VETERANS ALLIANCE TO HOST MEMORIAL DAY PARADE MAY 26

Hanover Township

Monday, May 26th the annual Hanover Township Memorial Day Parade again marches down Whippany Road with a colorful hour-long event. This year the Parade chaired by Committeeman and Deputy Mayor Michael Mihalko and the Hanover Veterans Alliance will carry on a long tradition honoring our fallen military and service heroes.

United States Army Reserve Veteran and retired Hanover Township Deputy Police Chief, Steve Bolcar will act as this year's Grand Marshal. A lifelong resident of Hanover Township, Chief Bolcar has dedicated his life to the service of his community. U.S. Army Captain and 2018 West Point Graduate Michael Herbert will deliver this year's keynote address during the memorial ceremony which follows the parade. In 2019, Captain Herbert was deployed in support of Operation Atlantic Resolve, aimed at strengthening the alliance between The United State and its NATO allies in response to Russian Aggression.

The Parade starts at 9:30 a.m., and begins at the Whippany Park High School, kicks off with the Hanover Township Committee members and features veterans from World War II, Slattery Marine Corp League, along with the US Marine Corp Color Guard, Whippany Park Marching Band, pipe bands,

military vehicles, and service organizations. The Whippany and Cedar Knolls Fire Deartments, area churches, cub, boy and girl's scouts, and a host of teams from Little League and Soccer marching with members of the NY Red Bulls with take part.

The parade will march to the American Legion Hall on Legion Place where ceremonies honoring those who gave all will be held and where Captain Herbert will speak. A gathering at the rear of the Legion will take place immediately thereafter with hotdogs and refreshments for all.

Note that parking for the Legion Ceremony will be in the parking lot of the JCC located at 905 Route 10. Access can be made via Legion Place prior to the parade or the Route 10 entrance to the JCC at any time. Signs and Police Officers will provide direction to dedicated parade parking and a shuttle to the legion will be available for those who prefer not to walk.

New for this year, those parade attendees wishing to attend the Legion Ceremony will be able to board school buses that will follow the parade marchers to the Legion. The buses will pick up passengers at Whippany Park High School and Our Lady of Mercy Church. Following the Legion Ceremony, bus transportation will be provided back to both locations.

PRESERVATION TRUST GRANT APPLICATIONS DUE JUNE 19TH

Morris County
The Morris County Office of Planning and Preservation has announced the availability of grant applications to file for open space funding through the Morris County Preservation Trust.

The applications are available on the Open Space Preservation website: morriscountynj.gov/Departments/Open-Space-Preservation/Open-Space-Application

The deadline for submitting open space applications and appraisals for 2025 funding is Thursday, June 19, 2025.

In 2024, the Morris County Board of County Commissioners approved the Open Space Trust Fund Committee's recommendations to award \$1.8 million in grants for acquisition and preservation of 65.2 acres across three municipalities.

Since its inception in 1994, the Open Space Trust Fund program has helped to preserve more than 18,300 acres throughout Morris County, supported by \$300,022,868 in funding generated through a preservation tax approved by voters in 1992.

In addition to open space projects, the county's Preservation Trust Fund also supports farmland and historic preservation, county parkland acquisition, recreational trails projects, and the purchase of flood-prone residential properties.

The review process for grant applications is managed by the Open Space Trust Fund Committee, which visits the proposed sites and makes final recommendations to the Board of County Commissioners each fall.

"Any of Morris County's 39 municipalities and qualified charitable conservancies are eligible to apply for grant funding," said Barbara Murray, program coordinator of the Morris County Open Space Trust Fund program.

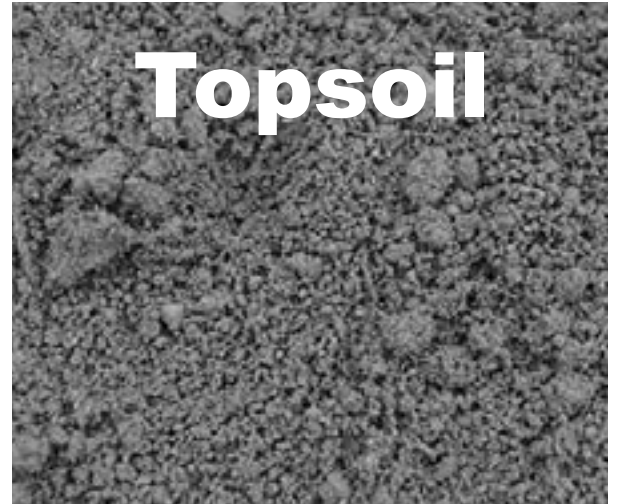

HOLLOW SPRING ENCAMPMENT – MAY 3–4

Morristown National Historical Park's signature living history event returns on Saturday, May 3, and Sunday, May 4, Revolutionary War re-enactors from across the northeast will gather at Jockey Hollow for Morristown National Historical Park's annual Spring Encampment. This immersive weekend event highlights the daily lives of Continental soldiers and camp followers during the Revolutionary War.

Throughout the weekend, visitors can explore the sights and sounds of a recreated 18th-century military encampment. Demonstrations will include musket drills, military inspections, cooking, sewing, and other camp chores. Younger guests are invited to take part in the "children's muster," where they'll be taught how to march and drill like Revolutionary soldiers. This year's encampment includes additional interpretive demonstrations sponsored by the Friends of Jockey Hollow. Visitors can observe 18th-century carpentry with Scott Lance of At the Sign of the Adze, Ace, and Chisel, historical laundry methods, and trade interactions with the camp sutler.
