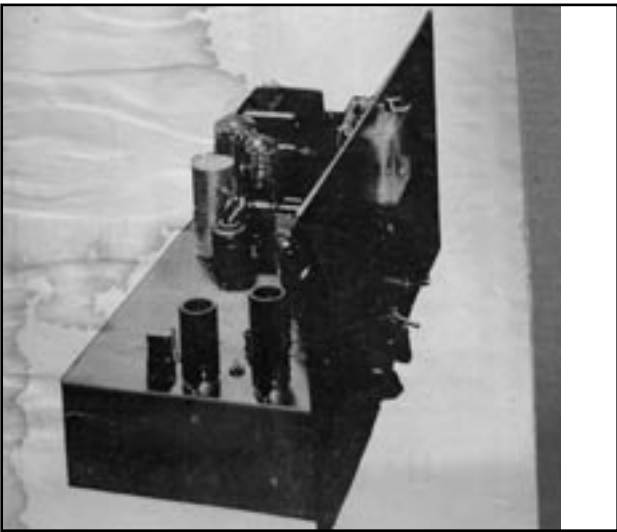
We do all kinds of Ham Radio Activities. We take part in contests and exercises to practice our communications skills. We work with local kids, at school and at summer camps

EXIT 4A ON I-280 TO BE CLOSED IN SUMMER/FALL 2025

Borough of Roseland

A contractor with the New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) has alerted the Borough that they are designing repair measures for a culvert conveying I-280 over Foulerton Brook in Roseland.

The repairs will take approximately four (4) months and will take place in summer or fall of this year. The necessary repairs will require the closure of I-280 EB ramp to Eisenhower Parkway South (Exit 4A) for the duration of construction.

Traffic will be detoured via Eisenhower Parkway North and I-280 WB through the I-280 Interchange 4.

Additional reminders and alerts will be published once confirmation of construction dates are received by the NJDOT and the contractor.

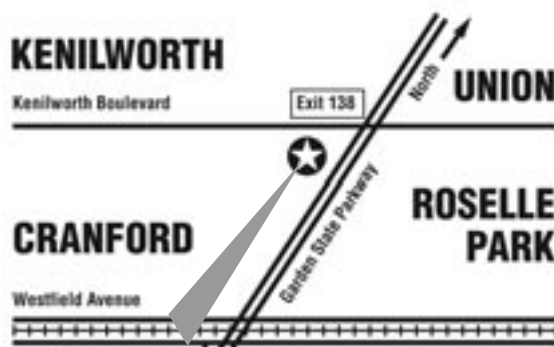

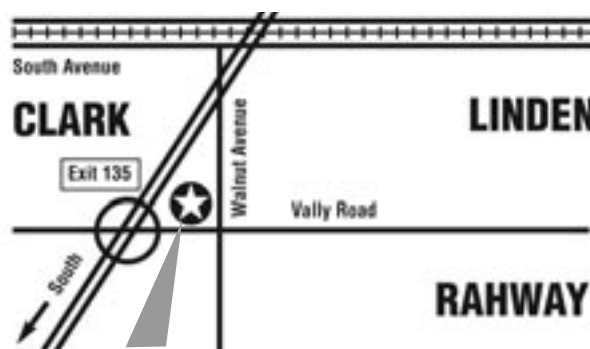

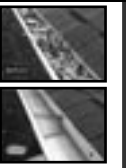
