## **TURKEY TROT 5K FINDS NEW HOME WITH FIRE COMPANY**

A beloved township tradition is getting a fresh start. The annual Green Brook Turkey Trot 5K, long organized by Joe Patanella's Green Brook Racing and sponsored by the Green Brook PBA, will now be run by the Green Brook Fire Company.

When Patanella decided to retire Green Brook Racing, the future of the Thanksgiving race was uncertain. That's when the Green Brook Fire Company stepped forward, seeing the event as a perfect way for the Fire Company to stay active in the community, raise funds, and keep the tradition alive.

Bring the entire family, and leave the excuses at home! You can run, you can walk, you can even bring a stroller! The course is a USATF certified 5k course. All pre-registered participants will receive a t-shirt, and top 3 male and female times in each age group will receive awards. The festive event will feature DJ music, fire trucks on display, and more!

It keeps a cherished Green Brook tradition alive and gives our volunteers another way to connect with residents while supporting the work they do year-round," Searfoss said.

Race Committee chairperson Steve Pokk is excited for the event. "As a new firefighter and someone who loves fitness, we see the Turkey Trot as the perfect way to bring people together for a fun, healthy event while also supporting the Fire Company. We're excited to put our own energy into it and keep this tradition running for years to come and are so grateful to Joe and the PBA for the years of hard work that have gone into this event to build it into what it is today." Runners can expect the same festive spirit the event is known for and will feature a new firefighter turkey race t-shirt! The race will be held on Thanksgiving morning.

## D.A.R. SPOTLIGHT **ON HISTORY**

the American Revolution (DAR) were invited to assist the Green Brook Cultural, Heritage & Historic Preservation Committee and the Green Brook Historical Society with general cleaning and maintenance tasks at the historic Dr. John Historic Preservation Committee/Green Brook Vermeule House. The goal was to prepare for an open house the following weekend.

Constructed in 1799, the Georgian colonial- House. style farmhouse on Rock Avenue in Green Brook was open to the public as a stop on Somerset County's Journey Through the Past history tour, October 11-12. Volunteers dusted and swept inside the house while others raked and cleared the property.

the perfect opportunity to increase awareness of events that took place in this area during the Martha Washington and another colonial American Revolution," said DAR Chapter Regent Nancy Stoll, one of the volunteers. "We had Continental Army and militia encampments, skirmishes with the British, the Battle of the Short School helped at both sites, guiding visitors Hills, and the many contributions of area residents, including the Vermeule family, to the American cause.

"Events such as Journey Through the Past highlight local history and the importance of preserving historic sites," Stoll said. During the event, Elizabeth Snyder-Continental Chapter DAR hosted a history display at Washington Rock State Park in Green Brook, one of the 34 stops on the history tour.

The DAR is a nonprofit, nonpolitical service organization open to women 18 and older who are descended from a man or woman who aided the cause of American independence. 


