## AUTHOR TO SPEAK ON WOMEN OF THE REVOLUTION

Michael Young, author of "Women Who Would Be Free," will address the Elizabeth Snyder-Continental Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution (DAR) at their meeting on September 9, 7-8 p.m. in Green Brook. Young's book chronicles the stories of more than 100 heroines of the American Revolution. He will speak about women who served the cause of independence in many roles during the Revolutionary War.

"As we prepare to celebrate the Semiquincentennial, the chapter is very pleased to have Mr. Young speak at our meeting," said Chapter Regent Nancy Stoll. "His book examines the many ways that women contributed to the founding of America. He also includes the Indigenous Peoples and enslaved African Americans, shedding light on these once neglected patriots."

## GREEN BROOK VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT

The past several weeks have been extremely busy for members of the Green Brook Volunteer Fire Department. July 3rd, the Township was hit by an extreme rain and wind storm. The GBFD responded to over 35 calls for service, which included utility emergencies, down trees, trees fallen on homes with structural damage, vehicle extrication, and multiple alarm activations.

On July 14th, the Township was dealt another weather event, which included heavy rains with historic flooding within the Township. During this event the Green Brook Volunteer Fire Department handled over 60 calls for service, which included over 30 water rescues of residents from their homes and vehicles, a kitchen fire, utility emergencies, land slide and flooded residences. Some of our own members homes and vehicles were also affected by flood damage.

Our Fire House was flooded, to the highest level ever, requiring us to vacate the firehouse during the storm. The flooding caused significant damage to the Fire House, and some of the fire apparatus.

We are in need of new members to be active Green Brook Volunteer Fire Fighters.

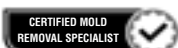

## NJ FESTIVAL ORCHESTRA PRESENT “THE GYPSY SPIRIT”

Season-Opening Concert Features International Talent and Folk-Inspired Melodies in Westfield and Basking Ridge

The New Jersey Festival Orchestra raises the curtain on its highly anticipated 2025–2026 season with *The Gypsy Spirit*, a vivid and exhilarating journey through folk traditions reimagined in symphonic splendor. Under the baton of Maestro David Wroe, this electrifying program will be performed on Saturday, September 27 at 7:00 PM at The Presbyterian Church in Westfield and Sunday, September 28 at 2:30 PM at the Sieminski Theater at Fellowship Village in Basking Ridge.

Bringing together rich musical traditions of Eastern and Southern Europe, *The Gypsy Spirit* features works by Janáček, Bruch, and de Falla, performed by NJFO in collaboration with special guests Imperial Brass (Westfield performance only) and internationally acclaimed Armenian violinist Anush Nikoghosyan.

Next, Anush Nikoghosyan brings warmth, fire, and virtuosity to Bruch’s *Violin Concerto No. 1*, a romantic masterwork beloved for its soaring melodies and emotional power.

The concert concludes with de Falla’s *Three-Cornered Hat Suites Nos. 1 & 2*, an exuberant orchestral portrait bursting with Flamenco rhythm, Andalusian color, and theatrical flair.



“The music in *The Gypsy Spirit* is a perfect marriage between the popular and classical idioms,” said NJFO Music Director David Wroe. “I’m also excited to be working with Imperial Brass; collaborating with the community is an essential part of our mission.”

Concertgoers are invited to deepen their experience with a pre-concert lecture by Dr. Yifei Xu, NJFO’s Operations Director and renowned pianist, at 6:00 PM in Westfield and 1:30 PM in Basking Ridge.

Following *The Gypsy Spirit*, NJFO’s 2025–2026 season continues with *Holiday Tenors* on Saturday, December 6, at The Presbyterian

Church in Westfield and Sunday, December 7, at Drew University in Madison. Back by popular demand, this festive celebration features award-winning tenors, guest artists, and beloved seasonal symphonic favorites.

The orchestra then rings in the new year with *Broadway Through the Ages*, a sparkling tribute to iconic show tunes performed on Wednesday, December 31, at Westfield High School and Thursday, January 1, at the Sieminski Theater in Basking Ridge. Led by Maestro David Wroe, NJFO will be joined by a cast of Broadway soloists and special guest choruses in this joyful and glamorous musical journey through Broadway’s greatest hits.

The season concludes on Saturday, May 30, at The Presbyterian Church in Westfield with *Ode to Joy*, an evening of transcendent music and international artistry. 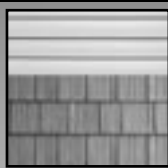

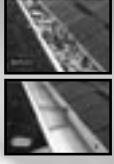

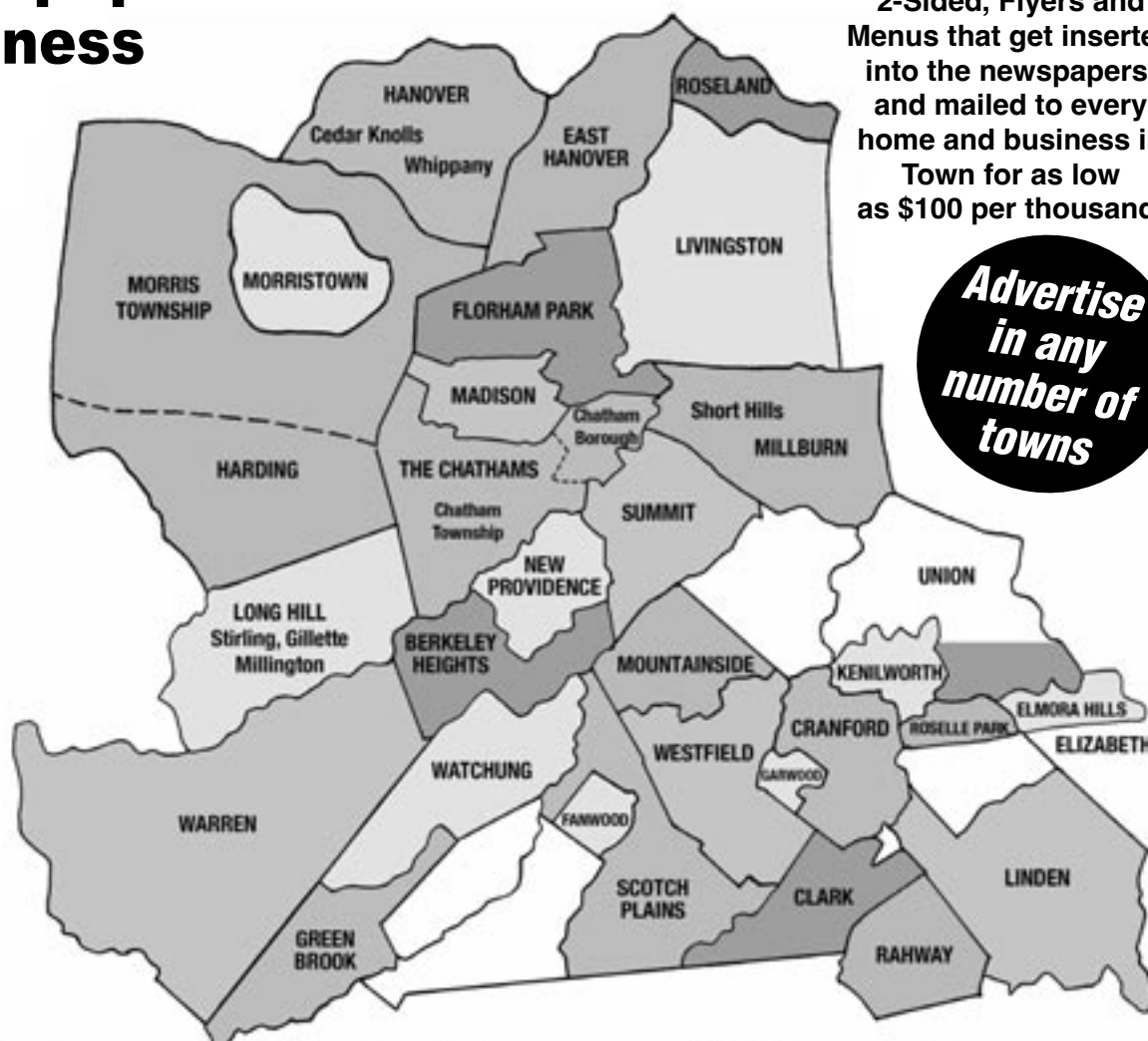

# HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION PROGRAM

The Somerset County Hazardous Waste Collection Program gives residents and farmers a legal and cost-free way to dispose of unwanted household items that cannot be disposed of in the regular trash. This drop-off opportunity is for residents only.

Adherence to social distancing guidelines is required. Occupants should remain in their vehicles at all times. Materials should be stored in residents' trunks, cargo areas, or truck beds and items must be accessible to the staff so they can easily remove items from vehicles.

Five events are held annually at various locations around the county from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. to enable residents to take advantage of the program.

County residents are also asked to take advantage of the RxMission Drive-In/Drop-Off medicine-collection program, which is held in conjunction with scheduled Hazardous Waste drop-off events, rain or shine. Residents can drop off medications at as many of the Hazardous Waste drop-off events as they wish to safely dispose of unwanted or outdated prescription drugs and over-the-counter medications from their homes. Sheriff's officers are on hand to accept the medications.

Please note that materials accepted at Hazardous Waste Days are NOT the same as those accepted at First Saturday of the Month Days.

The Morris County Municipal Utilities Authority's permanent household hazardous waste facility will accept materials from Somerset County residents on a fee basis. For information, visit [www.mcmua.com](http://www.mcmua.com). Morris County will not accept explosives or radioactive materials.
