





honors the caregiving qualities of canine website, and registration is now live for the companions while raising critical funds for cancer research and support services especially here in New Jersey.



Course will be offered by the Union County Chapter of NAMI. The course will meet in person starting on Thursday evening October 9th and meet each Thursday from 7:00 to 9:30 p.m. over a consecutive 8-week period in Scotch Plains. The course is free-of-charge, with all necessary materials furnished at no cost to participants.

The course is specifically for the parents, siblings, spouses/partners, teen-age and adult children, and significant others of individuals with severe and persistent mental illness. The program is not appropriate for individuals who, themselves, suffer from one of the major mental disorders. NAMI members who have completed intensive training will teach.





In 2024 alone, Caring Contact Listeners answered over 21,000 calls, serving as a lifeline for anyone in need - no matter the reason for their call.


