ROTARY CLUB SCHOLARSHIP AWARD RECIPIENTS

Annually the Florham Park Rotary Club has the honor of recognizing community volunteers with a Rotary Scholarship Award. Four students were recognized this year, each receiving a \$1,000 award.

The number of awards and amounts are directly attributable to the good people and local businesses that participate in the Rotary's scholarship fund raising programs. The annual "Taste of Florham Park" was recently held at the Vanderbilt-Twombly Mansion at Fairleigh Dickinson University. Those Admission tickets, 50/50 Raffles, and Tricky Tray tickets all contribute to the scholarship funds. Next is the annual "Florham Park Rotary Halloween Dog Parade & Costume Contest" at the great lawn by the Florham Park Gazebo. October date to be announced soon.

The Rotary Scholarship panel found that every Senior interviewed was better in person than they were on their impressive applications on paper, thus making the decisions very difficult. Most applicants were from Hanover Park High.

"The four Seniors recognized for community service and "Service Above Self" are just the tip of the iceberg of the wonderful youth residing in Florham Park," said Betty O'Brien, Rotary Scholarship Committee Chair.

Those four Seniors who received the Rotary Scholarship Award, listed alphabetically:

- Amanda Cosentino Community Service Chair and Peer Buddies President and one of four students to represent Hanover Park High School in the National District of Character Award competition all while being the 2025 Class President.
- Gloria Hoagland Volunteered at the Garden Terrace Nursing Home and will be interning there, was a Key Club active member, and was a Historian Representative in the National Honors Society where she promoted member engagement in community service projects.
- **Isabelle Medich** Earned the Fredrick Douglas and Susan B. Anthony award in demonstrating commitment to and addressing different social issues. She was also a Little Duck Aftercare Teacher and was a Red Cross Certified Lifeguard.

LANDSCAPE WITH BIRDS IN MIND

The Raptor Trust

How many Eastern Screech Owls do we currently have at The Raptor Trust? Apparently ALL of them! Most of these owlets were displaced after the trees that held their nests were cut down.

Cutting down trees and landscaping especially during nesting season - can destroy active nests, scare off parents, and even injure adult birds during a critical time.

Most birds nest between March and August. Even small projects - like pruning shrubs or pulling out vines - can have a devastating result on a nest.

Here's how you can help:

- Delay major trimming until fall
- Check for nests before cutting or clearing

- Leave a few brush piles
- birds and critters love them
- Avoid pesticides and non-native plants

These small steps can make all the difference for birds trying to raise their families nearby—or young birds in the first days of their lives.

The Raptor Trust is a 501(c)(3) not for profit organization which provides free medical care to thousands of orphaned or injured birds each year. Our infirmary staff is available seven days a week during daylight hours to admit injured birds, but we must rely on the people who find them to bring them to us for care.
