar position as public information officer and communication coordinator for Linden Public Schools, and was a teacher at Linden High School.

"I'm incredibly honored to be selected as Citizen of the Year by the Piscataway Elks," Miller said. "This award is recognition of the tremendous role Piscataway Township Schools plays in our community. Our schools are a focal point for family involvement and support, and I treasure my role in celebrating and strengthening that bond."

Piscataway Elks Incoming Exalted Ruler Peter Namen said Miller was selected because of his award-winning work in promoting the successes of Piscataway Township Schools and in strengthening the school district's ties with the township and community groups, including the Elks.

"Gary has ingrained himself in our community as he works to engage families, celebrate students and staff, and elevate the profile of Piscataway schools in the eyes of educators and leaders statewide," Namen said during his introduction of Miller at the awards ceremony.

Piscataway's Assistant Superintendent of Schools Dr. Glenn Lottmann was on hand for the awards ceremony to show the district's support for Miller and the Elks.

Miller has won multiple awards over the past two years from the National School Public Relations Association and the New Jersey School Public Relations Association, including a National Award of Excellence as editor of the school district's annual School Guide & Calendar. Miller has also won state and national

awards for social media, newsletter, and photography.

Miller has written two articles for School Leader magazine, a staple on the desks of superintendents and school board members around the state. These pieces highlighted Piscataway's innovative educational programs, including efforts to ensure non-college-bound students get the attention and support they need to find success after graduation, and the district's successful Freshman Seminar program that eases the way for ninth-graders into Piscataway High School through team building and peer mentorships.

"Gary has been invaluable in spreading awareness of achievements by Piscataway Township Schools' students and staff, both within our community and statewide, and working with local groups for the betterment of our schools," said Piscataway Superintendent of Schools Dr. Frank Ranelli. "This is a very well-deserved honor."

Aside from his daily duties of keeping families informed and involved, Gary also sits on the Piscataway Board of Education's Culture, Climate & Community Relations Committee and is executive director of the Piscataway Education Foundation.

"Gary has worked with Piscataway Elks on promoting our annual backpack and school supplies drive and Halloween Trunk or Treat," Namen said, "and the Elks in turn have donated to support the efforts of the Piscataway Education Foundation to uplift students and teachers.

"We've developed a great partnership that benefits both sides – and the greater Piscataway community as a whole."

All volunteers are invited to celebrate Earth Day 2025 with a clean-up of the Rahway River within Union County Parks and Recreation's Rahway River Park on Saturday, April 26th (with a rain date of Sunday, April 27th).

Please join the Rahway River Watershed Association, Boy Scouts, Cub Scouts, local officials and environmental commissions, fisherman and other stakeholders in this annual event. The clean-up will focus on areas upstream and downstream of the dam at Winfield Park, New Jersey in Cranford, Clark, Linden, and Rahway.

Please come by the parking area adjacent to the waterfall of the Rahway River by the Bloodgood Dam at Winfield Park at 8:45 a.m. to register, pick up bags, gloves, bottled water and snacks, and receive safety information. Teams will be encouraged to travel to any part of the river within the park where they would like to perform cleanup activities. We specifically ask all folks to register and to work in small groups for safety purposes. Everyone under 18 must have adult

Cleaning up a river and park area is a great way to celebrate Earth Day and if you haven't participated in an event like this before, you will find it invigorating, and you will feel good about what you have accomplished...it is also fun and educational...especially for Scouts and young adults as they always find something interesting. Over the 25+ years this cleanup has occurred thousands of folks have participated, and pulled some amazing things from the river improving its quality. The Rahway River watershed is a better place thanks to the commitment of so many great debris removed, and within approximately 24 volunteers over the last quarter century!

The clean-up will generally be between 9-12, but any amount of time or effort that folks can volunteer is appreciated. There is always a large volume of floatable debris to pick up. The team working registration will provide suggestions on areas with large volumes of floatable debris.

All participants should wear jeans, longsleeved shirts, gloves and boots, Waders are welcome for folks who like to get a little wet. Each participant should bring a standard 5-gallon carry bucket with a handle (put your name on the bottom)... this makes for easy carrying of "stuff" for transfer to the large garbage bags. A mulching rake is also a great asset to have to enable reaching out and pulling debris into shore from the riverbank.

After the event there is an inventory of the hours Union County Parks and Recreation removes and disposes of all the trash.

was Sister Donna Marie O'Brien OP who was honored for her commitment to Catholic Education and shaping the minds of countless children from 1960-2015. Sr. Donna was past principal of St. John the Apostle School for 34 years, retiring in 2015.

Bishop Elias Lorenzo addressed the attendees at the Gala and wrote in the Commemorative Anniversary Book, "The Diamond Anniversary offers all in the parish the opportunity to renew and reinvigorate your founding mission... and be a community of living faith that witnesses Christ's love to the world!"


The Most Reverand Thomas J. Walsh, Archbishop of Newark founded the parish on June 4, 1948, and appointed the Rev. Thomas F. Mulvaney as the first pastor. Father Mulvaney was given the task of organizing the parish and construction the buildings. The new parish used the Winfield Park Community Center for masses until the new church building was ready. The cornerstone was placed on September 10, 1949. On March 10, 1950, Archbishop Walsh dedicated and blessed the new church and school and the

first mass was celebrated in the church.

St. John the Apostle School opened in September 1950 with of a registration of 710 students. The teaching faculty was led by Sisters of the Dominican Order who served for the school for 65 years. The school enrollment grew and a third floor was added to the school. By 1963, enrollment had more than doubled to 1,429 students prompting the construction of the annex building to accommodate a growing middle school.

Saint John's is a vibrant growing parish with over 300 students enrolled in its religious education programs, 340 students enrolled in its Pre-k to 8 school, 24 Hour Perpetual Adoration, ongoing adult religious education programs, and many other social and religious events.
