(USOPTC) in Colorado Springs. Accompanied by his coach, Will Castellanos, Dexter will join a select group of top-tier athletes from across the country—an opportunity granted to only the most promising gymnasts in the nation.

This prestigious recognition comes after an incredibly challenging year for Dexter. He faced numerous health setbacks, including multiple doctor and hospital visits, surgeries, a serious injury, and demanding physical therapy, all of which took a toll on his overall well-being. Despite these hardships, with the unwavering support of his family, friends, coaches, and dedicated medical team, Dexter persevered. His resilience paid off in May at the National Championships in Salt Lake City, where he not only competed but triumphed—earning four medals and capturing the gold as the National Vault Champion.

Training at the USOPTC is a milestone few young athletes ever reach. It is the epicenter of elite athletic development in the United States, where future Olympians are forged. They recognize not only the physical demands of the sport but also the emotional and mental strength it takes to stay on this path. Their gratitude extends to the entire support system that has helped Dexter thrive in such a challenging, high-performance environment.

2025 MEMORIAL DAY PARADE AND CEREMONY

*Sons of American Legion Squadron 140,
Guy R. Bosworth - Millburn*

On Monday, May 26, 2025, more than 1,000 residents lined Millburn Ave. and gathered in Taylor Park for the township's annual Memorial Day Parade and Ceremony. This year's event was the largest in recent memory, drawing over 500 marchers from 39 local organizations, and served as a powerful testament to the town's enduring commitment to honor those who gave their lives in service to the United States of America.

The morning began with a spirited and dignified parade that stepped off from Millburn High School. The procession was led by a motorcycle escort from the Newark and Millburn Police Departments, followed by the Essex County Emerald Society Pipes and Drums, Grand Marshal Bernie Zenn, the Newark Mounted Police, and the honor guards of Guy R. Bosworth American Legion Post 140. Behind them marched the Millburn Township Committee and a vibrant assembly of community and cultural organizations. Concluding the parade were the members of the Guy R. Bosworth Sons of the American Legion Squadron 140, the Millburn Volunteer First Aid Squad, and the Millburn Fire Department Honor Guard.

The ceremony in Taylor Park was emceed by Scouting America Troop 19 Life Scout Lea McKenna and newly pinned Scouting America Troop 17 Eagle Scout Dominic Volpicelli, who is also a member of the Sons of the American Legion. After a moving presentation of the colors by the Millburn Police Honor Guard, Star Scout Ivy Paschkes led the Pledge of Allegiance. Sons

of the American Legion member Ben Seifer followed with a stirring rendition of the National Anthem, just before a 21-gun salute echoed through the park.

Following the invocation by Reverend Bowie Snodgrass of Christ Church in Short Hills, Sons of the American Legion Squadron 140 Commander Daniel Cannon delivered remarks that underscored the true meaning of Memorial Day. Reflecting on the Hometown Hero Banners lining Millburn's streets, Cannon reminded the audience that the stories of Millburn's veterans are deeply woven into the town's identity. "We wave flags because others raised them high on distant battlefields," he said. "And we enjoy the freedoms of this town, this nation, because others fought to defend them."

Mayor Annette Romano followed sharing her childhood memories of Memorial Day. She continued by expressing her deep appreciation to the members of the Memorial Day Parade Committee, and the Township Committee for their dedication and hard work in organizing such a meaningful and respectful event. She also publicly thanked the Millburn ShopRite and Bunchers Hardware for their support once again this year.

Next to speak was American Legion Post 140 Commander Burt Brown, whose address deeply resonated with those gathered. Brown began by introducing this year's Grand Marshal, World War II veteran Bernard Zenn. He shared a poignant story from Zenn's wartime service: a bitter winter in Germany when, despite suffering from frostbitten feet, Zenn refused medical care until he found someone to take over his duty of warming socks and shoes for fellow soldiers. Only after ensuring their comfort and safety did he then seek treatment.

Commander Brown held up Zenn's story as more than an act of personal sacrifice. "It's a

reflection of what defines the American veteran," he said. "When the conditions are toughest, when most would retreat, these men and women pressed forward."

He then drew a connection to the present day, recounting how Scouts from Troops 17 and 19 spent hours in the cold heavy rain just days earlier, decorating veterans' graves at St. Rose and St. Stephen Cemeteries. "They could have stayed dry, warm, and comfortable," Brown said, "but they didn't. They sacrificed their own comfort to honor those who sacrificed everything. And that is the essence of Memorial Day."

Brown praised the Scouts' service as the embodiment of Memorial Day's spirit. "When a young person kneels to place a flag on a grave, soaked and shivering, that act mirrors in a small but significant way the selflessness of those who wore our nation's uniform. In that moment, those Scouts stood as equals in purpose with the heroes they were honoring."

The ceremony continued with a stirring performance of "America the Beautiful" by the Millburn High School Brass Ensemble, featuring Justin Lambert, Jason Li, Teresa Wang, Hayden Moon, Leo Hwang, and Benjamin Qin. The park then fell into solemn silence as Lambert and Li performed a haunting echo rendition of "Taps."

Reverend Snodgrass returned to offer a final prayer, followed by closing remarks from Lea McKenna. "Our flag does not fly because the wind moves it," she said. "It flies with the last breath of each soldier who died protecting it."

As the Pipes and Drums of the Emerald Society played "Amazing Grace," the ceremony drew to a reverent close — a powerful reminder that Memorial Day in Millburn is not merely a date on the calendar, but a living tradition that binds the past, present, and future.

intellectual curiosity and rigor, drive and resourcefulness, compassion and collaboration, as well as resilience. 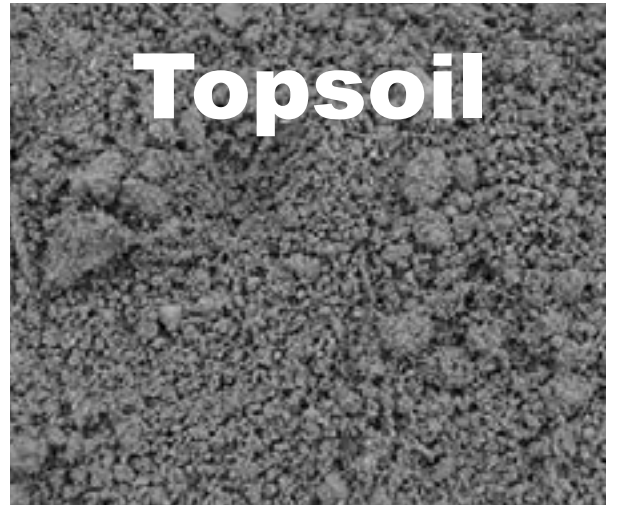
