## WERE THERE PIRATES IN NEW JERSEY?

Begin celebrating the 250th Anniversary of the American Jersey, a non-profit women's club founded in 1893. Revolution by learning the little-known history of New Jersey's Privateers and the part they played in the war.

The Sea Dogs, a group of privateer re-enactors, will bare their cutlasses at historic Twin Maples in Summit on Saturday, October 4 in two shows at 2 and 3 p.m. History buffs and the whole family will enjoy a brief lecture, exhibits of privateer artifacts and musical renditions of old sea shanties. Will the British arrive to chase the brave privateers? Come and see!

Tickets are available online at www.fortnightlyclub.org/ events-1/nj-privateers-the-american-revolution. Ticket prices are \$15 per adult and \$5 per child (3-12). Seating is limited. Free parking. No strollers, please.

The program takes place at Twin Maples, 214 Springfield Avenue, Summit, a site on both the New Jersey and National Historic Registers. The Twin Maples estate was built in 1908 in the Colonial Revival style. Its facade is reminiscent of the White House. The estate is owned by the Fortnightly Club of New

Proceeds benefit Twin Maples' historic preservation.

Later, on October 4 at 5 p.m. the Fortnightly Club of Summit will host a Colonial Tavern Night fundraiser featuring authentic colonial drinks and music with a colonial inspired appetizer and dessert buffet, featuring the Regimental Brewmeister and the Ministers of Apollo. Tickets for this event are available at fortnightlyclub.org for \$65 per person. Proceeds benefit masonry repairs of the Twin Maples terrace.

The Fortnightly Club has a full calendar planned for the coming year including a Designer Fashion ReSale event, a Twin Maples Ghost Hunt with New Jersey Paranormal, a Holiday Ceramics Workshop, breakfast or brunch with Santa at Twin Maples on December 6 and 7, the Battle of the Bubblies, Baking at Twin Maples and a Tranquility Workshop. 

## FORMER MAYOR WHITMAN'S VISIT TO CITY HALL

### City of Summit

A decades-old mission brought a familiar face back to Summit City Hall in July, as former Mayor Janet Whitman (1988 to 1995) returned to complete a heartfelt chapter of the city's history, one she began during the construction of City Hall 30 years ago.

Whitman, the first woman ever elected mayor of Summit, was instrumental in the planning and development of the current City Hall building, which opened in 1996. But she didn't just help build a government center. She planted the seeds for future generations of civic leaders.

"I knew I had to finish this project," she said with a laugh, as she sat down at her old desk in the Mayor's office, pulling out the stationery. "It's been on my mind that these letters have to get written."

As part of her original vision, Whitman had

two time capsules created during construction. They are scheduled to be opened in 2049 and 2099, marking the 150th and 200th anniversaries of Summit's incorporation as a city. Tucked inside each are scavenger hunts designed by Whitman to lead future mayors and council members to a hidden gift and personal letter from her.

This week, joined by former Common Council member Phyllis Sank, Whitman returned to City Hall to complete those letters, adding a final, personal touch to a visionary project she began more than a generation ago.


Now a resident of Austin, Texas, Whitman says Summit will always be home. During her visit, she toured the City Hall building she helped bring to life, including the Janet Whitman Community Room, which is currently undergoing a facelift after 30 years of service.

She also spent time in the law library, rekindling memories of her time in office.

Current Mayor Elizabeth Fagan presented Whitman with a ceremonial key to the city in recognition of her lasting impact, not only as a leader but as a trailblazer. Whitman's historic election as Summit's first female mayor set a precedent that continues today. Three of the five mayors who followed her have also been women.

"Mayor Whitman didn't just shape our city in the 1990s. She ensured her influence would echo through the 21st century and beyond," said Mayor Fagan. "Thanks to her, future leaders will not only discover her gifts but be reminded of the responsibility and inspiration that comes with public service."

As Summit looks ahead to its next 75 years, Janet Whitman has ensured its future leaders will be connected to their city's past.



At the September luncheon, three recent alumnae of TECH TREK will share their experiences and how those experiences influenced their interest in STEM.

The luncheon will also honor Erna Hoover, a dear friend, long-time member, and past president of the Summit College Club. Dr. Hoover, who was the first woman technical department head at Bell Labs, has several important patents to her name and has been inducted in the National Inventors Hall of Fame.

Many in the broader local community are familiar with the Summit College Club through its annual Book Sale, which takes place each spring in nearby New Providence. The community at large contributes by donating books, by volunteering to assist with the event, and by purchasing books at the sale. The Summit College Club Foundation also provided scholarship funds to women enrolling in a local community college after a break in their education. This program, which began last year, is designed to encourage women to continue

pursuing higher education.
