## TRY DRY JANUARY IN 2026

The CDC defines drinking in moderation by limiting intake to 2 drinks or less in a day for men or 1 drink or less in a day for women. Heavier drinking and long-term drinking can increase physical and mental problems. The concept of Dry January, wishing to cut down on your alcohol intake, or simply wanting to begin the new year with a clean slate by choosing not to drink beer, wine, or spirits for one month, appeals to someone who may have noticed a pattern that they're drinking a little bit more than they should, especially during the holidays.

### THERE ARE BENEFITS TO DRY JANUARY:

- You'll get a mood boost.
- You'll sleep more soundly.
- You might feel less bloated or even drop a few pounds.
- You'll save money.
- Your skin might look brighter.
- You'll have a stronger immune system.
- You'll feel better in the morning.
- You'll have a new relationship with alcohol.

A month may seem like a long time, but most people can be successful. Here are some tips for a successful Dry January:

Find a substitute non-alcoholic drink. For social situations, or when you crave a cocktail after a long day, reach for alcohol-free beverages like sparkling water, soda, or virgin beverages

(non-alcoholic versions of alcoholic drinks.)

Non-alcoholic beer or wine also is an option, but some brands still contain up to 0.5% alcohol by volume, so check the label.

Avoid temptations. Keep alcohol out of your house. When you are invited to someone's home, bring your non-alcoholic drinks with you.

Create a support group. Let friends and family know about your intentions and encourage them to keep you accountable. Better yet, enlist someone to do the challenge with you.

Use the Try Dry app. This free app helps you track your drinking, set personal goals, and offers motivational information like calories and money saved from not drinking. It's aimed at cutting back on or cutting out alcohol, depending on your choices.

Don't give up. If you slip up, don't feel guilty. Just begin again the next day.

If you found Dry January to be a positive experience, why not consider extending it a little longer or gradually decreasing your alcohol consumption? Embracing these small changes could lead to lasting improvements in overall health and well-being.

## FROM BASEMENT DREAM TO GLOBAL STAGE

Twenty seasons ago, the Continuo Arts Foundation began as a dream in a basement in Westfield, New Jersey - an idea fueled by a belief that music could shape lives, bridge generations, and carry local voices to the world's greatest stages. Today, that dream resonates far beyond its humble beginnings. As Continuo Arts enters its 20th season, it stands as a thriving conservatory of music in Summit, a cultural home where artistry, education, and community converge week after week.

Founded by Candace Wicke, Continuo Arts was built on a simple but powerful premise: that music education should be rigorous yet welcoming, ambitious yet deeply human. What began with a small circle of singers has grown into an organization that now serves more than 200 members and families each week from six counties, offering opportunity, inspiration, and excellence across generations.

### A CONSERVATORY WITH A COMMUNITY AT ITS HEART

At the core of Continuo Arts is its conservatory model - one that embraces both breadth and depth. The Foundation now supports 10 intergenerational choral programs, along with musical theater, opera, and comprehensive conservatory instruction for vocalists and instrumentalists. From young beginners discovering their first notes to seasoned musicians refining their craft, students learn side by side in an environment that values mentorship, collaboration, and lifelong musicianship.

This intergenerational spirit has become one of Continuo Arts' defining strengths. Children, teens, adults, and seniors rehearse under the same artistic umbrella, sharing not only music but perspective, discipline, and joy. It is a living example of how the arts can connect people across age and experience.

### UNPRECEDENTED STAGES, UNFORGETTABLE MOMENTS

Over the years, Continuo Arts has carried its music far beyond New Jersey, reaching milestones once thought unimaginable for a

community-based arts organization. Ensembles have performed in the Sistine Chapel, filled Carnegie Hall and Lincoln Center with sound, collaborated with musicians from around the world, and even opened for the Vienna Philharmonic. Highlights include working with Disney Theatrical on 42 performances of The Hunchback of Notre Dame at The Paper Mill Playhouse and participating in the launch of Disney's live action Lion King Live movie. The organization's story and mission were further amplified through a full-length PBS documentary, "Requiem For My Mother", bringing its impact to audiences nationwide. Each of these moments reflects not only artistic excellence, but the courage to dream big—and to prepare relentlessly so those dreams can be realized.

### A LANDMARK 20TH SEASON

The 20th anniversary season marks not a pause for reflection, but a bold step forward. Among its highlights is the launch of the Institute for Lifelong Learning at The Continuo Arts Foundation, expanding educational offerings for adult learners who seek growth, enrichment, and connection through music at every stage of life. Audience-favorite annual cabarets return, blending intimacy, storytelling, and vocal artistry,

while the season also welcomes a special guest emcee—Mrs. New Jersey—bringing added sparkle and celebration to the festivities. On the international stage, Continuo Arts will present three world premieres at Carnegie Hall, reaffirming its commitment to new music and living composers. The season culminates in an extraordinary performance tour of France, including a featured concert in the iconic Notre Dame Cathedral—a moment that symbolically mirrors the organization's journey from a basement rehearsal space to the world's most revered sanctuaries of music.

### LOOKING AHEAD

As The Continuo Arts Foundation begins its 20th season, its story is no longer just about where it has been, but about what it continues to make possible. Under the enduring artistic vision of Candace Wicke and a community united by purpose, Continuo Arts remains a place where dreams are nurtured, voices are strengthened, and music becomes a lifelong companion. From Westfield to Summit, from local rehearsals to global stages, Continuo Arts proves that when passion meets perseverance, a single dream can grow into a legacy that sings across generations - and around the world.

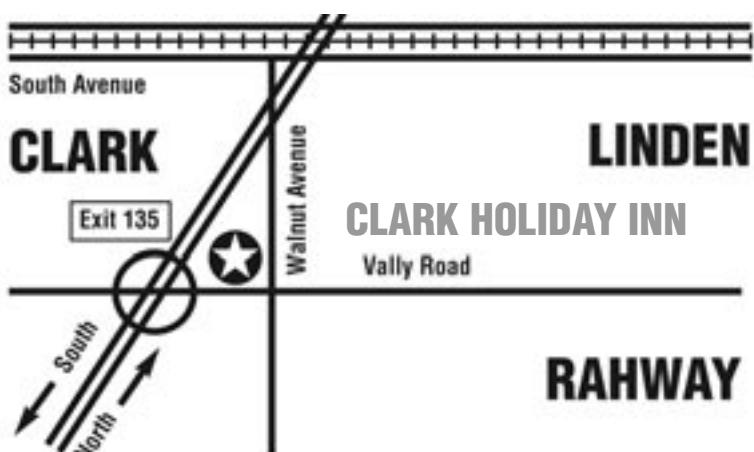

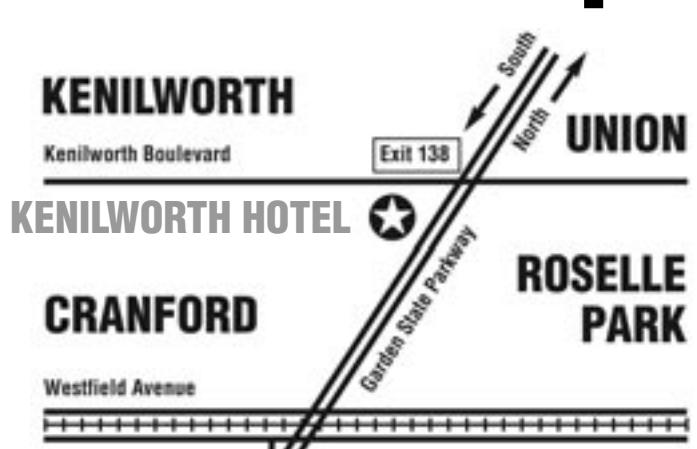

## STATE CANCELS LEGAL NOTICE MANDATE

We rarely ever hear about the government reducing taxes but it happened this year when New Jersey Governor Phil Murphy eliminated the mandate that legal notices must be printed in a newspaper.

The antiquated mandate is decades old and the cost for the advertising was paid for by public funds from municipalities, counties, school districts, and independent authorities. It was a lucrative business for the publications and more recently the majority of their revenue. Without the mandate the fear in the newspaper industry was that the publications relying on the legal advertising income will not survive.

In some cases the majority of content in the newspaper had been the legal ads. In question was the criteria for the mandate, i.e., were the publications meeting the required numbers of

paid subscriptions, and circulation.

The idea of doing away with the mandate, though practical, was considered political poison. No lawmaker wanted to be deemed responsible as the cause for newspapers' closures and people losing their jobs. During the Governor Christi administration the Star Ledger warned that doing away with the mandates would cause 250 weekly newspapers to close.

What brought about the change is a successful lawsuit filed by the County of Warren which named the Star Ledger and Daily Record as defendants. The suit may have been the last straw in the Ledger's decision to stop printing the newspaper in January of 2025.

Local governments will now be required to publish their legal notices on their websites.
