WARM SLEEPWEAR AND BOOKS COLLECTED FOR HOLIDAYS

Linden Public Schools

School No. 9 collected 430 pairs of pajamas during its annual Pajama Drive, a weeks-long effort aimed at providing children in need with warm sleepwear and books during the holiday season. The drive ran from Oct. 27 through Dec. 5, with a schoolwide goal of collecting 496 pairs of pajamas, one more than last year's total of 495. While the final count fell short of that benchmark, each donated pair will be matched with a book from Scholastic and distributed through the school's longtime charitable partnership.

The collection period concluded with a schoolwide Pajama Day on Thursday, Dec. 4, marking the close of the drive and offering students and staff an opportunity to celebrate the effort.

According to fourth-grade teacher Theresa Rogakos, the Pajama Drive has been a staple of the school's service initiatives for more than a decade.

“Since 2008, our school community has proudly partnered with Beyond Bedtime (formerly Pajama Program) through Scholastic initiatives,” Rogakos said. “What began at Linden Public School No. 5 and continues at School No. 9 has grown into a lasting tradition that provides comfort and connection to children in need.”

This year's total brings the school community's cumulative donations to 3,326 pairs of pajamas and 3,313 books. School officials said the annual drive reinforces lessons of service, empathy, and community engagement, particularly during the holiday season.

SHARP-SHINNED HAWK RELEASED BACK TO WILD

This feisty Sharp-shinned Hawk was admitted on 12/22 after being found in a yard in Warren following a window strike. On intake, the hawk had bloody nares and mouth, consistent with head trauma often seen after collisions. The nares are a bird's nostrils, located near the base of the beak, and bleeding there often points to head or facial trauma from collisions.

With supportive care and time to heal, this "Sharpie" as we call them, made great progress and was moved to an outside flight cage on 12/28/25. After proving strong, steady flight and good awareness, the hawk was successfully released back to the wild on 1/2/2026.

Sharp-shinned Hawks are incredibly fast and agile forest hunters, built to weave through dense trees while chasing small birds. That same speed and focus, however, can make them especially vulnerable to window strikes when reflective glass looks like open sky or habitat.

Remember, small changes matter, adding window decals is a simple way to help.



We can create opportunities for story sharing, connection, and support, which is what Imagine's volunteer facilitators do night after night in Imagine's support groups.

Many who have attended Imagine's trainings have shared that they use the skills gained during the training in their everyday lives as they support and connect with others. One volunteer shared this about her training experience: "This training gave me skills that I didn't even know I needed. What I gained from taking part in this facilitator training will assist me in every relationship I have. I've already learned how to be a better listener to my children, to my husband, and to my friends...this training was life-changing!"

The staff at Imagine are so pleased to welcome these compassionate new volunteers to their incredible community of facilitators that's now over 140 strong! 

HISTORIC APPLE DISTINGUISHED DISTRICT DISTINCTION CELEBRATION

Linden Public Schools marked a historic milestone on Thursday, December 11, as more than 30 educators, technology leaders, and administrators from across New Jersey joined district and city officials for a first-of-its-kind celebration recognizing Linden as an Apple Distinguished District.

The day unfolded as a vivid showcase of student creativity and districtwide innovation,

featuring student-produced livestreams connecting four schools, guided Apple-integrated classroom tours, and an in-depth Q&A with student media teams. Together, these moments offered visitors a rare, behind-the-scenes look at the digital learning ecosystem powering one of New Jersey's most diverse and forward-thinking school districts.

Linden Public Schools officially earned the Apple Distinguished District designation on

September 16, 2025, after Soehl Middle School became the final school among the district's 11 buildings to receive individual Apple Distinguished School status. With all schools achieving recognition, the district qualified for the rare districtwide honor — solidifying Linden's 13-year Apple journey as a fully realized, systemwide model of innovation, creativity, and technology-driven learning.

Superintendent Dr. Atiya Y. Perkins said the distinction reflects both a long-term vision and the collective commitment of students, teachers, and administrators.

"This is more than a milestone. It is a message," Superintendent Perkins said. "It says that a large, diverse, urban district like Linden can lead on a global stage, and that our students are fully capable of innovating, creating, and achieving at the highest levels."



DAR LAUNCHES AMERICA 250 CELEBRATION

America's semi-quincentennial year has arrived and the Daughters of the American Revolution (DAR) kicked off the celebration by honoring their patriot ancestors at the Somerset County Park Commission's Festival of Trees.

"Celebrating America 250 by Honoring Our Patriot Ancestors" was the theme of the tree hosted by Elizabeth Snyder-Continental Chapter DAR at the Environmental Education Center in Basking Ridge during December. The 8-ft. tall tree was decorated with red, white and blue lights and the profiles of the Revolutionary War ancestors of DAR chapter members.

"We hope that our tree helped to raise awareness of the individuals who established our nation," said Regent Nancy Stoll. "Our members are descended from patriots in nine states who served in a variety of ways. We need to remember the sacrifices that they all made for our freedom."

Featured on the tree were mini profiles of 50 patriot ancestors and their service. They included a captain of the Lexington Alarm in

Massachusetts, a river boat pilot, people who donated money or supplies, a brigadier general of the light dragoons, a spy, a president of the provincial Congress, and farmers who joined their local militia.

To join the DAR, women need to document their descent from a man or woman who aided the cause of American independence. Some prospective members have mapped out their family tree, but others know only that they have an ancestor who served in the Revolution. In that case, the DAR will assist them with research and the application process.

The DAR is a non-profit, non-political women's service organization dedicated to promoting patriotism, preserving American history, and securing America's future through better education. There are currently 190,000 members in 3,000 chapters in the U.S. and several nations abroad.

During National Military Appreciation Month and beyond, SCORE mentors offer resources for veterans to start and grow their entrepreneurial enterprises.

"While I enjoy working with all SCORE clients, as a U.S. Army veteran, I particularly enjoy working with veterans to translate their military experience into entrepreneurship. Helping clients realize their dreams is very gratifying and the essence of the SCORE mission."

SCORE Central Jersey Chapter Chair Nancy Verduin said mentors continually expand their knowledge base to better assist veterans on their entrepreneurial journey.

"Military transitioning from active duty have

different needs than civilians in terms of starting a business," said Verduin. "It's wonderful to have veterans' resources at our volunteers' fingertips to aid in mentoring our service men and women."

Veterans account for about 10 percent of SCORE's client base. Veterans own 10 percent of small businesses and 14 percent of franchises. Since franchisors have a defined plan of what the business should entail, veterans represent the perfect franchisee given their ability to effectively execute plans as intended.

Nationally, veterans own nearly 2 million businesses, employing more than 5 million Americans, and generating more than \$1 trillion in annual income. Of those, 40 percent of veteran-owned businesses generate more than \$500,000 in annual revenue.
