On Friday, November 28, for the 26th consecutive year, the Florham Park Rotary decorated the tree and placed it at the Florham Park Post Office at 187 Columbia Turnpike.

Each ornament on the tree holds local children's gift wishes. Most of the children are from Florham Park, East Hanover and other Morris County towns, many of whom are orphans or resource (aka foster) children. "The people of Florham Park do a fantastic job," said Rotarian Rexford Lyon, who helped to organize the annual event. "Some of these gifts are real needs, like diapers or a winter coat. Coloring books and toys are also common requests. The people of Florham Park really go above and beyond."

This effort is coordinated by the Florham Park Rotary through the East Morris office of the state Division of Child Protection and Permanency, formerly known as the DYFS.

More than 100 ornaments are filled with wishes and hang from the tree. They are a reminder that even in eastern Morris County, there are many children and families in need.

Amazing Grace Lutheran Church, 160 Ridgedale Avenue, Florham Park is galvanizing its parishioners to contribute for the second year in a row. This is especially appreciated this year as many families struggle.

Dave Kramer, Rotary club president, encourages residents to visit the Angel Tree at the Post Office, take a look at the ornaments, and see which gift request they can fulfill.

HISTORY OF THE ARMED FORCES OF AMERICA


In celebration of Veterans Day, on November 11, The Historical Society of Florham Park scheduled a "History of the Armed Forces of America" presentation.

Author Walter Choroszewski returned to Florham Park to present the program in the Akhoury Room of the Florham Park Library. He took the audience through key dates and facts of America's military from its Colonial beginning to the Armed Forces of today. His presentation started with the American Revolution for independence when the United States formally established Armed Forces for defense on land and sea. Walter "C" took us through the development and evolution of the US military branches of Army, Navy, Marines, Coast Guard, US Air

Force, right up to US Space Force.

He also shared the latest enlistment numbers of each branch of service.

Army 445,475, Navy 330,311, Marines 168,298, Coast Guard 40,590, Air Force 313, 615 and US Space Force 9,671.

The program included the Missions of each of the military branches and their theme songs. For example, "Anchors Aweigh" is the official song of the US Navy. Attached is the Mission statement of the United States Marines.

Veterans Day was officially named in 1954 under President Eisenhower. Originally celebrated as Armistice Day in 1919 under President Wilson, it marked the one-year anniversary of the end of World War 1. Veterans Day was created to mark a shift from honoring those who served in WWI to honoring all veterans.

Mr. Choroszewski is a New Jersey advocate and an avid photographer. He has published more

than 18 photographic books. Some may recall last November's presentation for The Historical Society of Florham Park – "First People: the New Jersey Connection". Commented Peter Nicolas, a vice president of The Historical Society of Florham Park "We will certainly invite Walter to return to Florham Park".

The Historical Society of Florham Park was founded by a group of women in 1935 to save and preserve the Little Red Schoolhouse and the history of the borough. Virtually all the artifacts in the museum were donated to and are the responsibility of the Historical Society. The Historical Society is a 501c3 non-profit organization.



ENROLLING IN MEDICARE AND UPDATING YOUR PLAN

Turning 65 marks eligibility for Medicare, a federal health insurance program designed for seniors and certain individuals with disabilities. While the system can be complex, resources are available to help beneficiaries navigate enrollment, updates, and plan changes to ensure their coverage continues to meet their needs.

Original Medicare consists of Part A (hospital insurance) and Part B (medical insurance). Part A covers hospital stays, skilled nursing facilities, home health, and hospice care. Part B focuses on outpatient care, doctor visits, preventive screenings, and therapies. While comprehensive, Original Medicare leaves gaps in coverage, which can be supplemented through Medigap policies. These help with deductibles, co-pays, and sometimes foreign travel coverage, offering flexibility and predictability.

Medicare Advantage (Part C), offered by private insurers, combines Parts A and B and often includes additional benefits like vision, dental, hearing, fitness programs, and lower premiums. These plans have out-of-pocket maximums, but often require use of in-network providers.

Prescription drug coverage (Part D) is also offered through private plans. Each plan has a formulary outlining covered medications, costsharing structures, and potential coverage gaps, though assistance programs like "Extra Help" exist for those with limited income. New Jersey also provides state assistance through PAAD and Senior Gold to help seniors manage prescription

drug costs.

For higher-income beneficiaries, Medicare applies IRMAA (Income-Related Monthly Adjustment Amount), which adds extra costs to Part B and D premiums based on IRS tax information.

Enrollment timing is crucial. While some may delay enrollment due to employer coverage, late enrollment penalties apply if coverage lapses without creditable insurance.

Every year, Medicare beneficiaries have an opportunity to review and adjust their coverage. The Annual Enrollment Period (October 15 – December 7) allows switching between Original Medicare and Advantage plans, adding or changing drug plans, or returning to Original Medicare. Any changes take effect January 1. Additionally, the Medicare Advantage Open Enrollment (January 1 – March 31) allows those in Advantage plans to switch or return to Original Medicare.

When evaluating options, beneficiaries should consider cost, provider networks, additional benefits, drug coverage, and changes in their health or medications.

Christ Church, Summit, NJ


