#### **ENROLLING IN MEDICARE AND UPDATING YOUR PLAN**

Turning 65 marks eligibility for Medicare, a federal health insurance program designed for seniors and certain individuals with disabilities. While the system can be complex, resources are available to help beneficiaries navigate enrollment, updates, and plan changes to ensure their coverage continues to meet their needs.

Original Medicare consists of Part A (hospital insurance) and Part B (medical insurance). Part A covers hospital stays, skilled nursing facilities, home health, and hospice care. Part B focuses on outpatient care, doctor visits, preventive screenings, and therapies. While comprehensive, Original Medicare leaves gaps in coverage, which can be supplemented through Medigap policies. These help with deductibles, co-pays, and sometimes foreign travel coverage, offering flexibility and predictability.

Medicare Advantage (Part C), offered by private insurers, combines Parts A and B and often includes additional benefits like vision, dental, hearing, fitness programs, and lower premiums. These plans have out-of-pocket maximums, but often require use of in-network providers.

Prescription drug coverage (Part D) is also offered through private plans. Each plan has a formulary outlining covered medications, costsharing structures, and potential coverage gaps, though assistance programs like "Extra Help" exist for those with limited income. New Jersey also provides state assistance through PAAD and Senior Gold to help seniors manage prescription

drug costs.

For higher-income beneficiaries, Medicare applies IRMAA (Income-Related Monthly Adjustment Amount), which adds extra costs to Part B and D premiums based on IRS tax information.

Enrollment timing is crucial. While some may delay enrollment due to employer coverage, late enrollment penalties apply if coverage lapses without creditable insurance.

Every year, Medicare beneficiaries have an opportunity to review and adjust their coverage. The Annual Enrollment Period (October 15 – December 7) allows switching between Original Medicare and Advantage plans, adding or changing drug plans, or returning to Original Medicare. Any changes take effect January 1. Additionally, the Medicare Advantage Open Enrollment (January 1 – March 31) allows those in Advantage plans to switch or return to Original Medicare.

When evaluating options, beneficiaries should consider cost, provider networks, additional benefits, drug coverage, and changes in their health or medications.







#### STUDENTS AND STAFF HONOR AMERICA'S HEROES ON VETERANS DAY

From morning announcements to spirited assemblies, from handwritten letters to solemn wreath-laying ceremonies, Linden Public Schools overflowed with patriotism and pride as students, staff, and veterans came together districtwide to honor those who have served our nation. The day was a moving tapestry of red, white, and blue — a living lesson in gratitude, history, and community spirit.

At School No. 1, Principal David Walker, who earlier led a spirited patriotic ceremony inside the school gymnasium, guided a group of students outdoors into the crisp November air for a solemn of remembrance moment alongside Superintendent Dr. Atiya Y. Perkins, Mayor Derek Armstead, city officials, and veterans from American Legion Post 102. Together, they gathered at the century-old World War I monument on Wood Avenue and East Gibbons Street — exactly 100 years to the day since the memorial tablets were first unveiled in 1925 to honor the borough and township residents who served in the Great War. As the wreath was gently placed at the base of the monument, students stood shoulder to shoulder with veterans, linking past and present in a powerful tribute to sacrifice. service, and the enduring spirit of Linden.

Across Hudson River in New York City, the largest student-run military organization in the nation, the Linden High School NJROTC, marched proudly in the 106th Annual New York City Veterans Day Parade, the largest Veterans Day event in the United States. The parade commemorated the 250th anniversary of the U.S. Army, Navy, and Marine Corps, three service branches born during the Revolutionary War. Dressed in precision uniforms, Linden's cadets

represented their city and district with honor, embodying the discipline and dedication that define America's armed forces.

delivery to the Menlo Park Veterans Home — carried words of gratitude and encouragement from the next generation to America's heroes.

Back in Linden, at School No. 10, patriotism filled the auditorium as Principal Wayne Happle, staff, and families gathered for a stirring Veterans Day Assembly that blended music, poetry, and appreciation.

The program began with Superintendent Perkins' inspiring remarks to the lively elementary school children.

"When I think of the service you provided, it was service before self," she told the veterans — and continued with students performing beloved patriotic classics. From the fifth graders' powerful rendition of The Star-Spangled Banner to the kindergartners beaming as they sing You're a Grand Old Flag, every performance radiated pride and purpose. The highlight came when former teacher Mrs. Linda Burt-Moquete delivered an emotional solo of God Bless the USA, her voice lifting the room in unity and gratitude.

Among the honorees were five veterans from Atria Senior Living in Cranford, who joined other distinguished guests. They included World War II heroes Edmund Fiorelli and Thomas O'Neil, and local service members such as Officer Raul Jordan and Officer Tavares of the Linden Police Department. Each received a certificate of appreciation, presented by students who beamed with admiration as they shook the hands of living history.

At McManus Middle School, patriotism took the shape of compassion as students spent their lunch periods writing more than 200 handwritten "Thank You" cards to honor those who served. The colorful, sincere messages — destined for

delivery to the Menlo Park Veterans Home — carried words of gratitude and encouragement from the next generation to America's heroes. "Each card is a small way to show our appreciation for the people who served our country," said Brenda Kaneaster, science teacher at McManus. "We're proud of our students for spreading kindness and letting our veterans know they're valued."

From the youngest kindergartner singing with pride to the high school cadets marching in one of America's most storied parades, Veterans Day 2025 in Linden Public Schools was more than a commemoration, it was a community united in purpose.

As Superintendent Perkins reflected, "When our students honor veterans, they're learning the true meaning of service, sacrifice, and citizenship. This is how we teach history — by living it."




