FOOD DRIVE SUPPORTS IHM FOOD PANTRY

As part of UNICO National's Community Service Day, Scotch Plains-Fanwood UNICO collected and donated food items for the Immaculate Heart of Mary Church (IHM) Food Pantry in Scotch Plains. The food drive, coordinated by SP-F UNICO member Joe Schiavo, began with members and residents dropping off items at locations in the Scotch Plains-Fanwood area over the span of a couple of weeks. When April 26 arrived, UNICO members and Scotch Plains-Fanwood High School National Italian Honor Society students brought the food to IHM, unpacked it, and placed it on the pantry shelves while organizing the pantry to ensure everything was in the right place.

By the end of the day, the pantry was stocked with several full bags of food, all of which will help those experiencing food insecurity or needing food for themselves and/or their families. In addition to the food donations, SP-F UNICO donated \$200 to the food pantry for future needs.

IHM Food Pantry coordinator Mary Kate Schiller was very appreciative of SP-F UNICO for the food and service donations. The chapter honored its motto of "Service Above Self" and was proud to support the efforts of IHM to provide food for the community.

EMILY LITZ RECOGNIZED BY STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION

Scotch Plains-Fanwood Public Schools

Emily Litz, a fifth-grade teacher at Nettingham Middle School, continues to bring pride to Scotch Plains-Fanwood Public Schools. On May 7, she was formally recognized by the New Jersey State Board of Education (NJSBE) for winning the Milken Educator Award, often referred to as the ‘Oscar’s of Teaching’.

“We recognize you. We value you and we thank you,” said NJSBE Division of Teaching and Learning Services Assistant Commissioner Dr. Jorden Schiff.

Other NJSBE members also spoke about how Litz is a dedicated teacher who worked hard to earn this recognition and how she is a “bright light” in the teaching profession.

The Milken Family Foundation honors 45 teachers nationwide every year, and in 2024 Litz was the sole winner in New Jersey. Recipients of the award receive a \$25,000 cash prize and have access to mentorship and networking opportunities through the Milken Family Foundation.

“Mrs. Litz continues to make Scotch Plains-Fanwood Public Schools proud,” said Superintendent Dr. Joan Mast. “She continues to lead not only our students, but the teachers around her, to make our schools the best they can possibly be.”

Students at Union County Vocational Technical Schools are making a meaningful mark on their community through their growing involvement with GlamourGals—a nonprofit dedicated to ending senior isolation through teen-led makeovers and intergenerational connection. Since launching their chapter, these students have brightened the days of local seniors through complimentary manicures, heartfelt conversations, and simple moments of shared joy.

Their very first event laid the foundation for something much bigger: a movement of compassion and connection. For Ivy L., now attending her second GlamourGals visit, the experience has been deeply personal. “We connected over our childhood memories of painting our nails—she used to do her own all the time, and I talked about how my mom would paint pictures and designs on mine,” Ivy recalled. “Today’s visit was another beautiful, memorable experience. I already can’t wait for the next one.”

For fellow volunteer Gayatri S., each visit is a reminder of the deeper mission behind the glitter and polish. “When I think about why we do this, I’m reminded that GlamourGals exists to fight senior isolation,” she said. “Hearing her story helped me realize how much joy and comfort our presence brings. Every time we visit, we’re taking another step toward that goal—and that means everything.”

The Union County Vocational Technical Schools’ GlamourGals chapter is more than a student group—it’s a team of young changemakers leading with empathy. Through their commitment, seniors are reminded that they are valued, seen, and never alone. And for these students, the journey is just beginning.

GlamourGals, a 501(c)(3) founded in 2000, reduces social isolation by empowering beautiful connections across generations. Our signature beauty makeovers are led by teen-led chapters nationwide that bring honor and companionship to seniors in aged care.

MEMORIAL DAY: A TIME FOR REFLECTION AND ACTION

Every Memorial Day, millions of Americans attend parades, fire up their grills, and host large backyard BBQs for friends and family. As a veteran, I look forward to marching in a parade and attending a BBQ. However, before the festivities begin, I make it a point to check in on fellow veterans and ensure they are in a good place. For some veterans, Memorial Day is a difficult day, and they could use some reassurance from a friend or comrade.

For too long, our military members and veterans have been facing a heartbreaking crisis. A new study suggests that 44 veterans and servicemembers take their lives every day. This has become a nationwide epidemic, and countless families are struggling with this issue alone. Fortunately, there are many organizations working tirelessly to help our uniformed heroes get through these difficult times.

In 2017, the New Jersey Veterans Network (501(c)3) was created with a focus on the well-being of military members, veterans, and their families. The NJVN is a volunteer-driven mobile outreach team that actively seeks out veterans in need, providing them with free, life-saving resources and services. As a grassroots organization, we have a unique perspective on the needs of our uniformed heroes.

Our approach, combined with the ability to

collaborate with other organizations that share our mission, has allowed us to save lives and help veterans live a better quality of life. Recently, the NJVN has ramped up our mentorship and peer support programs. However, our recreational therapy events and functions have produced the most impactful results.

The NJVN has had great success hosting social events such as: movie nights, group hiking, paintball, professional sporting games, fishing trips, hunting, and other outdoor activities. Additionally, every year, the NJVN sends veterans to Camp Patriot (a PTSD retreat) for a week of healing.

Each week, the NJVN provides veterans with food, clothing, housing assistance, VA benefits information, and mental health support. By partnering with numerous other groups and organizations, we can offer our uniformed heroes a better way of life.

We are always looking for volunteers that can both assist with upcoming events and help mentor veterans so they can live better productive lives. Volunteers are the most important NJVN resource, and we would love to have more people help us save lives. 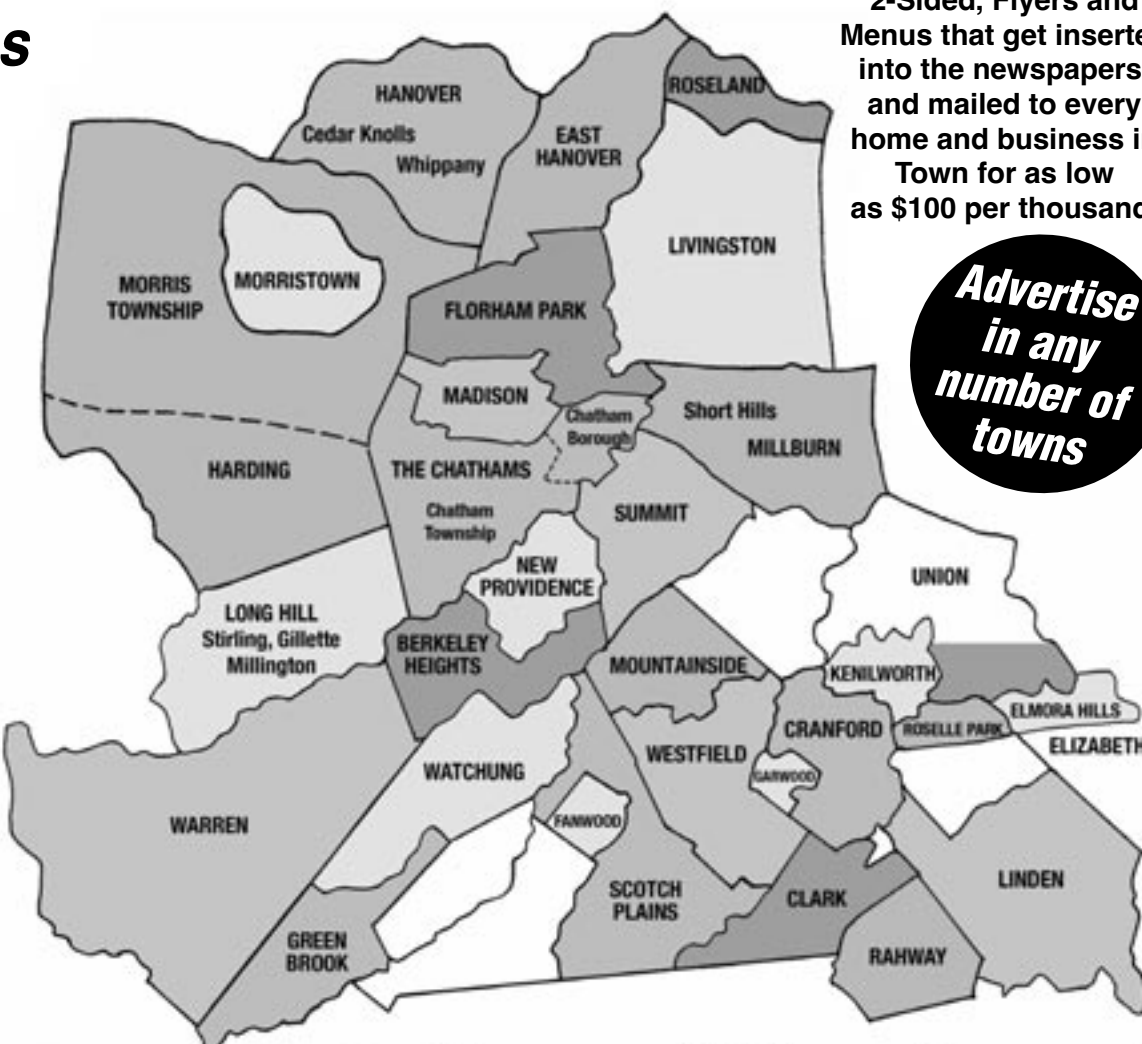

BIKE AND SEWING MACHINE COLLECTION FOR P4P - JUNE 7

Faith Lutheran Church

Do you have bikes or sewing machines needlessly taking up room in your home or garage? Give them a new home by bringing them to Faith Lutheran Church's bike and sewing machine collection for Pedals for Progress (P4P) and Sewing Peace on Saturday, June 7th from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

Adult and children's bicycles in rideable or repairable condition will be shipped overseas by P4P and distributed to those who rely on them for transportation to jobs, markets, medical care, and schools. Donations of working sewing machines also provide income opportunities for those living in developing countries.

If you are unable to drop by on June 7th, you may still leave your bicycle(s) in Faith Lutheran's lower lot next to the utility shed. If you are donating a sewing machine, please leave it underneath the sheltered alcove by the red doors at the bottom of the parking lot. Faith will make sure these items get to P4P for this collection or will hold them until the next one. Please note that "bikes for parts" or disassembled bicycles will not be accepted.

On average, it costs \$52 to collect, process, and ship each bicycle. A donation toward shipping costs is necessary for P4P's continued success and \$20 is suggested per bike and sewing machine. All monetary donations (cash or check) and material donations are fully deductible, and a receipt will be provided on site on June 7th. Donations can also be made directly via p4p.org.

To date, Pedals for Progress has shipped over 167,000 bicycles and 6,300 sewing machines to partner agencies in Central America, Africa, and Eastern Europe.

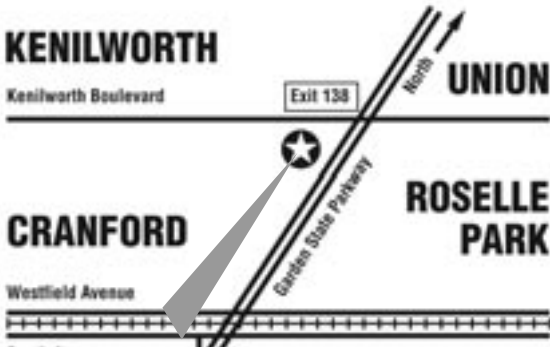

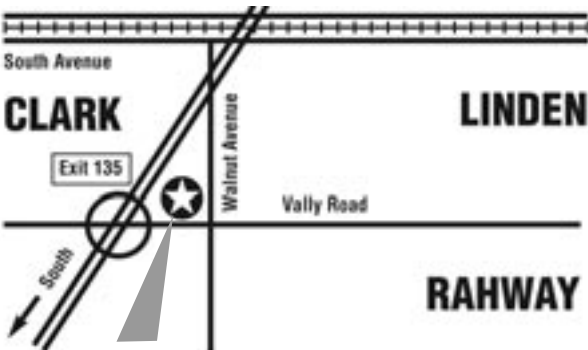
