24 RESIDENTS EARN CPR CERTIFICATION

24 Roselle Park residents earned their CPR certification after completing the “Putting Life First” seminar held in March. The certification, which is valid for two years, ensures these residents are equipped with essential life-saving skills to respond effectively in emergencies.

“We started this program after a local resident lost their life in a motorcycle accident,” said Councilman Gregory Johnson. “In situations like that, sometimes all emergency personnel need is just a few more minutes to arrive. Those minutes can mean the difference between life and death.”

The success of the event was made possible through the leadership of Councilman Johnson, the dedication of the Garwood First Aid Squad, and the support of the Roselle Park Police Department. Gratitude is also extended to Neri’s Deli for providing refreshments and lunch, as well as to the Gregory Johnson Civic Association for its generous sponsorship of raffle prizes.

“That’s why it’s critical to empower everyday

people with the tools and training to act swiftly and confidently before first responders get there,” continued Councilman Johnson. “This isn’t just a seminar — it’s a movement. It’s about putting life first in Roselle Park and making sure our residents are prepared to protect each other when every second counts.”

The event will be held in 2 locations: Trailside Nature & Science Center in Mountainside in the afternoon and at William Miller Sperry Observatory on the campus of Union College in Cranford in the evening. The theme is "Solar Max, Unlocking the Secrets of the Sun." This is a family friendly event that focuses on learning about our Sun and its impact on us, and also about astronomy and related sciences in a fun and easy to understand atmosphere. This event appeals to both children and adults. The event is free and open to the public and does not require preregistration. So, mark your calendars for Saturday, May 17, 2025, and come out to learn more about the Sun and our universe!

Amateur Astronomers, Inc (AAI) of Cranford, NJ celebrated their 75th Anniversary on Sunday, November 17, 2024, at The Westwood Caterers of Garwood, NJ. In attendance were 53 past and current members who range from teenagers to seniors.
AAI has always interested anyone who loves looking and learning about the night sky. Housed in the William Miller Sperry Observatory on the Union College campus in Cranford, the observatory is open to the public every Friday

night with their twin domes looking at the heavens. One of the domes houses a 24-inch reflector and the other dome houses a 10 refractor, which was constructed by club members. Public lectures start at 8:30 p.m. on Fridays, they are on current topics in Astronomy. Youth lectures are presented by the club at 7:00 p.m. to preregistered scout groups to help them earn their patches in science. MICHAEL POWERS NAMED GRAND MARSHAL 2025 MEMORIAL DAY PARADE

American Legion Post 60 has nominated Michael Powers as the Grand Marshal of Roselle Park’s 2025 Memorial Day Parade. The parade will take place on Monday, May 26th.

“Mr. Powers’ nomination as Grand Marshal of this year’s parade reflects his lifelong commitment to serving our community,” said Mayor Joseph Signorello III. “His dedication to our nation and Borough makes him an ideal representative for this significant occasion.”

Powers, a lifelong resident of Roselle Park, served in the U.S. Navy until 1982 when he was honorably discharged. He joined the Union County Sheriff’s Department in 1991, retiring in 2017. He continued his community service as a Court Officer and later as the Resource Officer at Roselle Park High School.

As a dedicated member of the Church of the Assumption and an esteemed Fourth Degree

Knight in the Knights of Columbus, Powers exemplifies his commitment to strengthening the community through charitable efforts as well. He has also coached youth sports and mentored young athletes, remaining a constant presence in the lives of many.

The Borough’s annual Memorial Day Service will be held on the library grounds after the parade. Residents are welcomed and encouraged to attend the parade and memorial service.

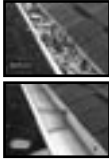

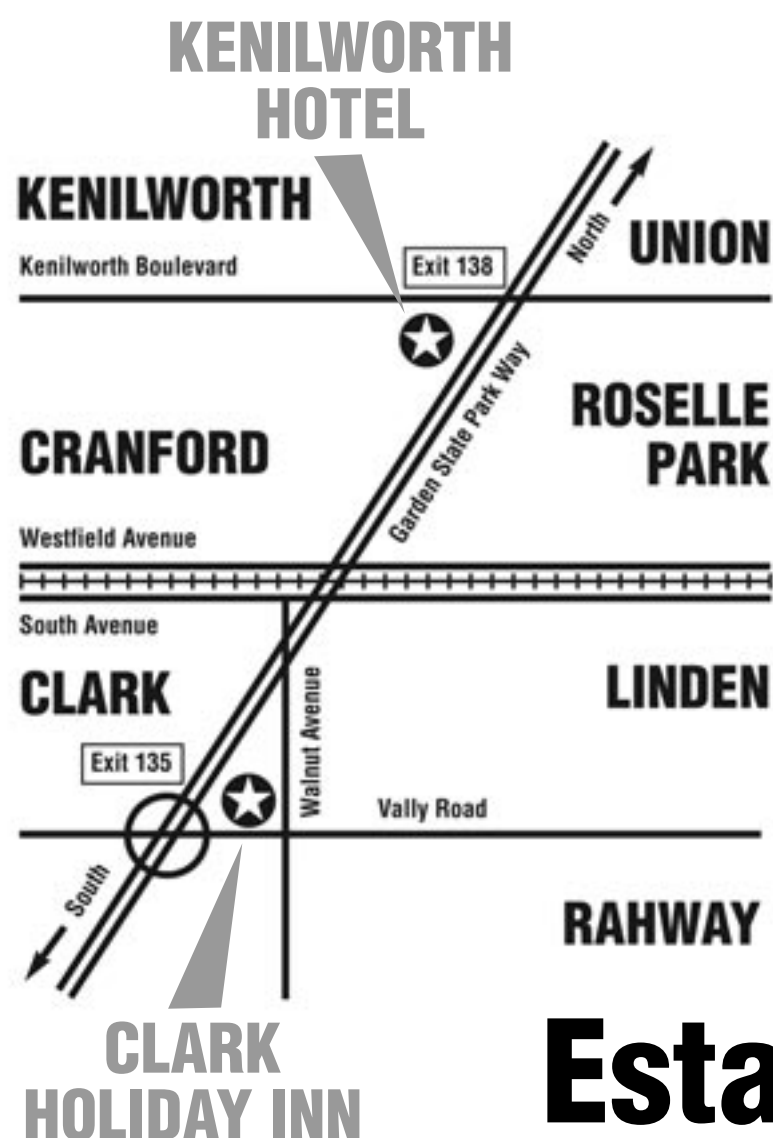

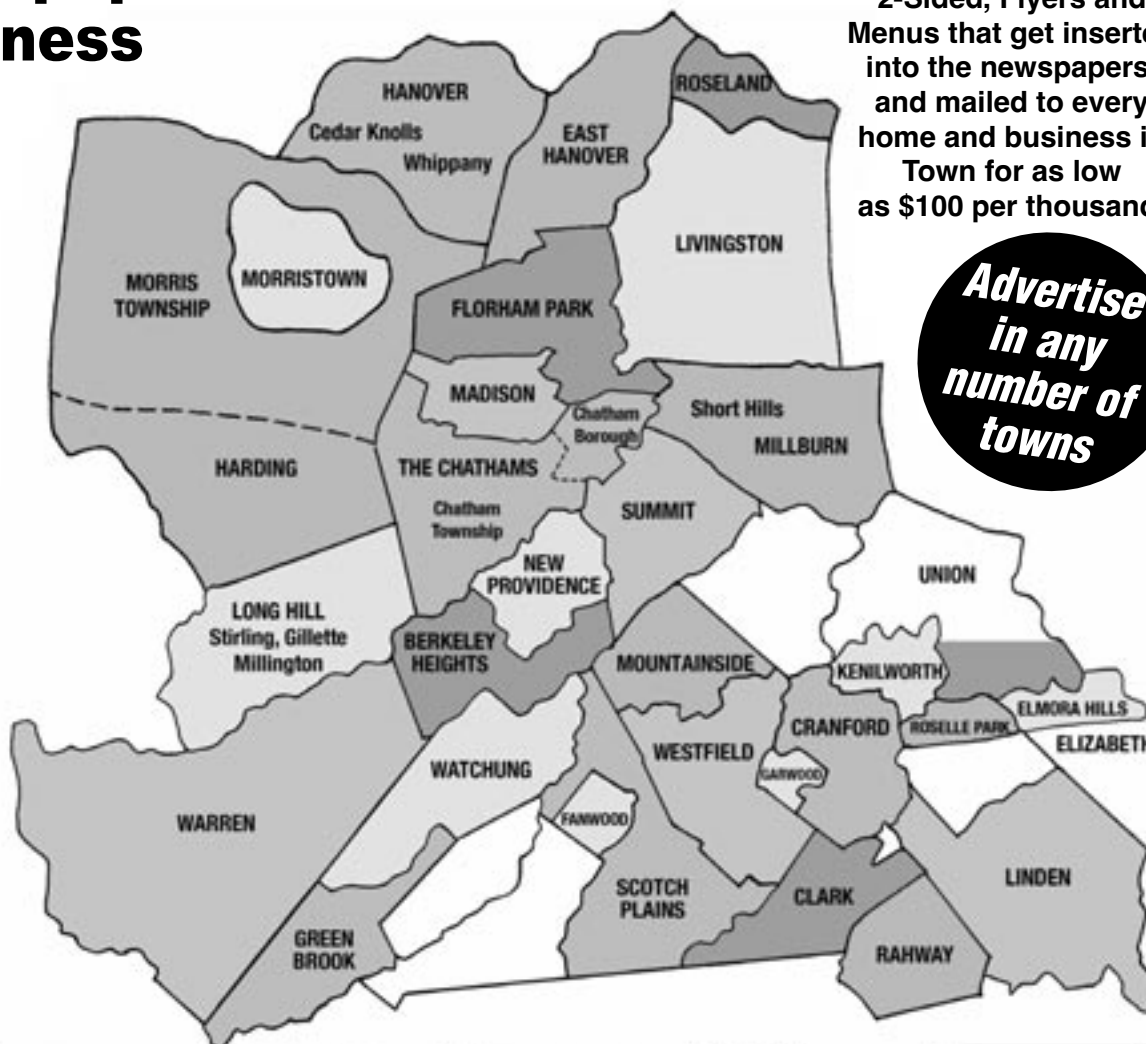
