Firefighter Matt began by showing the students his uniform and equipment, explaining how each piece helps protect him while he's

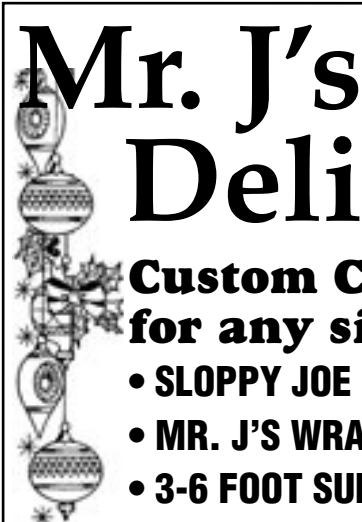

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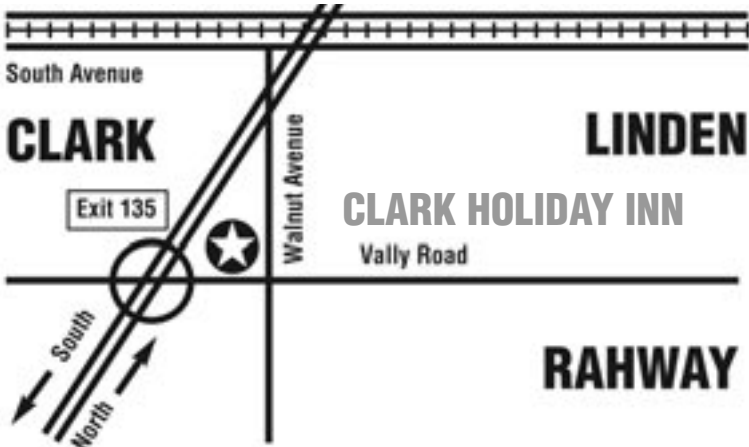


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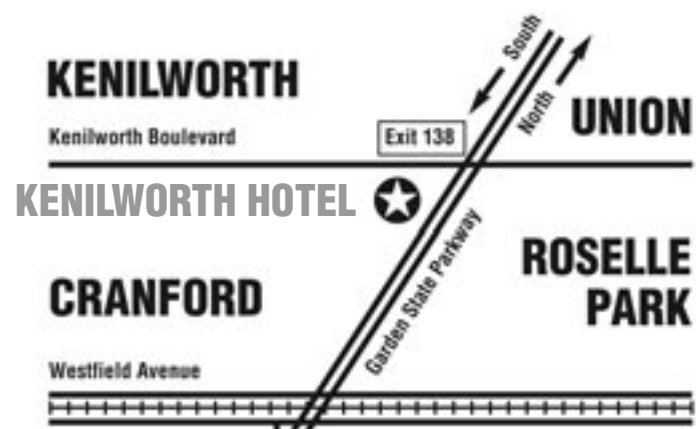
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CHARLES NEMETH SITS ON COUNTY AI PANEL

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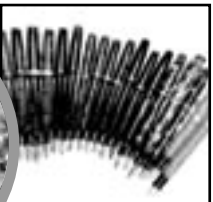
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AMER LEGION JIU JITSU TEAM WIN 2 MEDALS
