SHARP-SHINNED HAWK RELEASED BACK TO WILD

This feisty Sharp-shinned Hawk was admitted on 12/22 after being found in a yard in Warren following a window strike. On intake, the hawk had bloody nares and mouth, consistent with head trauma often seen after collisions. The nares are a bird's nostrils, located near the base of the beak, and bleeding there often points to head or facial trauma from collisions.

With supportive care and time to heal, this "Sharpie" as we call them, made great progress and was moved to an outside flight cage on 12/28/25. After proving strong, steady flight and good awareness, the hawk was successfully released back to the wild on 1/2/2026.

Sharp-shinned Hawks are incredibly fast and agile forest hunters, built to weave through dense trees while chasing small birds. That same speed and focus, however, can make them especially vulnerable to window strikes when reflective

glass looks like open sky or habitat.

Remember, small changes matter, adding window decals is a simple way to help protect avian wildlife.

12TH ANNUAL PIZZA TASTING CONTEST 2026

On Saturday, January 24, 2026, the Knights of Columbus Monsignor Lorette Council #3240, at Church of the Assumption in Roselle Park, held its 12th Annual Pizza Tasting Contest. Hours before the biggest snowstorm to hit the area in years, 135 people attended the event, with each attendee sampling pizza from seven area pizzerias and voting for their favorite.

The pizzeria restaurants who donated the pizza to make this event possible are: Calabria Pizzeria (Cranford), Costa's Restaurant and Pizzeria (Roselle Park), Johnny Napkins (Union), Master Pizza and Italian Kitchen
