KRISTEN BARLETTA WINS BIG AT EQUESTRIAN CHAMPIONSHIP

Mountainside mom of two, Kristen Barletta, 45, recently traveled to St. Louis, Missouri, to compete in the 2025 Interscholastic Equestrian Association (IEA) National Championships—returning home with top honors. Barletta brought home both a National Championship in jumping and a Reserve Championship on the flat in the adult division, marking a major achievement in her lifelong equestrian journey.

Barletta was joined in Missouri by her family, who cheered her on during the competition. "Having my family there made the whole experience even more special," Barletta said. "To share that moment with them was something I'll never forget."

Now in its 23rd season, the IEA held its National Finals from April 24– 27, drawing over 600 of the top Middle School and High School riders from across the U.S. and Canada. In 2023, the IEA introduced an adult division to expand participation beyond youth competitors. The highestranking adult riders from each of the 11 zones in the U.S. were invited to St. Louis to compete for national titles.

Representing Zone 11 (NJ, PA, and WV) and riding as a member of the Bergen Equestrian Team, Barletta entered the competition as the top point earner in her zone for both jumping and flat. This was her first year competing in the IEA adult division.

A lifelong equestrian, Barletta began riding at the age of 9 at Watchung Stables, right here in Mountainside. She went on to ride competitively for Centenary College, qualifying for the Intercollegiate Horse Show Association (IHSA) National Championships all four years. After college, she spent time working alongside top Olympic riders across the U.S. and Europe.

"These days, I ride purely for fun," Barletta shared. "But winning at Nationals reminded me that the passion never really goes away."
