LT Rotella is warfare qualified as an Intelligence Officer and was awarded the Information Dominance Warfare Officer badge as well as Joint Service Commendation Medal, Navy & Marine Corps Achievement Medal, Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal among many others. Recently retired from Federal Law Enforcement, he is a Cranford resident along with his wife Lisa and two children Kelly and Daniel. LT Rotella is a lifetime member of the VFW Post #335 in Cranford and is also is an active member of the Elks Veteran Service Committee and the Italian American Police Society of New Jersey.

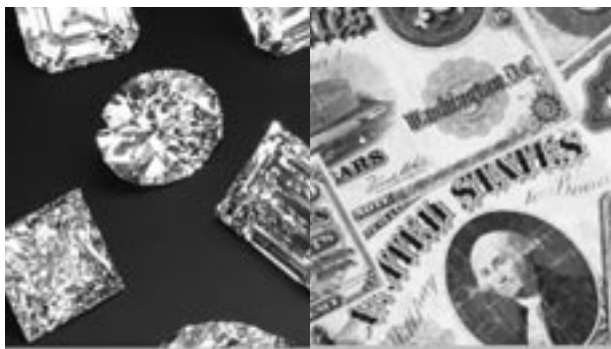
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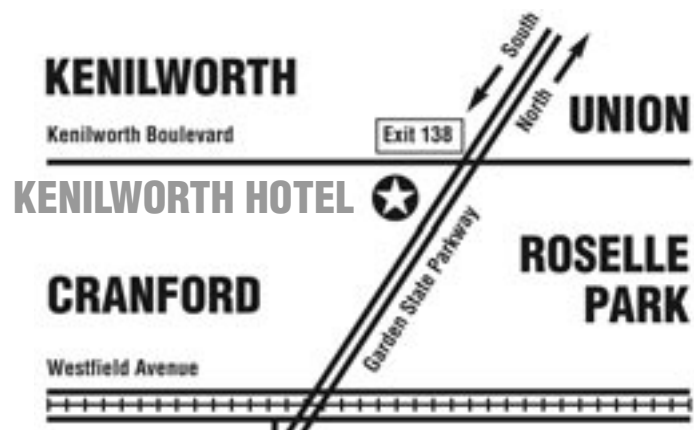
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FALL FARM DAY FUN AT THE LIBRARY

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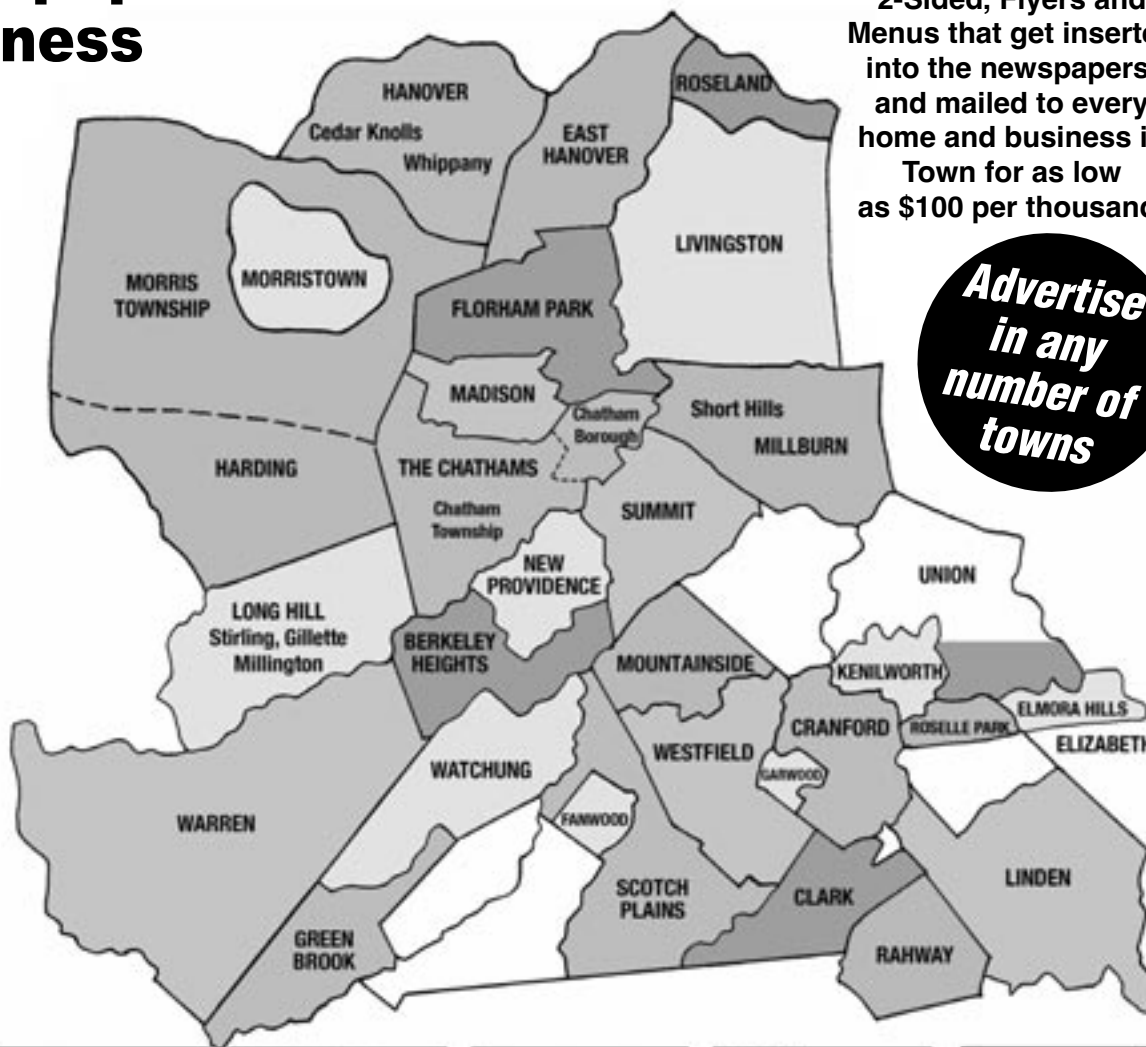
