SCOUT REVITALIZES AMERICAN LEGION'S VETERANS MEMORIAL

Life Scout Sara Abraham-Winkler leads a community effort to honor local veterans and preserve history ahead of the nation's semiquincentennial.

In a heartfelt tribute to Millburn's veterans and community heritage, Life Scout Sara Abraham-Winkler of Scouting America Troop 19 has completed an extraordinary Eagle Scout Leadership Service Project revitalizing the Veterans Memorial at the American Legion Post 140 – Guy R. Bosworth. The effort restored one of Millburn's most sacred community spaces, honoring generations of local service members who secured our liberty.

Sara, a member of Troop 19 chartered at St. Rose of Lima Church in Short Hills, joined Scouting in 2020 and quickly distinguished herself as a leader and tireless volunteer. Her Scouting experiences have deepened her appreciation for service and sacrifice, particularly after marching in the New York City Veterans Day Parade at the invitation of the Alumni Association of the USS Intrepid. Standing alongside veterans in that parade reinforced for her that freedom is not free, inspiring her to dedicate her Eagle project to honoring those who served our nation and community.

Over the course of several days, Sara led a few dozen volunteers who collectively contributed more than 200 hours of dedicated work to restore the memorial grounds. Together they restored the historic World War I cannon, cleaned and repainted the grenade launcher, repainted the flagpole and raised new American and POW flags, carefully removed algae and lichen from engraved memorial bricks honoring Millburn's veterans, cleaned the concrete benches and the Veterans Memorial Path post, planted grass seed and refreshed the landscaping, and installed new river rock along the perimeter to enhance drainage and beautify the site. Every element of the project was completed with care, reverence, and gratitude for the sacrifices made by those memorialized there.

This effort was completed in partnership with Millburn 250, the township's celebration of the 250th anniversary of American independence.

Millburn 250 committee member and Sons of the American Legion Squadron 140 Commander Daniel Cannon praised her effort, noting, "As we celebrate Millburn 250 and the 250th anniversary of our nation's independence, Sara's work stands as a tribute to the generations who secured our freedom and a gift to those who will inherit it. Her leadership and dedication reflect the very spirit of service and patriotism that built this country over the last 250 years. Millburn is proud of her."

In reflecting on the project, Sara shared, "I am super grateful for all the volunteers, generous donors, and corporate sponsors, especially Rossi Paint Store in Millburn, Chatham Stone, and the Budweiser Corporation. I am also thankful for the American Legion, Millburn Township, and Millburn 250 for extending their confidence in me to tackle this project. Overall, I am super super proud of all the work we accomplished."



CIVIL AIR PATROL AWARD HONORS BILLY MITCHELL

Lone Eagle Composite Squadron of the Civil Air Patrol (CAP).

Recently, Cadet 2d Lt Priyanka Nair, of the Lone Eagle Composite Squadron, was presented with her Civil Air Patrol (CAP) Billy Mitchell Award by Capt. Adam Fitting, Commander, at the Morristown Armory, Morristown, NJ. She is the daughter of Mr. Nair and Mrs. Leju of Glen Ridge, NJ.

She served as a flight commander at TN Wing encampment and has given presentations on the importance of character and the Spittin' Kitten's Squadron history. She was named the honorable graduate at the NJ Ground Search & Rescue(GSAR) Summer School and qualified for GTM 3, 2, and UDF. She is a sophomore at Newark Academy on the Varsity basketball team. Outside of school, she enjoys playing and teaching violin.

The Billy Mitchell award, the second cadet milestone achievement, is earned after the successful completion of the first eight

to the achievements, the cadet must pass a comprehensive examination on aerospace and leadership and attend a Basic Encampment. Only about 15% of all Civil Air Patrol cadets achieve 18. For more information about the Lone Eagle the Billy Mitchell Award.

Billy Mitchell Cadets who enlist in the U.S. Air Force are promoted to E-3 (airman first class) instead of E-1 (airman basic) upon completion of basic military training. Billy Mitchell cadets who enlist in the Army, Navy, or Marine Corps are promoted to E-2 instead of E-1 upon completion of basic military training. Further, Billy Mitchell cadets who enlist in the US Coast Guard are promoted to E-3 (seaman) instead of E-1 (seaman recruit) upon completion of boot camp. Finally, they are considered favorably by the admission staff for selection to the AFROTC and the USAF Academy.

The Lone Eagle Composite Squadron meets on
