Torch Run began in New Jersey in 1984 as a way to raise funds and awareness for Special Olympics New Jersey. The run is a day-long event, split into 26 legs (or starting points) with some legs beginning as early as 4:45 a.m. The run travels through more than 300 towns, covering 750 miles on-foot. About 3,000 runners participated in 2025. Representing over 450 police departments.

The American Friends of Lafayette is sponsoring a 13-month long reenactment of General Lafayette's 1824-1825 Farewell Tour as America's "National Guest." It began in August 2024 in New York City and follows the General's itinerary with programming throughout 24 states. In July 2025, the General will return to Morristown - the Military Capital of the Revolution. In 1825, Lafayette visited Morristown on July 14, Bastille Day, and now 200 years later he will return to Morristown on July 13, 2025 and July 14, 2025. 



Lile Hall in Christ Church, Summit, was filled on Sunday afternoon, June 8, 2025, when the Summit College Club Foundation awarded scholarships to each of seven accomplished high school senior women from Summit and surrounding towns. The scholarships, a testament to the Summit College Club's mission to advance equity for women and girls, will significantly aid the students in pursuing their college dreams. The annual ceremony in which the club awards scholarships is a high point of the organization's year. Since its inception in 1920, the Summit College Club has given away more than \$1.1 million in scholarship funds, which has helped hundreds of women to attend the college of their choice and make a positive impact in their communities.

While a few of the awards have more specific requirements, all of them seek a senior young woman from a local town (Summit, Berkeley Heights, Chatham, Millburn, Mountainside, New Providence, or Springfield) who is graduating from one of eight high schools and who has "achieved academic excellence and demonstrated leadership potential."

Each recipient, then, has a stellar academic record, but that's just the starting point of her achievements. As a group, these young women have mastered second (or third) languages, conducted scientific research at the university level, founded nonprofits, captained winning sports teams, volunteered with local, national, and international organizations, and exercised leadership in school clubs, committees, and extracurricular activities. intellectual curiosity and rigor, drive and resourcefulness, compassion and collaboration, as well as resilience. They've used personal challenges as a springboard for growth, achievement, and giving back. Both literally and figuratively, these young women have climbed mountains. The Summit College Club is proud to honor them with scholarships and looks forward to following their careers in the years ahead.

The awards ceremony commenced with Summit College Club President Lynne Rogerson warmly welcoming everyone. She gave a brief history of the Summit College Club and its activities over the past year, highlighting its role in the local community and its connection to the American Association of University Women, a national organization.

Dr. Audrey Fisch, professor of English at New Jersey City University and founder and president of the nonprofit, More Than Bootstraps, then spoke about the crucial importance of every young person having access to and support for success in higher education. She spoke directly to the scholarship recipients about the transition from high school to college and strategies that would help them thrive. More Than Bootstraps helps build a community of first-generation students who empower each other to access and succeed in higher education through peer mentorship, and parental engagement.


