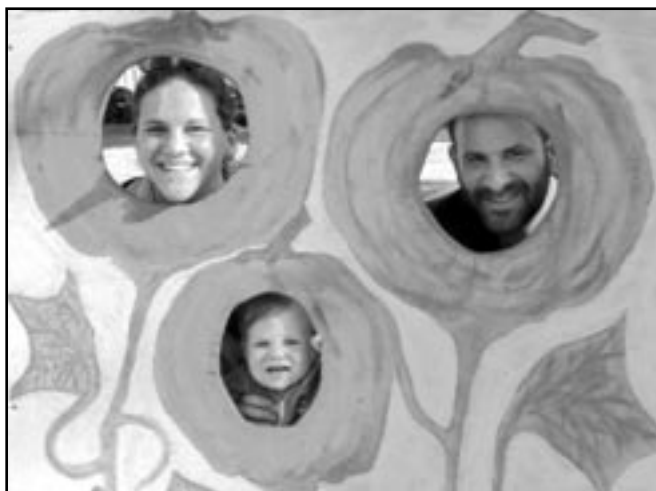
Borough of Roseland

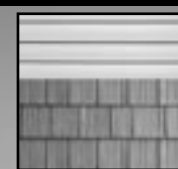

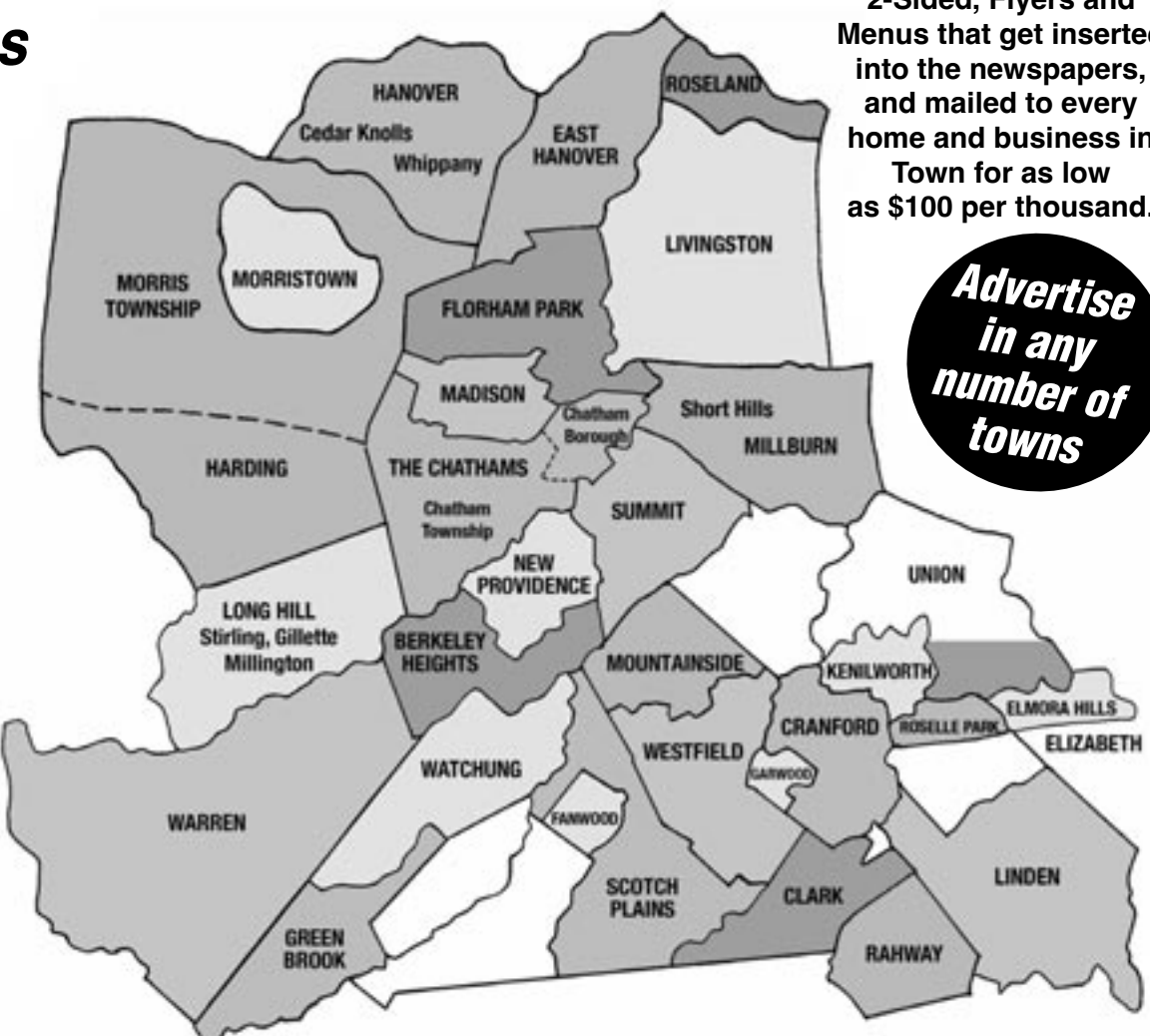
