ACES BLUE GOES BACK-TO-BACK AS SOFTBALL CHAMPIONS

Aces Blue has done it again. With poise, power, and plenty of late-inning heroics, the team successfully defended their 2024 Summer title to become repeat champions of the Mountainside Men's Summer Softball League.

Led by their fearless captain and local law enforcement officer Andrew Yasinski, the championship roster's chemistry, consistency, and clutch performances powered them through a competitive 10-team league featuring over 150 local residents.

Aces Blue entered the postseason as the #1 seed after a stellar 17-3 regular season. But the playoffs brought no easy wins - just grit, pressure moments, and unforgettable plays.

Their opening matchup was a Comeback against Aces Silver. Silver struck early, highlighted by a Home Run blast over the left field fence and into the ivy from Matt Murowski. Down late in the game, Blue rallied in the 6th. Key hits from Tommy Talty, Andrew Yasinski, and Mike Patricco brought the game within reach. Then Jeff Paszkewicz delivered a clutch triple to deep left, putting Blue ahead 4–3. A sac fly by Kevin DelleDonne capped the inning.

In the top of the 7th, with two runners on and no outs, Matt Miranda made a spectacular catch in deep left field to stop Silver's momentum.

In round 2, Blue rallied in bottom 7th against Aces Gold for back to back come back Wins.

Aces Gold was led by Dave King and anchored by the pitching of Adam Nord.

Gold led 4–3 heading into the bottom of the 7th, but Blue once again rose to the occasion. A single by Yasinski, another by Patricco, and a strategic intentional walk to Jeffrey Carrier set the stage for Evan Shanahan. Shanahan steps to the plate, with his entire family and teammates rooting him on, delivered a clutch screaming line drive over the center fielders head for a walk-off double securing the victory and sending Blue to the next round.

In the next round, Blue squared off against Aces Red, captained by Matt Deanna. The bats came alive, and the team notched a solid 8-3 victory, with home runs from Kevin DelleDonne town.

and Mike Patricco leading the way.

The Championship Game against Aces Red was a true battle. Red struck first with a lead off double from Rob DiGiacomo. Dan Clark fires a single to left field scoring DiGiacomo to give Red the early lead.

PJ Jennings ripped a line drive to deep center field. Red pushed for another run, but center fielder Jeffrey Carrier fielded it cleanly and fired a strike to the cut off, Tommy Talty, who relayed a laser to catcher Kevin DelleDonne. A bang-bang play at the plate ended with DelleDonne slapping on the tag, and umpire Chris delivering his classic punch out call.

Red's defense held Aces Blue to 2 run across two innings, but the tides turned in the bottom of the third. Nick Barbera sparked the offense with a leadoff single, igniting a rally. Timely hits from Talty, Paszkewicz, and Kevin DelleDonne pushed Blue ahead.

By the fifth, Aces Blue held a 4–2 lead, but Red wasn't done yet. With runners on second and third, the pressure was mounting. Pitcher Jeremy Alarva, always calm under pressure, delivers a perfectly placed pitch that clips the front edge of the plate - called strike 3 to end the inning! In the final inning Alarva stayed poised and delivered 2 more strikeouts, helping Aces Blue clinch the championship with a 6-2 victory!

LEVI CORY HOUSE VILLAGE SHOP OPENS

The Village Shop located in the Mountainside Restoration Committee's Levi Cory House will be open on most Saturdays from 11am-3pm beginning Saturday, September 6, 2025. Additional hours will be announced prior to the December holidays.

The circa 1818 Levi Cory House, which was moved to Constitution Plaza nine years ago, was originally located at the corner of New Providence Road and Mountain Avenue. The house was the location of the first Children's Country Home, during the 1890s, before expanding to its current location as the Children's Specialized Hospital. After years of repair, renovation and restoration, the Levi Cory House now opens as a Museum for Children's Interests and the Village Shop. Recently, a shaded patio was added to the rear of the house, a second porch was added as there was one on the original house, and plumbing and a rest room have been added thanks, in part, to funds from the Watts Mountainside Community Foundation.

The Village Shop serves as a fund raiser for the continued restoration and maintenance of the Levi Cory House and maintenance of the Deacon Andrew Hetfield House. The Shop has been restocked with many new items for the home and for gift-giving - home décor, jewelry, antique and vintage items, furniture pieces and many

interesting items and curiosities. Stop by to browse and you may find something for yourself or for gift-giving. Purchases benefit the Mountainside Restoration Committee.

The Levi Cory House and Deacon Andrew Hetfield House are located at Constitution Plaza (Watchung Ave., off Birch Hill Rd.) adjacent to the Mountainside Library. The Mountainside Restoration Committee is a 501(c)(3) charity and a committee of volunteers whose purpose is to maintain the Deacon Andrew Hetfield House, restore and maintain the Levi Cory House and collect and save historical Mountainside information and items from destruction. 

During National Military Appreciation Month and beyond, SCORE mentors offer resources for veterans to start and grow their entrepreneurial enterprises.

Veterans' training, resolve and fortitude to overcome challenges make them the ideal entrepreneur. They soar as small business owners. According to research, 80 percent of the 1.7 million veteran-owned business owners consider themselves successful. The small business fiveyear survival rate for veterans is double that of the non-veteran population.

Data from the U.S. Small Business Administration has shown that small business owners with an established mentor have twice the success rate – 70 percent versus 35 percent – as those who do not have a mentor.

In conjunction with National Military Appreciation Month in May, SCORE, a national nonprofit organization that assists small businesses, has developed specific resources for use by its 10,000 mentors nationally in mentoring veterans.

The SCORE Veterans Small Business Resource Guide features veterans-specific resources to offer insight on developing a business plan, securing funding, starting a business, buying an existing business, buying a franchise, connecting with one of SCORE's volunteer mentors, and gaining a better understanding of business through webinars and

"Volunteering at SCORE is my way of showing appreciation to those who helped and guided me during my career while sharing my background and experience to help entrepreneurs succeed," said SCORE Mid-Atlantic Regional Vice President Ed Coleman. "While I enjoy working with all SCORE clients, as a U.S. Army veteran, I particularly enjoy working with veterans to translate their military experience into entrepreneurship. Helping clients realize their

dreams is very gratifying and the essence of the SCORE mission."

SCORE Central Jersey Chapter Chair Nancy Verduin said mentors continually expand their knowledge base to better assist veterans on their entrepreneurial journey.


"Military transitioning from active duty have different needs than civilians in terms of starting a business," said Verduin. "It's wonderful to have veterans' resources at our volunteers' fingertips to aid in mentoring our service men and women."

Veterans account for about 10 percent of SCORE's client base. Veterans own 10 percent of small businesses and 14 percent of franchises. Since franchisors have a defined plan of what the business should entail, veterans represent the perfect franchisee given their ability to effectively execute plans as intended.

Nationally, veterans own nearly 2 million businesses, employing more than 5 million Americans, and generating more than \$1 trillion in annual income. Of those, 40 percent of veteran-owned businesses generate more than \$500,000 in annual revenue.




