ANNUAL CANSTRUCTION JR. EVENT BENEFITS LOCAL FOOD

Westfield Girl Scouts successfully hosted its annual Canstruction Jr. event. Six teams of Junior and Cadette Scouts took on the challenge of using canned goods to build various structures. The 4th-8th graders had up to six hours to complete the designs, with the goal of bringing attention to food insecurity in the area.

The same teams returned to the Presbyterian Church in Westfield to sort and distribute the over 3,000 shelf-stable items and 600 reusable bags.

Canstruction is an international hunger relief charity that raises millions of pounds of food each year. Its youth events give students age 10-18 the chance to use art, design, math, and problem-solving skills to create fantastic, innovative CanArt® structures using unopened cans of food. All food raised at a Canstruction Jr. event is donated to a local hunger relief organization.

Participants in the Westfield Girl Scouts Canstruction Jr. event spent many months drafting designs, acquiring goods, and practicing the builds. Teams developed presentations to local businesses as well as allocated proceeds from annual Girl Scout cookie sales to secure canned goods. From concept to completion, the six projects were girl-led.

This year's Canstruction Jr. event, held on the internationally-recognized WAGGGS World Thinking Day, serves as an example of the Girl Scout commitment to the development of strong, community-minded young leaders. Congratulations to the participating Girl Scouts on their hard work and creative approach to the design challenge.

BOXING NIGHT RAISES \$70,000 TO BENEFIT SCHOLARSHIP FUND

CMC of Westfield

The College Men's Club of Westfield (CMC) hosted another record-setting "Friday Night at the Fights" fundraiser to benefit the CMC Scholarship Fund. On Friday, February 7th, a sold-out crowd of more than 250 attendees assembled at the Kenilworth Veterans Center to watch 11 amateur bouts refereed by officials of the New Jersey Association of USA Boxing.

The evening generated gross proceeds of more than \$70,000 benefiting the club's scholarship fund from ticket sales, a 50/50 raffle, and sponsorships by three local businesses. The 2025 event's results exceeded all 21 previous years' gross and net totals.

CMC President Dave Germond shared that "We are energized watching these talented young athletes demonstrate their skill and training for such a worthy cause as expanding access to higher education." Germond further noted that "the CMC is extremely grateful to our Platinum Sponsor, Ray Catena Mercedes Benz of Union and our two Gold Sponsors, Rumble Boxing of Westfield and The Isoldi Collection, for their generous support of this annual event, the CMC's largest fundraiser."

At the conclusion of the evening, Germond advised the crowd to "mark their calendars now, we will be back here at the Kenilworth VFW to hold the Boxing Night on February 6, 2026 to set another fundraising record."

The evening showcased 11 action-packed bouts spanning the 105-pound to 165-pound weight classes. Boxers assembled at the Kenilworth VFW representing gyms from across the Tri-State Area, including DORCA JFK Boxing Center of Newark, Ike & Randy's of Paterson, Park Elite Boxing of Roselle Park, Brunswick Boxing Stars, and World Class MMA. The Champion Boxer of the evening was awarded to Erik Mendez, who defeated Alessandro Jaucian in the 132-lb bout.

The College Men's Club of Westfield was established in 1922 and for over a century has helped hundreds of Westfield young men by providing college tuition assistance and funding standardized test preparatory courses. Since its founding, the CMC has raised and distributed over \$1.4 million in higher education assistance to young men of the Westfield community to attend over 130 institutions of higher learning. In 2024 the CMC awarded a total of \$75,900 in four-year scholarships and one-time grants.

Scholarship applications are currently available online at the CMC's website and are evaluated by a committee of CMC Trustees in late Spring. This year's application deadline is May 1, 2025. Funds for scholarships are generated from fund-raising events like the annual Boxing Night, donations, membership dues, endowment investment income and legacy bequests.

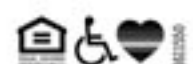

"As we celebrate the fifth anniversary of our film festival, I'm filled with gratitude and excitement for the incredible filmmakers, passionate audiences, and dedicated team that have made this journey possible," said Stephanie Levine, festival director and Cranford Schools Friends of the Performing Arts president. "This milestone is not just a reflection of our past achievements but a testament to our commitment to showcasing diverse voices and inspiring stories."

The festival screening will occur from 6-10 p.m. at the Cranford Theater, located at 25 North Ave W in Cranford. A pre-screening celebration will be hosted at Cranford's Yale Terrace Brewery for selected filmmakers and VIP ticket holders. A post-show Q&A session for audience members to ask questions of filmmakers about their films will take place after the screening. The

full schedule of this year's films will be available online in April.

Tickets are now available for purchase at the Cranford Film Festival website. They start at \$25 for the screening of the short film block. VIP tickets, which include admittance to the pre-party and a festival T-shirt, will cost \$45 for one and \$75 for two. The festival historically is a sellout event, so attendees are encouraged to purchase their tickets early.

The festival also offers an entirely virtual screening of selected short films for viewing online from April 27 to May 11. The virtual ticket also costs \$25.

The 4th annual Arts Day, a free companion event held in the afternoon before the film festival screening in downtown Cranford, will celebrate the performing and visual arts from within Cranford and beyond. It will feature

performances from local groups, including Cranford High School's performing arts ensembles, at the Eastman Clock Plaza and student visual art on display in nearby downtown locations.

This year, the festival is expected to be sponsored by over 50 businesses, many of them local to the Cranford area, who have generously donated funds and products to support the festival. A full list of festival sponsors can be found on the website.

The proceeds generated by the film festival's ticket sales, donations and sponsorships support the non-profit organization Cranford Schools Friends of Performing Arts (FOPA). FOPA's purpose is to enhance the experience of the students participating in all performing arts programs in Cranford's school district. All funds raised benefit students directly.

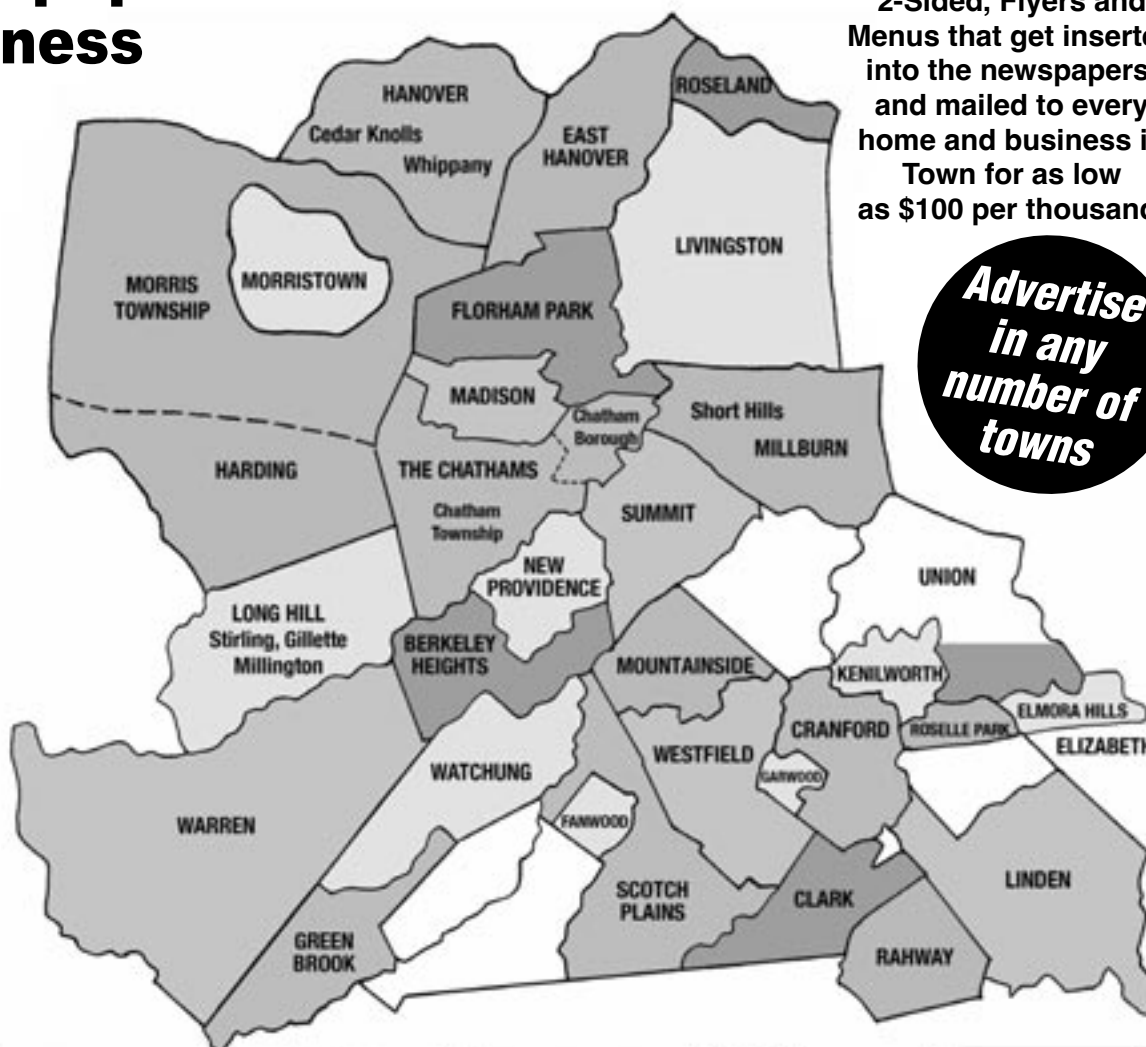
