#### THE LIFE OF DR. MARILYN HART CELEBRATED

On the evening of April 22, 2025, the Council of Mountainside Borough unanimously passed a proclamation celebrating the life of Dr. Marilyn Hart. She was the first woman elected to the Borough Council, and had a remarkable life, enriching her community and was an outstanding role model. Marilyn and her husband David M Hart each served on the Council, and together were awarded the prestigious Mabel Young Good Neighbor Award.

The proclamation reads:

WHEREAS, Dr. Marilyn McGuire Hart, a proud member of the "Greatest Generation," passed away peacefully in her sleep on March 26, 2025, at the age of 99; and

WHEREAS, Marilyn was born on February 19, 1926, in Jersey City, New Jersey, to Edward and Kathryn McGuire, and moved with her family to Mountainside in 1934 during the Great Depression; and

WHEREAS, Marilyn was an exceptional student, earning the distinction of Valedictorian at Holy Trinity High School, and later marrying David M. Hart in 1951, with whom she shared 64 years of marriage; and

WHEREAS, despite the demands of raising three children, Marilyn continued her education, earning a BA from Seton Hall University, a Master's Degree from Kean University and a Ph. D. in Urban Anthropology from Rutgers University, and she dedicated 28 years as a professor at Kean University, retiring as Professor Emeritus in 1995; and

WHEREAS, Marilyn made invaluable contributions to her community through

her involvement in charitable and civic activities, including serving on the Regional High School Board of Education, becoming the first woman elected to the Mountainside Borough Council, and volunteering for a wide range of organizations such as the Children's Specialized Hospital, Our Lady of Lourdes Catholic Church, Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, and the March of Dimes, among others; and

WHEREAS, Marilyn's unwavering optimism, work ethic, and leadership inspired countless individuals, and she led by example in her unwavering commitment to her faith, her family, and the betterment of her community; and

WHEREAS, Marilyn was predeceased by her loving husband, David M. Hart, who passed away in 2016, and is survived by her three children and their spouses: Dr. D. Michael Hart, Ellen Richardson, and Alison Brafman; her seven grandchildren and six great -grandchildren; and a community that has been forever enriched by her presence.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Mountainside that we celebrate her remarkable life, her unwavering spirit, and countless ways she has enriched our lives. May her memory inspire us to embody the same love and kindness she so generously shared.

#### POLICE PARTICIPATE IN LAW ENFORCEMENT TORCH RUN

On June 6, 2025, the Opening Ceremonies for the Special Olympics New Jersey Summer Games were held at The College of New Jersey (TCNJ) in Ewing. Attending were Mountainside Chief Joseph Giannuzzi, Lieutenant William Stolting, Union County Prosecutor William Daniel, and Chief David Hart of Linden. The event featured a significant presence from law enforcement, with officers from across the state lining the field to welcome the athletes.

A highlight of the ceremony was the arrival of the Law Enforcement Torch Run, a longstanding tradition where officers carry the "Flame of Hope" across New Jersey, with its entry into the stadium to ignite the ceremonial flame. This marks the official start of the Games and celebrates the partnership between law enforcement and the Special Olympics community.

#### **ABOUT THE ANNUAL LAW ENFORCEMENT TORCH RUN FOR SPECIAL OLYMPICS NEW JERSEY:**

Torch Run began in New Jersey in 1984 as a way to raise funds and awareness for Special Olympics New Jersey. The run is a day-long event, split into 26 legs (or starting points) with some legs beginning as early as 4:45 a.m. The run travels through more than 300 towns, covering 750 miles on-foot. 



#### STEP UP, SPEAK UP FOR FOSTER CHILDREN

CASA of Passaic and Union Counties

Mia spent most of her nine years in a home marked by instability and fear. Her parents' addiction left her hungry, alone, and unsure of what to expect each day. She eventually entered foster care. While her peers prepare for a funfilled summer, Mia finds herself living with strangers. A judge assigned a Court Appointed Special Advocate (CASA) volunteer to her and now, although things still feel uncertain and scary, Mia has someone who listens, shows up, and stands up for her.

Mia is just one of more than 500 children removed from home in Passaic and Union counties due to abuse and/or neglect. Living in foster care and separated from all they've known, each child needs a caring, consistent adult in their corner to protect their best interests while in care. Is that you?

CASA volunteers are trained advocates who visit the child monthly and have court-ordered access to all parties in the case. Supported by CASA staff, advocates make fact-based observations about outstanding needs or concerns and make recommendations to the court. The CASA volunteer is often the only consistent person in the child's life. Applicants must be at least 21, be able to communicate effectively both orally and in writing, have computer skills, pass a background check, and complete the 36-hour training.

Fall trainings start soon; Union County's begins Sept. 16 in Linden and Passaic County's begins Nov. 3 in Wayne; county of residence does not matter. View the training dates at casapassaicunion.org/casa-training.

The first step to becoming a CASA volunteer is to attend an information session. Register now at casapassaicunion.org/info-session for any of the following:


#### Canine Companions




