NO TOWN IS IMMUNE: OVERDOSES IN MILLBURN-SHORT HILLS

Picture the scene: sirens blare, red and blue lights flash through the trees of our quiet Millburn-Short Hills neighborhood. It's the Friday night crew, racing to a call - a teenager is unconscious from an overdose. Friends stand frozen, panicked, unsure what to do. EMTs arrive, assess the girl, lift her onto a stretcher, and rush her to St. Barnabas Hospital.

Millburn-Short Hills is not immune to the opioid and alcohol crisis sweeping the nation. Our first responders witness it up close.

While the CDC reports a 24% decline in U.S. overdose deaths in 2024, opioids remain a leading cause. New Jersey may have one of the nation's lowest opioid dispensing rates, yet Essex County has the highest rate of Narcan use statewide. Overdoses are happening here, often quietly, often unexpectedly.

OPIOIDS: KNOW THE RISKS

Opioid overdoses can be accidental or intentional - from prescription painkillers to heroin to fentanyl-laced pills. What's surprising is that overdose deaths are highest among adults aged 55-64. No matter the cause, the signs are the



Fortunately, we have Narcan (naloxone), a medication that can rapidly reverse the effects of opioid overdose and restore breathing. It's safe, easy to use, and has no effect if no opioids are present. Best of all, it's free at many New Jersey pharmacies and available by mail through the of Department Health (nj.gov/humanservices/stopoverdoses/). Anyone 14 or older can obtain it anonymously.

TEEN ALCOHOL USE: A SUMMER CONCERN

As summer comes to its end, with its parties and unsupervised gatherings, the risk of teen alcohol poisoning increases. Alcohol impairs judgment, making teens more vulnerable to injuries from drunk driving or swimming under the influence. Mixing alcohol with other substances can also lead to life-threatening poisoning.

MSHVFAS has responded to multiple cases of severe teen intoxication—some requiring hospitalization. Prevention starts with awareness and honest conversations.

SEARCHING FOR BESSIE BOSWORTH'S PORTRAIT

The Sons of the American Legion Squadron Bosworth family estate sale. The Squadron 140 in Millburn has launched a public search to locate and reunite two historically significant portraits, those of siblings Guy R. Bosworth and Bessie Bosworth, whose service spanned both World War I, and World War II.

Guy R. Bosworth, a Millburn resident, pharmacist, and member of the Army Hospital Corps, was the first New Jersey serviceman to just finding a photograph," said Squadron lose his life in World War I when the troop transport S.S. Antilles was sunk by a German submarine on October 17, 1917. The Millburn American Legion Hall proudly bears his name in recognition of his sacrifice.

His sister, Bessie Bosworth, served as a U.S. Army Nurse during World War II and went on to become Millburn's first full-time health officer in 1948, reflecting the vital roles local women played in the war effort and in post-war civic life.


Recently, both portraits were part of the

successfully purchased Guy's uniformed photograph, but Bessie's had already been sold before they could secure it. The group now seeks the community's help to locate Bessie's portrait so the two can be reunited and displayed side-byside in the Millburn American Legion Hall.

"Reuniting these portraits is about more than

Commander Daniel Cannon. "It's about restoring a piece of Millburn's history and honoring a family whose service and sacrifice spanned two world wars. Guy and Bessie's legacy deserves to be remembered together."





For over 50 years, Odyssey of the Mind, an creative problem-solving international competition, has challenged children to think differently and solve complex problems creatively. At the start of this school year, more than 22,000 teams competed across the United States and in dozens of countries worldwide. These teams competed in Division 1 (elementary), Division 2 (middle school), Division 3 (high school), and Division 4 (university). In June, hundreds of teams, all of which placed in first or second place in their states or countries, gathered together to compete at the 2025 Odyssey World Finals at Michigan State University in East Lansing.

As always, Millburn had a strong showing at the World Finals. Congratulations to the two teams from Washington School who placed 22nd and 13th in the world and the four Glenwood School teams that placed

27th, 13th, 11th, and the Glenwood Save Me Structure team who won a 2nd place trophy for a theatrical engineering wonderful and performance featuring a structure made of 18 grams of balsa wood that held an amazing 1,030 pounds before crushing. We couldn't be more proud of all the hard work, incredible creativity, and awesome teamwork of all our Millburn Odyssey teams.
