commented Dr. DeFabio, "Afterall, it is just like having a family birthday."

Dr. Donald DeFabio opened his office in Berkeley Heights at 308 Springfield Ave in a 600 sqft office with two treatment rooms and an x-ray unit in June 1985. As his practice grew, so did the physical plant, steadily expanding to over 3,000 sqft in the same building, including an atrium, perfect for his roses and fig trees. Dr. DeFabio's commitment to community service is well known. Over the years he has been an active member of the BH Rotary and Lions Clubs, as well as serving on the BH communications committee. In 1999 he began producing and hosting Spotlight on Berkeley Heights for community cablevision, TV36, (now Hometowne TV), as well as The Mayors' Roundtable and Berkeley Heights community

events. In fact, his show on Wastewater Management received an award from the BH Environmental Commission.

"Spotlight on Berkeley Heights was pivotal in developing my YouTube channel which has grown to over 42K subscribers," mentions DeFabio, "The skills I learned in producing and hosting community access programming translated directly to my presence as a social media influencer." Dr. DeFabio continues to produce the DeFabio Difference on Hometown TV.

Speaking with patients at the event, the comments were consistent. "I feel better after every visit than before I came in" said Tom, while Andy mentioned "He is always up to date on the newest techniques and no matter what is going on, he always has an approach to it, one that has always worked."

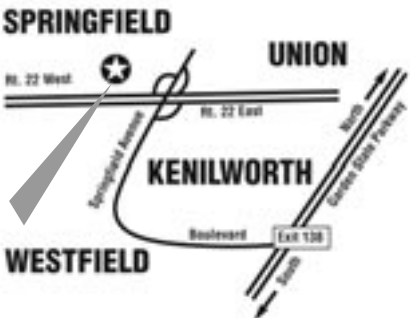

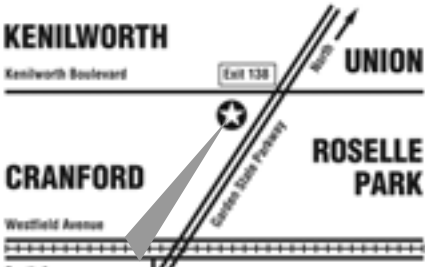

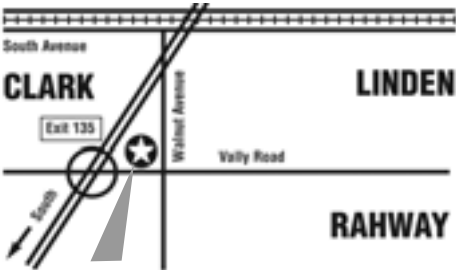

Li made it to the quarterfinals round at the NCAA Northeast Regional, taking 26th among all divisions.

Alisha was Co-Captain of the Fencing team at Warren Hills Regional High School and made First Team All-State in 2022 and 2023. As freshman at Wellsley she won 80 meet matches. She made her collegiate debut with 11 victories at the LIU Shark Tank Challenge. Other accomplishments include: a team-leading 16 wins at the Vassar Invitational; picked up 13 conference wins at NFC Conference Meet No. 1 and the Brandeis Invitational; undefeated against Division I Northwestern at the Tufts Invitational; went 10-2 at the Eric Sollee Invitational and the EWFC Championships; and advanced to quarterfinals and placed 32nd in epee at the NCAA Northeast Regional. 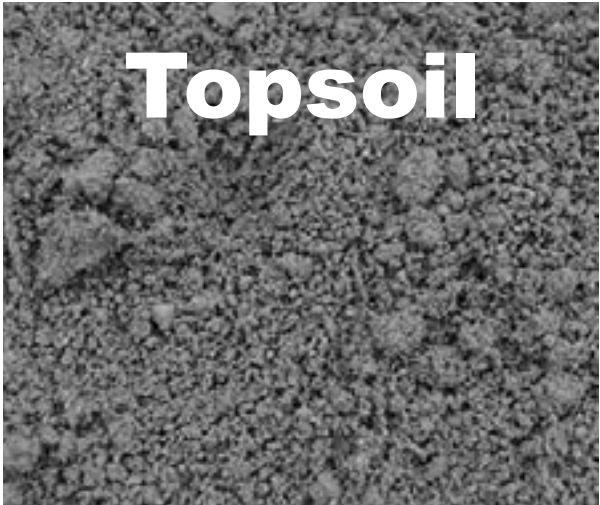

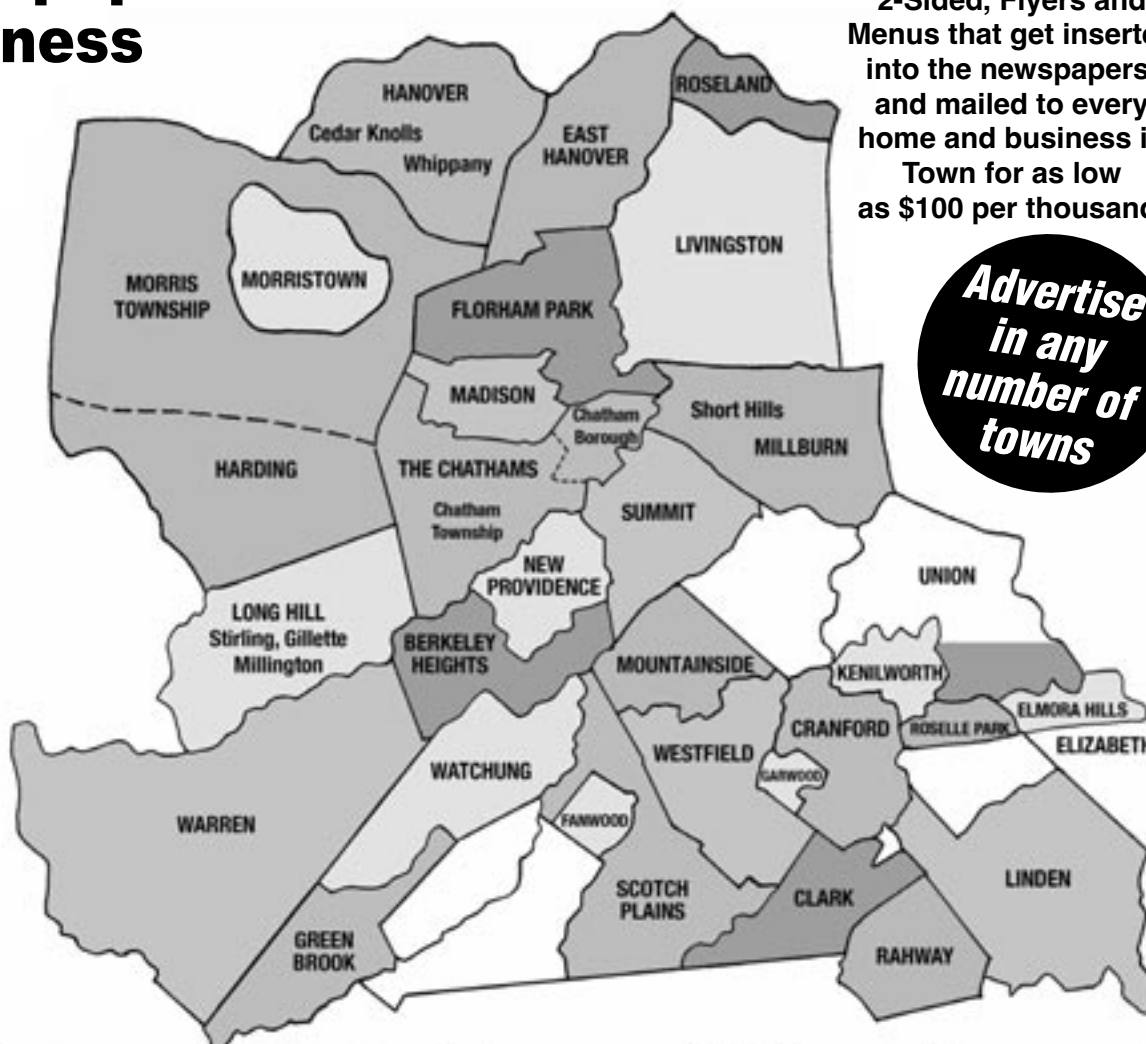
