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The New Providence Boy Scouts and the Community Service Association (CSA) are collaborating once again to collect food items and monetary donations for New Providence families and to stock the Starfish food pantry during the Thanksgiving season. The Scouting for Food Drive began in 1988 as a national Boy Scout initiative focused on collecting non-perishable items and providing resources to address hunger in local communities. Approximately 900,000 people utilize food banks. In New Jersey, one in five children and one in twelve households with seniors experience food insecurity.



HOW YOU CAN HELP:

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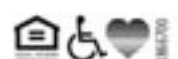

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VETERAN’S DAY REMEMBRANCE - NOV. 11

New providence American Legion Post#433

Veterans, family and friends are cordially invited to attend the Eleventh-Hour Service at DeCorso Center, located at 15 Fourth Street, New Providence, Doors open at 10:30 a.m., on Tuesday, November 11, 2025.

This day 106 years ago, commemorates the cessation of hostilities during WWI between Allied and German forces at "the Eleventh Hour on the Eleventh Day of the Eleventh Month" 1918. After four years of bitter fighting, the Great War was finally over. The Armistice was signed at 5am in a railway carriage in the forest of Compiègne, France on November 11, 1918. Six hours later at 11 a.m. the war ended.

The American Legion chartered and incorporated by Congress in 1919 as "the patriotic organization devoted to mutual helpfulness and social change for hundreds of benefits for our veterans and the important programs for our children and youth".

Doors at the Post Home will open at 10:30 a.m., please be there before 10:45 a.m. so all are settled in for the events of the day. The American Legion Post#433 members will lead an inspiring short service promptly at 11:11 a.m. to remind us of that momentous occasion as we also honor our local Veterans lost during 2024.

Food provided by local restaurants and establishments will be served. Our New

Providence Senior Citizens Club members will also provide desserts. And there will be music by our local vocalists, Kathy Martin and Mary Damato, "The Cover Girls". A Musical Tribute with service anthems, songs of the 'American Song Book' as well as favorite songs of the 1940s through 1970s.

We hope that you will join us for this occasion

LIONS CLUB HOSTS LINC AT OCT MEETING

Aidan Barth and Abigail Franco, co-founders of LINC spoke to the New Providence Lions Club at their October 8, 2025 meeting about the programs they offer. LINC (Linking Initiative for Neighborhood Change) was founded in 2022 by Aidan Barth and Abigail Franco when they were students at NPHS. LINC offers a Resource Pantry program and a School Pantry program.

The Resource Pantry - Located at the United Methodist Church here in New Providence, the LINC Resource Pantry provides local families in need with a variety of essential items every

month. On average, families walk away with between 40-50 lbs of food, hygiene products and cleaning supplies at each distribution.

The School Pantries - LINC launched the SchoolFuel Program in the NP School District to combat food insecurity. It offers students easy, anonymous access to a variety of fresh fruits, breakfast and lunch items as well as easy to make meal kits for students to take home, if they need.

The New Providence Lions Club was founded in May, 1969, supports local community groups through service projects, local high school scholarships as well as outright donations that benefit the community.

The weekend event benefits the preservation of Twin Maples, 214 Springfield Avenue, Summit, a property on the New Jersey and National Historic Registers. The house was designed and built by New York architect Alfred F. Norris in the Colonial Revival style in 1908 and resembles the White House. The Fortnightly Club purchased the property in 1949. Today, Twin Maples serves as a clubhouse and hosts many community events and fundraisers. The Fortnightly Club of Summit, a non-profit organization founded in 1893, offers women camaraderie and a full calendar of interesting events and volunteer opportunities. The Club supports the preservation of Twin Maples, education, the arts and humanitarian efforts. For over thirty-years the Club has awarded annual scholarships to deserving young, local women. 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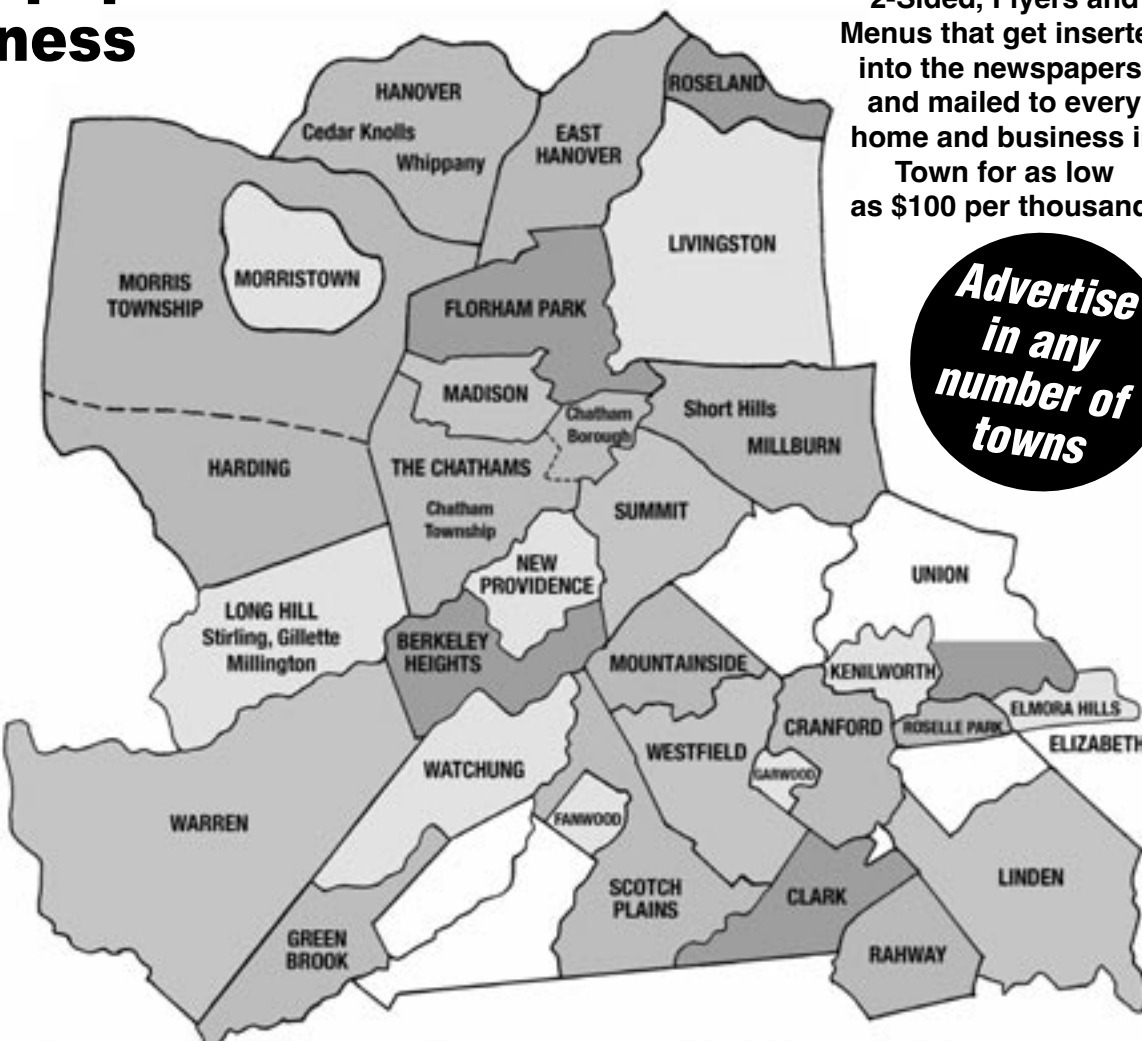

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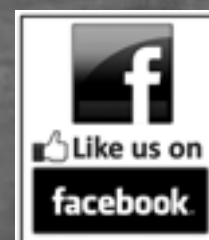
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
