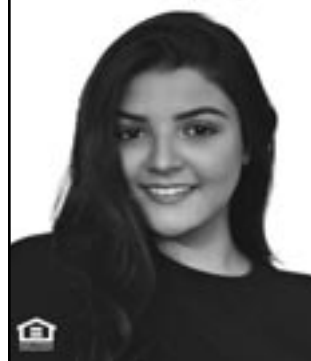

ST. JOHN THE APOSTLE PARISH CELEBRATES 75TH ANNIVERSARY

The Church of St. John the Apostle began its 75th Anniversary Celebration on February 26, 2025 with a Gala Dinner at Nanina’s in the Park in Belleville NJ. Over 250 parishioners and parish friends attended the event along with the current Pastor Mauro Primavera and Auxiliary Bishop Elias R. Lorenzo, OSB, regional bishop for Union County. Also present were Parish Clergy, the Sisters of St. Dominic as well as representatives from the Township of Clark and the City of Linden. Honoree at the celebration was Sister Donna Marie O’Brien OP who was honored for her commitment to Catholic Education and shaping the minds of countless children from 1960-2015. Sr. Donna was past principal of St. John the Apostle School for 34 years, retiring in 2015.

Bishop Elias Lorenzo addressed the attendees at the Gala and wrote in the Commemorative Anniversary Book, “The Diamond Anniversary offers all in the parish the opportunity to renew and reinvigorate your founding mission... and be a community of living faith that witnesses Christ’s love to the world!”

The Most Reverend Thomas J. Walsh, Archbishop of Newark founded the parish on June 4, 1948, and appointed the Rev. Thomas F. Mulvaney as the first pastor. Father Mulvaney was given the task of organizing the parish and

construction the buildings. The new parish used the Winfield Park Community Center for masses until the new church building was ready. The cornerstone was placed on September 10, 1949. On March 10, 1950, Archbishop Walsh dedicated and blessed the new church and school and the first mass was celebrated in the church.

St. John the Apostle School opened in September 1950 with of a registration of 710 students. The teaching faculty was led by Sisters of the Dominican Order who served for the school for 65 years. The school enrollment grew and a third floor was added to the school. By 1963, enrollment had more than doubled to 1,429 students prompting the construction of the annex building to accommodate a growing middle school.

Saint John’s is a vibrant growing parish with over 300 students enrolled in its religious education programs, 340 students enrolled in its Pre-k to 8 school, 24 Hour Perpetual Adoration, ongoing adult religious education programs, and many other social and religious events. Continued 75th Anniversary Celebrations will continue throughout the year. A closing Anniversary Mass will be celebrated by Cardinal Joseph W. Tobin, CSsR, Archbishop of Newark on Sunday October 12th at the 12 noon mass.

Every Memorial Day, millions of Americans attend parades, fire up their grills, and host large backyard BBQs for friends and family. As a veteran, I look forward to marching in a parade and attending a BBQ. However, before the festivities begin, I make it a point to check in on fellow veterans and ensure they are in a good place. For some veterans, Memorial Day is a difficult day, and they could use some reassurance from a friend or comrade.

For too long, our military members and veterans have been facing a heartbreaking crisis. A new study suggests that 44 veterans and servicemembers take their lives every day. This has become a nationwide epidemic, and countless families are struggling with this issue alone. Fortunately, there are many organizations working tirelessly to help our uniformed heroes get through these difficult times.

In 2017, the New Jersey Veterans Network (501(c)3) was created with a focus on the well-being of military members, veterans, and their families. The NJVN is a volunteer-driven mobile outreach team that actively seeks out veterans in need, providing them with free, life-saving resources and services. As a grassroots organization, we have a unique perspective on the needs of our uniformed heroes.

Our approach, combined with the ability to

collaborate with other organizations that share our mission, has allowed us to save lives and help veterans live a better quality of life. Recently, the NJVN has ramped up our mentorship and peer support programs. However, our recreational therapy events and functions have produced the most impactful results.

The NJVN has had great success hosting social events such as: movie nights, group hiking, paintball, professional sporting games, fishing trips, hunting, and other outdoor activities. Additionally, every year, the NJVN sends veterans to Camp Patriot (a PTSD retreat) for a week of healing.

Each week, the NJVN provides veterans with food, clothing, housing assistance, VA benefits information, and mental health support. By partnering with numerous other groups and organizations, we can offer our uniformed heroes a better way of life.

We are always looking for volunteers that can both assist with upcoming events and help mentor veterans so they can live better productive lives. Volunteers are the most important NJVN resource, and we would love to have more people help us save lives. 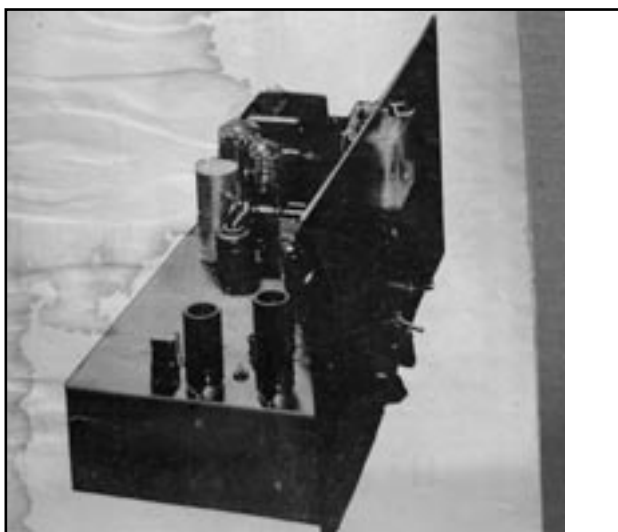
We do all kinds of Ham Radio Activities. We take part in contests and exercises to practice our communications skills. We work with local kids, at school and at summer camps.

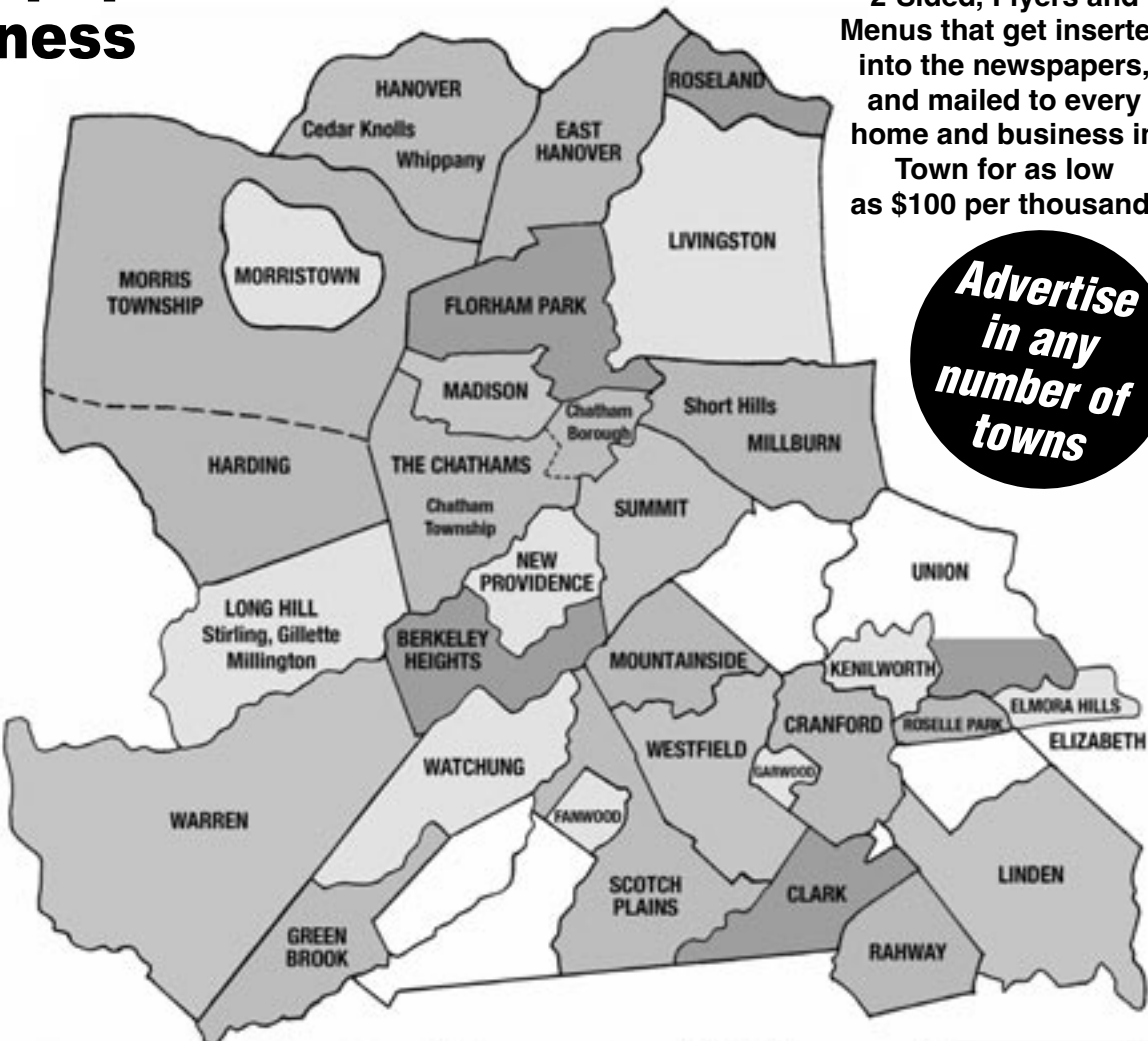
