STUDENTS AND STAFF CELEBRATE THE 'WEEK OF RESPECT'

One highlight was the reading of the book, "How Full Is Your Bucket?" The objective of the story is for students to reflect on how their actions can positively impact others.

On lead vocals is Rae Simone who brings a background rooted in Blues, Motown, Jazz, R&B and Soul, with Aretha Franklin and Ray Charles as major influences. Her vocals have been featured in Rolling Stone article, Weed Mike, a conversation with Mike Tyson. Her single, "All I've Got " has been receiving critical acclaim since its release in 2022. She and Robert have a new single together, "Maybe You Will Someday." Rounding out the rhythm section are veterans, Ricky Martinez on drums, Rob Cookman on keys, and Steve Gelfand on bass. All have toured and recorded with some of the biggest names in music including, Donald Fagen, Al Green, Blondie, Levon Helm, Dr. John, Chuck Berry, Pete Seeger, Odetta, Al Cooper, Steven Van Zandt...the list goes on and on. The band adds their own unique interpretations to traditional blues classics, as well as performing many of their own compositions. With searing slide guitar, exceptional vocals, and a rhythm section of seasoned veterans, they are known for jawdropping, entertaining performances. Also adding

Salem Roadhouse Café presents Robert Hill to the show, are original, humorous, animated music videos produced by Robert, that are shown during the LIVE performance! Not to be missed!




