





The set-up at Washington Rock had to be cancelled on Sunday, due to high winds and rain. Visitor turnout was good on Saturday at the Rock and very good at the Vermeule House on both days. General Washington, as portrayed by Sam Davis, was able to re-schedule his Sunday



appearance at the Rock and gave his presentation on Saturday afternoon. He was accompanied by Martha Washington and another colonial gentleman, all dressed in clothing from the time period.

Students from Watchung Hills Regional High School helped at both sites, guiding visitors through the Vermeule House and hosting a table at the Rock on Saturday, distributing brochures and handouts about the rich history of the Rock. Their assistance was greatly appreciated. Many thanks to Social Studies Supervisor, Anita Byk, who coordinated their participation in the event.

In November, the Dr. John Vermeule House will be open for tours as regularly scheduled on the 3rd Saturday of the month (11/15), from 10 a.m. – 12 noon. If you haven't toured the homestead yet, please join us. You will get an interesting glimpse of early 19th century life in your own township backyard!




