ADVOCATE FOR CHILDREN IN FOSTER CARE TRAINING BEGINS IN SEPTEMBER

CASA of Passaic and Union Counties

At just nine years old, Jayden has endured years of neglect due to his parents' substance use and mental health challenges. After they lost their apartment, the family began living in their car in various parking lots, and Jayden often went without food or basic care. Before things reached that point, Jayden had been enrolled in school and enjoyed it. Math was his favorite subject and he loved weekly math club and seeing friends. One night, police were called after Jayden was found alone and barefoot at a gas station. He was removed from his parents and is now living in foster care. A judge assigned a Court Appointed Special Advocate (CASA) volunteer to Jayden — and now he has someone who listens, shows up, and stands up for him.

Jayden is one of more than 500 children removed from home in Union and Passaic counties due to abuse and neglect. Living in foster care and separated from all they've known, each child needs a caring, consistent adult in their corner to protect their best interests while in care. Is that you?

Fall training to become a CASA volunteer starts mid-September and will be held at the Linden Library. The first step is to attend an information session. Register now at casapassaicunion.org/info-session for one of the following: Friday, August 1 and Wednesday, August 6, both at 12 pm at the Child Focus office in Elizabeth, 1143 East Jersey Street, 2nd Floor;

Wednesday, August 6 at 5:30 pm at the Linden Library; Monday, August 11 at 5:30 pm, Rahway Library; Wednesday, August 13 at 12 pm at the Child Focus office in Elizabeth, 1143 East Jersey Street, 2nd Floor; Wednesday, August 13 at 5:30 pm at the Plainfield Library; Monday, August 18 at 12 pm at the Child Focus office in Elizabeth, 1143 East Jersey Street, 2nd Floor; Monday, August 18 at 5:30 pm at the Colleen Fraser Building in Westfield; and Wednesday, August 20 at 5 pm, Mountainside Library.

CASA volunteers are trained advocates who visit the child monthly and have court-ordered access to all parties in the case. Supported by CASA staff, advocates make fact-based observations about outstanding needs or concerns and make recommendations to the court. The CASA volunteer is often the only consistent person in the child's life. Applicants must be at least 21, be able to communicate effectively both orally and in writing, have computer skills, pass a background check, and complete the 36-hour training. CASA of Passaic and Union Counties is a program of Child Focus, which prioritizes the needs and well-being of infants, children, and teens impacted by, or at risk of, abuse or neglect. BECOME A LITERACY NEW JERSEY VOLUNTEER TUTOR

Literacy New Jersey-Union and Middlesex Counties announces its Tutor Training Program. There will be a information session on Wednesday August 6 at 6 p.m. If you are interested in registering for tutor training, you must attend one of the information session.

The Tutor Training Program will begin on Tuesday August 19th and will provide tutor trainees with the tools and strategies necessary for working with adult students in one of four categories: English As A Second Language, High School Equivalency, Basic Skills or Job Skill/Digital Literacy.

All training sessions will be conducted online via Zoom. The five required training sessions will take place on August 19, 26, Sept. 2, 9, 16 from 6 pm to 8 pm.

After completing the training sessions, tutors are matched with a small group of adult students from the growing waiting list of students who need to improve their literacy skills. Tutors meet with their students online for 2 hours per week. After meeting your students, tutor trainees may be matched with a tutor mentor to guide them through their first lesson plans. New tutor volunteers are asked to make a commitment of at least 50 hours of instruction with students.

Literacy New Jersey provides ongoing supervision and support to tutors in the form of free Professional Development workshops on specific topics such as Health Literacy, ESL Conversation, Small Group Instruction

and Job Readiness. To volunteer, you must be at least 18 years old, able to speak English and willing to tutor in Union County or Middlesex County. You do not need to have any teaching experience and you do not need to speak a foreign language. The training will provide volunteers with techniques and strategies for working with adult learners, as

well as sample instructional materials and activities. There is a \$25 registration fee to cover the cost of books and materials. Literacy New Jersey is a non-profit organization. LANDSCAPE WITH BIRDS IN MIND

The Raptor Trust

How many Eastern Screech Owls do we currently have at The Raptor Trust? Apparently ALL of them! Most of these owlets were displaced after the trees that held their nests were cut down.

Cutting down trees and landscaping - especially during nesting season - can destroy active nests, scare off parents, and even injure adult birds during a critical time.

Most birds nest between March and August. Even small projects - like pruning shrubs or pulling out vines - can have a devastating result on a nest.

Here's how you can help:

- Delay major trimming until fall
- Check for nests before cutting or clearing

- Leave a few brush piles - birds and critters love them
 - Avoid pesticides and non-native plants
- These small steps can make all the difference for birds trying to raise their families nearby—or young birds in the first days of their lives.

The Raptor Trust is a 501(c)(3) not for profit organization which provides free medical care to thousands of orphaned or injured birds each year. Our infirmary staff is available seven days a week during daylight hours to admit injured birds, but we must rely on the people who find them to bring them to us for care.

SUPERIOR AUTO BODY CO. WAS AN EARLY PRODUCER OF CUSTOM BODIES FOR AUTOMOBILES

Throughout the 1800s, the City of Rahway was closely identified with the business of building carriages. By the 1850s, the industry had reached its height with as many as 40 carriage and carriage related factories in operation. By the end of the century, however, only nine factories remained as the industry was being dealt its final death blow brought about by the invention of the automobile. A few enterprising owners facing extinction realized the possibility of re-tooling their operations to produce auto bodies to supply the new and growing auto industry. One company to successfully “switch over” would become the Superior Auto Body Company.

G. O. Graves and Co., located on the south side of Hamilton Street between Oliver and Church Streets, was one of the remaining failing carriage factories. In an attempt to revive the business, D. H. Trembley, bought the Graves’ business and began converting the factory into a painting and trimming shop for autos as well as carriages. Unfortunately, the plant proved to be too small and the work limited. Three men who were connected with Trembley realized the opportunities that were open in the growing auto industry. With eyes set on a bright future, they decided to pool their talents and resources intent on starting their own auto body plant.

The three entrepreneurs, Joseph Oxman, Thomas Armstrong, and Daniel Martin moved into a vacant carriage factory building on St. Georges Avenue located between what is today School Street and the Rahway River and formed the Superior Auto Body Company. By 1913 the business was up and running with a work force of 50 employees. Many were former carriage workers who were employed as designers, painters, carpenters, sewers, and upholsterers. The majority of workers were Rahway residents many of whom owned their own homes in the city. The company hired both men and women. Over the next decade and a half, Superior would construct several additions to their building and employ over 400 workers making it one of the largest manufacturers of auto bodies in the area.

As it would fortunately turn out, Superior got into the auto body business at an opportune time and benefited during the World War I years, 1914-1918. The major auto manufacturers throughout the country were doing their patriotic duty by changing their production lines to produce military vehicles to aid the war effort.

As a result, a shortage of autos was created at a time when the automobile was becoming affordable to more than just the wealthy. To help supply this new demand, the small-town body shops were contracted by the smaller motor companies to fill the void.

The year 1919 marked a most productive year for Superior. They tripled their production capacity by extensively expanding their floor space and enlarging the painting, woodworking, and trimming departments. They purchased \$20,000 worth of new machinery and increased the number of employees. These improvements and additions enabled the company to sign a \$400,000 contract with the Columbia Motor Company of Hartford, Connecticut. The contract called for the production of auto bodies for 360 sedans and 200 coupes at a rate of four per day.

Superior would also secure contracts with the Dodge Bros. Motor Car Co. of Detroit, Michigan, the Reo Motor Car Co. of Lansing, Michigan, Bishop, McCormick, and Bishop of New York, N.Y., and the Templar Motor Car Co. of Lakewood, Ohio. During peak periods at Superior, 20 auto bodies per day were sent directly to the companies.

Most of the automobile bodies produced by Superior were stock body sedans painted in a choice of three colors – dark blue, green, or maroon. Special order autos were often requested to be painted purple or robin’s egg blue. A few special orders were placed by famous actresses of the period including Gloria Swanson, Mabel Norman, and Pearl White. Superior also filled an order that was purchased for the King of Siam.

The auto body business by the late 1920s, however, would experience the same fate as the carriage makers before them. Most of the smaller auto companies that had been supplied by local plants like Superior were merging with major companies. These mega companies had the capacity to manufacture the entire vehicle in their massive assembly line plants. Superior’s service was no longer needed and the partners closed their shop. Their building was eventually purchased by Charles and Edward Koos who converted it into “The First Home Furnishings Store in the Nation.”







LIGHTNING BUGS

What do Lightning Bugs, Fireflies and Glow Worms have in common? These are the three names for the same insect. We call them Lightning Bugs in New Jersey while other parts of the country call them Fireflies. Glow Worms are the young larvae of Lightning Bugs which live in the ground and also glow like their parents. Actually even their eggs glow. A signal to predators that either they don't taste good or may even be toxic.

I was surprised to learn that there are over 2000 different species of Lightning Bugs found around the world, on every continent except Antarctica.

Lightning Bugs are actually 'Beetles', nocturnal members of the family 'Lampyridae'. They live in a variety of warm environments, as well as in more temperate regions, and are a familiar sight on summer evenings. Fireflies love moisture and often live in humid regions of Asia and the Americas. In drier areas, they are found around wet or damp areas that retain moisture.

Here in New Jersey we have 21 species, including 2 that were newly discovered by science. The two most common are the Pennsylvania Firefly and the Big Dipper Firefly.

Lightning Bugs are very interesting. They go through an incredible process called metamorphoses. First the eggs hatch to nymphs, then they turn into larvae and

finally the adults emerge. Each stage of this process is called an "Instar".

We only see them for a couple of weeks on summer nights, but their entire life cycle, from egg to adult, is about two years. 95% of their lives are spent as larvae, living in the soil, emerging from the ground in late June or early July.

The nymphs and larvae are beneficial insects devouring other insects and creatures humans consider a nuisance because they harm our crops

and plants.

When Lightning Bugs become adults they almost stop eating completely and survive mostly on pollen and nectar. This cycle of their lives is focused almost totally on mating.

This is when their ability to light up reaches its peak. The flashes of the Lightning Bugs are unique to each species. The flashes can help them identify their own species as well as letting individual insects recognize potential mates. The lights warn predators that this meal may not be very tasty. The light of the flash can be yellow, green or orange.

There is one species of Lightning Bugs, found in the Smoky Mountains and in areas along the Appalachians that flashes in unison. There is also a Lightning Bug species that does not light up at all.

Everyone knows how Fireflies got their name, but many people don't know how the insects produce their signature glow. Fireflies have dedicated light organs that are located under their abdomens. The insects take in oxygen and, inside special cells, combine it with a substance called 'luciferin' to produce light with almost no heat. This process is called "Bioluminescence". Scientists are still not sure how the insects regulate this process to turn their lights on and off.

After mating, females deposit their eggs in the

ground, which is where eggs develop to adulthood. Underground larvae feed on worms and slugs by injecting them with a numbing fluid.

Spotted Ladybugs are a symbol of good luck in many cultures. Also called 'Ladybird Beatles', they are the most beloved insects in the world.

After Ladybugs, Lightning Bugs are most likely the favorite insect of most people. Many of us have fond childhood memories of catching Lightning Bugs on a hot summer night, playing with them for a little while and watching them fly away.

Habitat destruction is one of the reasons many people have noticed a decline in Lightning Bugs over the past years. Luckily for us, this year a very wet spring has helped larvae flourish and families are enjoying their displays in many parts of the United States.

Please if you catch one, treat it gently and release it when you are done. Their survival into the next generation depends on human beings.

THE BRUCE SPRINGSTEEN ARCHIVES & CENTER FOR AMERICAN MUSIC TO BE SIGNATURE GROUP AT 6TH ANNUAL MARCH TO YORKTOWN DAY

As the country enters a year of celebrations leading up to 2026 and America 250, the Semiquincentennial of the signing of the Declaration of Independence, the Washington-Rochambeau Revolutionary Route New Jersey (W3R-NJ) announces an event that is a prelude to Westfield Celebrates America 250.

The 6th Annual March to Yorktown Day Commemoration & Encampment Festival in Westfield, NJ will be held on Sunday, August 17th from 12:00 noon – 4:00pm.

The event will kick off at 12:00 noon at outside of Westfield's Town Hall with an opening ceremony and the playing of patriotic music followed by remarks about the importance of Westfield commemorating when the French and American troops marched from Newport, Rhode Island to Yorktown, VA (an almost 700 mile, nine state, land and water journey) to lay siege to the British forces there, securing independence for the United States. The march of the troops took place in the summer of 1781 taking them through several Union County towns including Westfield, Mountainside and Scotch Plains on August 29, 1781. The March route was designated in 2009 as the Washington-Rochambeau Revolutionary Route National Historic Trail, a unit of the National Trail System, administered by the National Park Service.

At 12:30, the community is invited to watch or join-in the symbolic march re-enactment along East Broad Street to Mountain Ave. Wreaths of remembrance will be placed at the Presbyterian burial grounds where over 70 Revolutionary War Veterans, their families and other patriots are buried. The march will continue into Mindowaskin Park accompanied by the Generals Rochambeau, Washington and Lafayette, the New Jersey Sons of the American Revolution Color Guard, the Daughters of the American Revolution, the New Jersey Fifes and Drums, the Miller-Cory Museum colonial living history group, women camp followers and the New Jersey Militia Heard's Brigade.

From 1:00 to 4:00, a history themed festival will be set up in Mindowaskin Park. A talk on African American experiences in the Revolutionary War will be given by Dr. Sean Dineen, Adjunct History Professor, Kean University and disabilities advocate. The event's signature group is The Bruce Springsteen Archives & Center for American Music. They will be on hand to share news about their mission and they will have an exhibit with engaging items. Children's games and activities along with information will be provided by local history organizations such as the Forgotten Victory Trail Association, Westfield Historical Society, Miller-Cory House Museum, Princeton Battlefield Society, Westfield Chapter Daughters of the American Revolution, West Fields Chapter Sons of the American Revolution, Sons of the Revolution in New Jersey, Washington Association of New Jersey, North Jersey American Revolution Roundtable, Fortnightly Club, Swan Historical Foundation, Trent House

Museum, Merchants & Drovers Museum, Frazee House Museum, Center for Creativity at the Rialto, Liberty Hall Museum and others.

An encampment with tents, cooking demonstrations, fife and drum music, musket firing and marching drills will occur during the festival.

Food by A Taco Affair of Westfield, will be available for purchase.




