56TH ANNUAL EASTER EGG HUNT – APRIL 12

The New Providence Lions will be hosting their 56th annual Easter Egg Hunt on Saturday, April 12, 2025, at Oakwood Park in New Providence. The hunt is open to all New Providence Toddlers, Pre-Schoolers, Kindergarteners, First and Second Graders.

According to New Providence Lions Club President John F.X. Keane, “For now 56 years, the New Providence Lions Club has hosted our borough’s Easter Egg Hunt, a joyous occasion for generations of our kids and their parents. Since 1969, our traditional Easter Egg Hunt celebration at Oakwood Park has provided a great opportunity for families to meet each other and to mingle with our great New Providence police, fire and rescue squad responders, who bring their equipment to entertain the kids. It is a piece of the New Providence experience and history that we feel blessed to give back to our community. And new for this year, we’ll be entertained by the illusions of local magician Michael Gray. We’re all looking forward to having a good time with the children and their families.”

The Hunt will take place Rain or Shine, with festivities beginning at 9:00 a.m. near Oakwood Park’s picnic area, accessed from Woodbine Circle and Roessner Place. At that time, Lions volunteers will be collecting food, handing out balloons, lollipops and pencils to the kids, entertainment will be provided by Michael Gray, and New Providence EMS, Fire and Police Departments will be on hand with their vehicles for viewing, dressed in their Superhero costumes to pose with children and their families. The Easter Bunny will arrive at 9:15 a.m. to greet the families as a prelude to the actual Easter Egg Hunt, which will begin at 9:30 a.m. sharp with nearly 2,000 colored eggs to be found. Children who find the special gold or silver eggs will receive large chocolate bunnies and gift baskets as special prizes.

The event is free, though donations are gratefully accepted, 100% of which are used to fund other services and scholarships for the New Providence community.

Families should plan on arriving at least 15 minutes before the 9:30 a.m. start of the Hunt, and later arrivals may have to park curbside on nearby streets. The Lions ask that parents be courteous and respectful to residents near the Roessner Place entrance to the park, and consider carpooling with friends.

Please Help the Lions feed the Hungry! As in recent years, the Lions will be conducting a food drive to support local families in need. Attendees are asked to bring cans or boxes of non-perishable food, which the Lions will collect and donate to the Our Lady of Peace R.C. Church Food Pantry in New Providence.

So, bring your baskets to Oakwood Park and join the New Providence Lions Club on April 12th at the Easter Egg Hunt!

GIRL SCOUTS EARN TOP HONORS AT ANNUAL KLONDIKE DERBY

BSA Troop 280

BSA Troop 280, based in Chatham, NJ, and draws members from surrounding towns, proudly earned top honors at the Patriots' Path Council, Fishawack District's annual Klondike Derby, held on February 1, 2025, at Mount Allamuchy Scout Reservation involving over 30 sleds of competitors.

The Klondike Derby is a unique winter competition where scouts participate in activities that challenge their outdoor skills and teamwork. This year's Klondike included events such as cooking, fire-building, first aid, shelter-building, pioneering, and other challenges. Scouts are required to navigate through the course with a sled containing essential gear, all while testing their abilities as a team in a variety of outdoor tasks.

Troop 280, a troop of girls founded in 2019 when girls were officially allowed to join BSA, took home first place in the Senior Sled category, demonstrating expert leadership, scouting skills, and problem-solving.

"The Klondike Derby is one of the most anticipated events of the scouting year for our troop, and we couldn't be prouder of the hard work, dedication, and sportsmanship shown by our scouts," said Amy Walker Wagner, Scoutmaster of Troop 280. "This victory is a testament to their commitment to learning, developing leadership skills, and working as a

team in challenging conditions. Our troop's success is especially meaningful as it highlights the incredible growth of girls in Scouting since Troop 280 was founded in 2019." The formation of Troop 280 was a significant milestone for Chatham's Scouting community, as it marked the expansion of opportunities for girls to experience all the benefits of Scouting. Since its founding, the troop has thrived, taking on challenges with

determination and leading by example. The first-place finish at the Klondike Derby is just one example of how these young women continue to break barriers and excel.

The victory also highlights the strength of the BSA's values, emphasizing leadership, citizenship, and outdoor skills, while encouraging young scouts to embrace challenges with confidence and perseverance.
