# **GREEN BROOK LEO CLUB LEADS WITH ACTION**

From protecting the local environment to supporting neighbors in need, the Green Brook Leo Club has been making a powerful impact in their community this spring.

On May 10, members of the Leo Club participated in the annual river cleanup sponsored by the Lower Raritan Watershed Partnership (LRWP). Held at the Green Brook Regional Center, the event brought together environmentally conscious volunteers committed to preserving the Green Brook River and surrounding woodlands.

Representing the Leo Club were eight enthusiastic youth volunteers: Sai Bhavsar, Shaan Bhavsar, Kayla Boyer, Addie Boyer, Keira Begarney, Blair Bischoff, Alyssa Martinez, and Julia Nichols. Together, they removed large amounts of litter from the river and wooded areas, filling dozens of bags with trash including plastic bottles, food wrappers, rusted metal, tires, and other debris.

"It was surprising how much trash we found," said Kayla Boyer. "But it felt really good to know we were making a difference."

The river cleanup, part of a larger initiative by LRWP, serves not only to improve water quality but also to raise awareness about pollution and its impact on local ecosystems. "It's important for young people to get involved," said club member Sai Bhavsar. "It's not just about cleaning up for a day, it's about learning to care for the environment long-term."

But the club's commitment to service didn't stop there.

In the weeks following the cleanup, the Green Brook Leo Club launched a clothing drive to support FISH, a local organization that assists families in need. From late May through mid-June, the club collected summer clothing at the Green Brook Town Hall, with the goal of gathering 500 individual items. Thanks to strong community support, and some persistent outreach through Facebook posts, the drive surpassed expectations.

"The response from the community was

overwhelming," said Sai Bhavsar. "People dropped off clothes every day and we had to collect the clothes multiple times. It felt great to see how many were willing to help."

FISH will distribute the donated items to families throughout the area, providing essential summer wear to individuals who might otherwise go without.

"We're incredibly proud of our Leo Club members," said a Green Brook club Lion Club representative.

"They're showing that young people can lead by example, whether it's cleaning up the environment or organizing a clothing drive to help local families."

The Leo Club, a youth branch of Lions Clubs International, continues to offer students leadership opportunities through service. With a successful spring behind them, members are already looking ahead to more ways to serve and strengthen their community.

# **GREENBROOK MAN RECEIVES 3RD SERVICE DOG**


#### Canine Companions

Tomaso School, Warren Middle School, and Watchung Hills Regional High School, returned to her roots to share her inspiring journey from struggling student to successful nonprofit founder and Princeton University scholar. Diagnosed with dyslexia, Julia is now the Founder and CEO of Coloring Confidence, a nonprofit organization dedicated to supporting children with dyslexia through artintegrated, curriculum-aligned lesson plans and mental health resources, including guided meditations and classroom worksheets, designed to support student wellness and academic growth.

The concept of Coloring Confidence was created from Julia's Girl Scout Gold Award project during high school. What started as a personal passion has grown into a nationwide program. Now an established nonprofit, Coloring Confidence reaches children in all 50 states and over 50 countries, providing school districts with dyslexia-friendly curriculum designed to build self-esteem and literacy skills

through creativity and structured support.

Julia recently joined the students at Central School and Warren Middle School to give a presentation about the nonprofit organization she now leads. During her presentation, Julia offered valuable insights into the process of identifying real-world problems, conducting effective research, and translating ideas into action, providing students with both inspiration and practical guidance. By observing her approach and problem-solving mindset, students can learn to apply similar strategies in their own projects, starting with recognizing issues in their communities, gathering data, and developing solutions that create real impact. After each presentation, the 5th graders and 8th graders had the opportunity to ask questions and engage in meaningful discussions.
