CELIA COLBERT APPOINTED SUMMIT FOUNDATION PRESIDENT

The Summit Foundation’s board of trustees has appointed Celia Colbert as its president, effective January 1, 2026. A trustee since 2016, Colbert brings extensive community leadership experience and a strong commitment to enhancing philanthropic impact in the Summit area. “I’m honored to step into this role,” Colbert stated. “The Foundation’s mission has never been more important, and I’m energized to work with my fellow trustees and community partners to make a positive difference.”

As a trustee, Colbert co-chaired the Foundation’s grants committee and has led its governance committee. She is also a trustee of Cooperman Barnabas Medical Center and the Summit Free Public Library. She serves on the board of directors of UNCF (United Negro College Fund). Colbert is a past president of the Summit Board of Education and spent more than 25 years at Merck & Co., retiring as senior vice president, corporate secretary, and assistant general counsel. She has resided in Summit for 35 years.

Colbert succeeds Dana Turk, who led the Foundation board through growth in grants and scholarships, community partnerships, the formalization of its vision and values, and operational advancements. “Dana has been a highly effective president,” Colbert noted. “She is a clear thinker and strong communicator, and she has enriched both the board and the Foundation through her strategic insights, analytical skills, and interpersonal strengths.”

The board of trustees also accepted the resignation of Kelli Montgomery, effective January 1, 2026. The board thanked Montgomery for her contributions, which included service on the scholarships and public relations committees.

The Summit Foundation’s all-volunteer board of trustees has expertise in a broad range of areas, including civic engagement, finance, law, real estate, nonprofit management, healthcare, education, STEM, consulting, and entrepreneurship. The trustees lead the Foundation’s strategy and operations

SAFETY ADVICE FOR POLICE CHIEF RYAN PETERS

Statement from
Summit Police Chief Ryan Peters

Over the past several weeks, the region has seen an increase in burglaries to motor vehicles, attempted vehicle thefts, motor vehicle thefts, attempted burglaries to houses, as well as burglaries to houses that are occupied. In most of these incidents, suspects entered homes in search

of key fobs. While Summit has not experienced the same level of criminal activity to date, these trends often move from town to town, and I want our residents to be prepared.

The Summit Police Department is prioritizing this situation and actively participating in information sharing with law enforcement partners in the region. Our priority is to keep Summit safe, and part of that is ensuring we identify and mitigate patterns we observe in nearby communities. While we continue to take steps on our end, we also need residents to remain vigilant.

PLEASE TAKE THE FOLLOWING PRECAUTIONS, WHICH MEANINGFULLY REDUCE OPPORTUNITIES FOR CRIME:

- If possible, park your vehicles inside a garage
- Remove all valuables, including key fobs, from plain view in your car and house
- Lock all vehicle doors

- Lock all exterior doors and windows to your home
- Lock the door between the garage and house if they are connected
- Set your home alarm system if you have one
- Turn on exterior lighting, especially overnight

If you see or hear anything suspicious, or if your home security cameras capture unusual activity, call the Summit Police Department immediately at 908-273-0051 (call 911 in an emergency). Quick reporting gives us the best chance to respond in real time and prevent additional incidents.

Residents can also schedule a free home security assessment through our website. An officer will review your property and offer personalized recommendations to enhance your home's safety.

We appreciate your cooperation and vigilance. By working together, we can reduce risks and keep Summit safe for everyone.

Pegasus: The Orchestra will perform at Drew University on Saturday, March 21 at 4:00 PM for the TheraYouth Foundation's Third Annual Concert fundraiser. Held at the Dorothy Young Center for the Arts, the concert will unite world-class professional musicians with local student performers to raise critical funds for TheraYouth's mission to provide needed physical, occupational, and speech therapy services to disadvantaged children who cannot otherwise access care.

Pegasus: The Orchestra pairs artistic excellence with social impact. Pianist, conductor and composer Karén Hakobyan founded the group in 2017 as a nonprofit dedicated to supporting exceptional musical talent, and to bringing world-class performances to underserved communities. True to its namesake, the ensemble empowers its musicians to soar artistically. Pegasus functions as a collective of artist leaders, resulting in performances that run the range of vibrant, driven orchestral performances alternating with intimate and chamber-like expression. The New York Concert Review calls Pegasus "a truly first-rate ensemble" and a "can't miss" group, urging audiences to "get your tickets right away before they sell out."

As a composer-arranger, Director Hakobyan frequently crafts orchestral works to showcase

the unique musicality of the ensemble's artists, as in this concert which Hakobyan specifically wrote for this performance.

The Chatham High School Chamber Choir, directed by Kenneth Bryson, will perform the Interlude. This ensemble has performed at venues including the White House, the National Anthem at Citi Field to open a Mets game, the Empire State Building, and the Cathedral of St. John the Divine, and appreciated for their musical excellence.

The proceeds from this concert will support the TheraYouth Foundation, whose mission is to ensure that children are never denied critical physical, occupational, or speech therapy simply because their families cannot afford it. TheraYouth serves disadvantaged youth with treatable conditions, helping them gain strength, communication, and independence. Funded entirely through donations and fundraisers, every dollar raised supports life-changing therapy sessions for children who might otherwise go without the care they need to thrive.

"Every child deserves the chance to reach their full potential," said TheraYouth founder, Dr. Irina Marcoff, DPT. "This concert not only raises vital funds but brings the community together around the belief that early, high-quality therapy can change the course of a child's life."







GRANTS TOTALING \$199,500 SUPPORTS REEVES-REED ARBORETUM

DAR LAUNCHES AMERICA 250 CELEBRATION

America's semiquincentennial year has arrived and the Daughters of the American Revolution (DAR) kicked off the celebration by honoring their patriot ancestors at the Somerset County Park Commission's Festival of Trees.

They included a captain of the Lexington Alarm in Massachusetts, a river boat pilot, people who donated money or supplies, a brigadier general of the light dragoons, a spy, a president of the provincial Congress, and farmers who joined their local militia.

To join the DAR, women need to document

their descent from a man or woman who aided the cause of American independence. Some prospective members have mapped out their family tree, but others know only that they have an ancestor who served in the Revolution. In that case, the DAR will assist them with research and the application process.

The DAR is a non-profit, non-political women's service organization dedicated to promoting patriotism, preserving American history, and securing America's future through better education. There are currently 190,000 members in 3,000 chapters in the U.S. and several nations abroad.



SHARP-SHINNED HAWK RELEASED BACK TO WILD

This feisty Sharp-shinned Hawk was admitted on 12/22 after being found in a yard in Warren following a window strike. On intake, the hawk had bloody nares and mouth, consistent with head trauma often seen after collisions. The nares are a bird's nostrils, located near the base of the beak, and bleeding there often points to head or facial trauma from collisions.

With supportive care and time to heal, this "Sharpie" as we call them, made great progress and was moved to an outside flight cage on 12/28/25. After proving strong, steady flight and good awareness, the hawk was successfully released back to the wild on 1/2/2026.

Sharp-shinned Hawks are incredibly fast and agile forest hunters, built to weave through dense trees while chasing small birds. That same speed and focus, however, can make them especially vulnerable to window strikes when reflective glass looks like open sky or habitat.

Remember, small changes matter, adding window decals is a simple way to help.

POLICE OFFICER JONATHAN SAUERS CELEBRATED ON HIS RETIREMENT

On Friday December 5th, Summit celebrated the career of Officer Jonathan Sauers, who dedicated the last 26-years to serving the City of Summit.

Officer Sauers, grew up in Westfield and started serving the public at a young age. He volunteered with both Garwood First Aid Squad and Cranford First Aid Squad as an EMT, and held the position of President for both organizations. Simultaneously, he attended Union County College, completing an Associates Degree in Criminal Justice, and then later attended and graduated from Kean University with a B.A. Degree in Public Administration-Criminal Justice.

Upon completing his education, Officer Sauers was hired by the Cranford Police Department where he served four years as a Communications Officer. While employed with their agency, he was also appointed to the Westfield Auxiliary Police Force serving initially as a volunteer Auxiliary Police Officer; but later was hired full-time in the capacity of a Traffic Enforcement Officer.

In 1998, Officer Sauers entered the John H. Stamler Police Academy as an Alternate Route Candidate with the 79th Session. He completed the training, successfully graduating 6th in his class of 52 recruits. Officer Sauers was hired by the Summit Police Department in 1999.

Officer Sauers served in several of the agencies bureaus during his years of service with our agency. When initially hired, he was assigned to the Patrol Bureau, however, after a short time he was transferred to our Traffic Special Services

Bureau (TSSB). Within this role, Officer Sauers participated in traffic enforcement assignments, research and field work regarding City Ordinances and best methods to enforce them, training new Crossing Guards, and investigating fatal and/or serious motor vehicle crashes with injury.

Officers Sauers was later assigned to the Detective Bureau where he was responsible for general investigations, statement taking of suspects, victims and witnesses, crime scene processing, and background investigations for peddler licenses, firearms permits, and solicitors. After this assignment for several years, Officer Sauers opted to be reassigned back to the Patrol Bureau where he would complete his career. In the mid-2000s, Officer Sauers also served as the agency's Accreditation Manager assisting with and overseeing the lengthy process of accreditation.

Officers Sauers has been the recipient of a Unit Citation, an Exceptional Duty Service Award, countless exemplary performance notices from his supervisors, and dozens of commendation letters and notes of appreciation from residents and businesses over the years.




