FRAZEE HOUSE FALL ACTIVITIES AND PUMPKIN PATCH

Fanwood-Scotch Plains Rotary Club

There is an exciting line-up of Fall activities scheduled at the Frazee House Park in Scotch Plains throughout October. The site will be decorated for Halloween and the Great Pumpkin Patch will be back for its eight year! Hundreds of pumpkins will be available, and they'll be sold every day from 11am to dusk throughout the month of October.

During the weekend of October 18th and 19th there will be games for children, a Big Bake sale and many photo opportunities. These will begin on Saturday October 18th at 11 a.m. The Big Bake Sale will be back for the second year and will offer a wide variety of sweet treats including brownies, cookies, cupcakes and fall specialties. Additionally, the Frazee House will participate in Union County's annual "Four Centuries in a Weekend". Representatives will be at the Frazee site between 12 - 5 p.m. on both days with brochures, bookmarks, and an internal tour of the renovated areas of the house. History buffs can note that the Frazee House is one of the stops on the Battle of Short Hills Historic Trail as well as being renowned for the legendary confrontation between General Cornwallis and Aunt Betty Frazee.

On October 24th and 25th, the popular Ghost Walking tours will be back at the Frazee House. The pre-Halloween tours will be conducted by renowned psychic-medium Jane Doherty. Each presentation will begin with a short orientation at the restored Frazee homestead, including details about the spirit world. The 90-minute tours will proceed with a walk along the property, stopping at each "ghost hangout" to reveal the stories and secrets there. There are two tours on 10/24 at 6 p.m. and 7:45 p.m., and three tours on 10/25 at 5 p.m., 6:45 p.m. and 8:30 p.m.

Finally, October activities will end with the first ever séance at the Frazee

House, held in one of the newly renovated rooms. There will be only one session at 7 p.m. on November 1st. Seating will be limited. The séance will be led by renowned psychic-medium Jane Doherty.

All proceeds will go toward completing the renovation of the historic Frazee house. The October activities are a great opportunity for the community to visit the site and see it for themselves. OSBORN CANNONBALL HOUSE MUSEUM

The Osborn Cannonball House Will Be Open For Scotch Plains Day and for Four Centuries in a Weekend.

The Osborn Cannonball House Museum, located at 1840 Front Street in Scotch Plains, will be open to the public on Sunday, October 5th from 11:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. and for Four Centuries in a Weekend on Saturday, October 18, 2025, and Sunday, October 19, 2025 from 12:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. both days.

The museum will feature a display entitled "NJ Passengers Aboard the RMS Titanic," which will include replicas of the actual items used aboard the ship. From the museum's vast antique clothing collection, mannequins will be dressed in "Titanic era," or Edwardian, clothing. This display will have clothing representing the three classes aboard the ship.

Costumed docents will give tours of the 1750 home of the Osborn family, who witnessed and played a role in the Revolutionary War and the founding of the town of Scotch Plains. For the Four Centuries in a Weekend event, there will also be a children's craft in our craft tent along with an early Halloween treat!

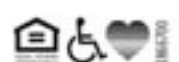

AMERICAN REPERTORY BALLET PRESENTS THE RETURN OF STIEFEL & KOBORG’S GISELLE

American Repertory Ballet (ARB) opens its 2025/26 season at the New Brunswick Performing Arts Center (NBPAC) with the highly anticipated return of Ethan Stiefel and Johan Kobborg’s acclaimed adaptation of the classic ballet Giselle. Presented Friday, October 10, 2025 through Sunday, October 12, 2025, Giselle tells the story of a young woman who dies of a broken heart—only to confront, and eventually forgive, her beloved from beyond the grave.

Originally choreographed in 2012 for the Royal New Zealand Ballet under Stiefel's artistic leadership, Giselle was initially restaged and partially redesigned specifically for ARB at NBPAC in 2022 by the award-winning team of Howard Jones (Scenic Designer), Natalia Stewart (Costume Designer), and Joseph R. Walls (Lighting Designer). Giselle is celebrated as being “[s]uperbly coached, curated, and danced,” says The Ballet Herald’s Nadia Vostrikov. “ARB’s Giselle is everything the original had and more.”

Featuring emotionally powerful and technically stunning performances, this moving production will no doubt get audiences in the Halloween spirit via this haunting tale of love, betrayal, and the supernatural.
