EVENT HIGHLIGHTS PUBLIC LIFESAVING EQUIPMENT IN PARKS

On June 7th, the Borough of Garwood ended CPR & AED Awareness Week with The Aliver Foundation by bringing together this small town with a big heart to celebrate the town's commitment to saving lives. AED stands for automated external defibrillator.

"Garwood is proud to have ensured both of our parks are equipped with outdoor AEDs, and there's no better way to raise awareness than a family-friendly event where our whole community can come together for fun activities. It's also a great way for residents to get to know our amazing first responders. Thank you, GPD, GFD and GFAS for their unwavering support of our community," said Mayor Jennifer Blumenstock.

Attendees participated in a variety of activities, including a touch-a-truck, featuring members of the Garwood First Aid Squad, Garwood Police Department, and Garwood Fire Department, an interactive CPR/AED demonstration led by Luciane Raibin (Vice President of GFAS, Board Member and First Responder Committee Co-Chair at The Aliver Foundation), a stethoscope craft, and coloring.

"Educating our community through interactive CPR & AED demonstrations is so important so that people become comfortable and can jump in when an emergency happens. The Garwood First Aid Squad offers classes for anyone who would like to become certified," said Raibin.

Also featured will be appearances by Westfield's own "Towne Crier", who will present the "news of the day" and an Independence Day address by a selected community leader.

The band's music program will feature selections which celebrate America and American composers, including "Strike Up the Band" and "Walking the Dog" by George Gershwin, "Over There Fantasie" based upon Irving Berlin's World War I composition, "Over There", "America the Beautiful" by Samuel Augustus Ward, and "This Land is Your Land" by Woody Guthrie. 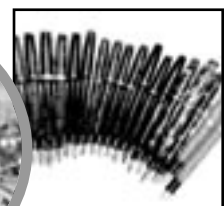

CANINE COMPANIONS CELEBRATING 50 YEARS

Canine Companions

Mike Saverino was recently matched with his third Canine Companions service dog names Arbor. Mike is overjoyed about how Arbor has picked up right where his retiring service dog

Webster left off, making a difference in Mike’s daily life. Arbor II is a two-year-old lab-golden retriever cross specially bred and trained by Canine Companions to serve people with disabilities. Arbor knows over 40 professional commands to assist Mike in his daily life. Arbor opens doors, turns on lights, and picks up dropped items for Mike to name just a few. Mike enjoys sled hockey, weightlifting, and is heavily involved in the Canine Companions New Jersey Volunteer Chapter. empowering people with disabilities to live with greater independence — and it all started with a service dog named Abdul. STEP UP, SPEAK UP FOR FOSTER CHILDREN

CASA of Passaic and Union Counties

Mia spent most of her nine years in a home marked by instability and fear. Her parents’ addiction left her hungry, alone, and unsure of what to expect each day. She eventually entered foster care. While her peers prepare for a fun-filled summer, Mia finds herself living with strangers. A judge assigned a Court Appointed Special Advocate (CASA) volunteer to her — and now, although things still feel uncertain and scary, Mia has someone who listens, shows up, and stands up for her.

Mia is just one of more than 500 children removed from home in Passaic and Union counties due to abuse and/or neglect. Living in foster care and separated from all they’ve known, each child needs a caring, consistent adult in their corner to protect their best interests while in care. Is that you?

CASA volunteers are trained advocates who visit the child monthly and have court-ordered access to all parties in the case. Supported by CASA staff, advocates make fact-based observations about outstanding needs or concerns and make recommendations to the court. The CASA volunteer is often the only consistent person in the child’s life. Applicants must be at least 21, be able to communicate effectively both

orally and in writing, have computer skills, pass a background check, and complete the 36-hour training.

Fall trainings start soon; Union County’s begins Sept. 16 in Linden and Passaic County’s begins Nov. 3 in Wayne; county of residence does not matter. View the training dates at casapassaicunion.org/casa-training.

The first step to becoming a CASA volunteer is to attend an information session. Register now at casapassaicunion.org/info-session for any of the following:
