

Borough of Roseland


The Roseland Police Department and the Borough of Roseland have been committed to educating its officers to better understand the classifications, state laws, municipal ordinances, high speeds and motorized bicycle violations occurring in Roseland - especially with the recent popularity of e-bikes.

Besides speaking with Noecker School students earlier this year and educating them about e-bikes and the dangers of riding them, to encourage safety while riding e-bikes, the Roseland Police Department, in conjunction with the Roseland Booster Club has initiated an incentive for juveniles in our community and others to be rewarded for the safe operation and wearing the appropriate safety gear (wearing a

helmet, having reflectors on a bicycle, etc.) while operating e-bikes. This initiative also extends to juveniles operating pedal bikes.

When a juvenile is observed by a Police Officer operating an e-bike or pedal bicycle safely, that officer will hand out the pictured ice cream voucher that the recipients can redeem at the Snack Shack for (1) Ice Cream Sandwich or (1) Ice Cream Cone. The Snack Shack Is located at the Harrison Complex, next to O'Beirne Field. This initiative will be active through September 2025.
