ANNUAL CANSTRUCTION JR. EVENT BENEFITS LOCAL FOOD

Westfield Girl Scouts successfully hosted its annual Canstruction Jr. event. Six teams of Junior and Cadette Scouts took on the challenge of using canned goods to build various structures. The 4th-8th graders had up to six hours to complete the designs, with the goal of bringing attention to food insecurity in the area.

The same teams returned to the Presbyterian Church in Westfield to sort and distribute the over 3,000 shelf-stable items and 600 reusable bags.

All food raised at a Canstruction Jr. event is donated to a local hunger relief organization.

Participants in the Westfield Girl Scouts Canstruction Jr. event spent many months drafting designs, acquiring goods, and practicing the builds. Teams developed presentations to local businesses as well as allocated proceeds from annual Girl Scout cookie sales to secure canned goods. From concept to completion, the six projects were girl-led.

This year's Canstruction Jr. event, held on the internationallyrecognized WAGGGS World Thinking Day, serves as an example of the Girl Scout commitment to the development of strong, community-minded young leaders. Congratulations to the participating Girl Scouts on their hard work and creative approach to the design challenge.



CMC of Westfield

The College Men's Club of Westfield (CMC) hosted another record-setting "Friday Night at the Fights" fundraiser to benefit the CMC Scholarship Fund. On Friday, February 7th, a sold-out crowd of more than 250 attendees assembled at the Kenilworth Veterans Center to watch 11 amateur bouts refereed by officials of the New Jersey Association of USA Boxing.

The evening generated gross proceeds of more than \$70,000 benefiting the club's scholarship fund from ticket sales, a 50/50 raffle, and sponsorships by three local businesses. The 2025 event's results exceeded all 21 previous years' gross and net totals.

CMC President Dave Germond shared that "We are energized watching these talented young athletes demonstrate their skill and training for such a worthy cause as expanding access to higher education." Germond further noted that "the CMC is extremely grateful to our Platinum Sponsor, Ray Catena Mercedes Benz of Union and our two Gold Sponsors, Rumble Boxing of Westfield and The Isoldi Collection, for their generous support of this annual event, the CMC's largest fundraiser."

At the conclusion of the evening, Germond advised the crowd to "mark their calendars now, we will be back here at the Kenilworth VFW to hold the Boxing Night on February 6, 2026 to set another fundraising record."

The evening showcased 11 action-packed bouts spanning the 105-pound to 165-pound weight classes. Boxers assembled at the Kenilworth VFW representing gyms from across the Tri-State Area, including DORCA JFK Boxing Center of Newark, Ike & Randy's of Paterson, Park Elite Boxing of Roselle Park, Brunswick Boxing Stars, and World Class MMA. The Champion Boxer of the evening was awarded to Erik Mendez, who defeated Alessandro Jaucian in the 132-lb bout.

The College Men's Club of Westfield was established in 1922 and for over a century has helped hundreds of Westfield young men by providing college tuition assistance and funding standardized test preparatory courses. Since its founding, the CMC has raised and distributed over \$1.4 million in higher education assistance to young men of the Westfield community to attend over 130 institutions of higher learning. In 2024 the CMC awarded a total of \$75,900 in four-year scholarships and one-time grants.

Scholarship applications are currently available online at the CMC's website and are evaluated by a committee of CMC Trustees in late Spring. This year's application deadline is May 1, 2025. Funds for scholarships are generated from fund-raising events like the annual Boxing Night, donations, membership dues, endowment investment income and legacy bequests.

SPRING CONCERT - FRIDAY, APRIL 4

The Westfield Community Concert band will present its annual Spring Concert on Friday, April 4 at 7:30 p.m. at Edison Intermediate School, 800 Rahway Avenue in Westfield. Dr. Thomas Connors, conductor and music director of the band, has prepared a program entitled "Dance Into Spring" which is highlighted by classical and contemporary selections for wind band.

The program will feature the band's performance of the complete Suite of Old American Dances, written by Robert Russell Bennett for wind band. Composed in 1952, this selection celebrates five traditional American dances of the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries: Catwalk, Schottische, Western One-Step, Wallflower Waltz and Rag.

The program will also feature the music of Bedrich Smetana, a renowned Czech composer of operas, with a performance of Dance of the Comedians. This 1866 composition includes music from the popular comic opera, The Bartered Bride. This challenging selection has been performed leading wind bands, including the United States Marine Band, "The President's Own".

The band also performs Sun Dance, by Frank Ticheli, Hebrides Suite, by Clare Grundman, Spring Song, by Jean Sibelius and From Every Horizon, composed by Norman Dello Joio for the 1964 New York Worlds Fair.

The band, in its 113th concert season, will also be presenting its annual Summer Concert Series on Thursdays, June 26, July 3, July 10 and July in the Westfield Municipal Building, 425 East 17 in Westfield's Mindowaskin Park.
