# AN UNFORGETTABLE NIGHT OF MUSIC TO TRANSFORM YOUNG LIVES

On March 21, Pegasus: The Orchestra will perform with the Chatham High School Chamber Choir in a dazzling benefit concert for the TheraYouth Foundation at the Dorothy Center for Performing Arts at Drew University. Led by accomplished conductor and pianist, Karén Hakobyan, the vibrant program includes Haydn's "Fire" Symphony and a rousing version of Gershwin's Rhapsody in Blue, both composed exclusively for this ensemble. GRAMMY-nominated cellist Sergey Antonov - hailed by The Washington Post as "destined for cello superstardom" - will bring his soaring tone and formidable technique to Saint-Saëns' Cello Concerto No.1. All proceeds support pediatric medical therapy for disadvantaged youth. ## TERAYOUTH CELEBRATES THREE YEARS OF TRANSFORMING CHILDREN'S LIVES

In just three years, the TheraYouth Foundation has become a beacon of hope for families across New Jersey struggling to secure essential therapy services for their children.

Physical therapist Dr. Irina Marcoff, DPT, founded TheraYouth to address a troubling reality: too many children with treatable conditions were being left behind. Long waitlists for public Early Intervention and school-based services; a shortage of pediatric providers accepting Medicaid; and the high cost of private therapy (often exceeding \$125 per session); placed critical care out of reach for hundreds of families.

"Early therapy can change the entire trajectory of a child's life," says Dr. Marcoff. "But for many families, access is the greatest barrier."

At its Elizabeth, NJ clinic, TheraYouth provides affordable physical, occupational, and speech therapy to disadvantaged children, more than 90% of whom rely on Medicaid. Since its inception, over 113 patients have "graduated" from therapy by achieving critical

developmental milestones.

The impact of timely intervention is undeniable. One young patient, unable to crawl or walk due to congenitally weak neck muscles, faced the risk of permanent disability due to delays in care. After just four months of physical therapy at TheraYouth, he graduated from treatment, able to walk normally, transforming his future.

Unfortunately, demand continues to outpace resources with more than 400 children on TheraYouth's waitlist for services. The foundation operates entirely through donations, community partnerships, and fundraisers.

## READING, WRITING & REVOLUTION: A SAMPLER'S REMARKABLE JOURNEY

### Westfield Historical Society

A sampler stitched for one of Westfield's founding families has traveled over two centuries and 1200 miles back to its origin, an endearing symbol of Revolution and resilience for America's 250th anniversary. The needlework by Mary Baker (1780-1859) was recently gifted to the Westfield Historical Society by Chris Turner of Clarkston, Michigan, a 7th generation descendant of the Bakers and Piersons, early settlers of the West Fields of Elizabethtown.

"We are thrilled to have this historic piece return in time for the celebration of America250," said Brian Remite, president of the Westfield Historical Society. "The provenance of this sampler is a who's who of many of Westfield's most prominent early families. It is a significant addition to our Revolutionary-era holdings and we are deeply grateful to the Turners for donating it."

Mary Baker was a daughter of Daniel Baker (1753-1814), who served as a sergeant under Captain John Scudder in the Revolutionary War. When the British invaded New Jersey in June 1780, his wife Margaret Osborn Baker (1760-1836) fled to Baltus Roll's farm in Springfield, "where, from fatigue and fright, she gave

premature birth on June 25, 1780, to her first child, Mary." The Bakers ultimately had 14 children and were interred in the Burial Grounds of the Presbyterian Church.

Along with reading, writing and simple arithmetic, needlework was an essential part of the Colonial education of girls. Samplers featured cross-stitch alphabets and numerals, demonstrating mastery of important practical skills. The undated piece reads "Mary Baker Woven by her age [indecipherable]," most likely when she was about twelve, placing it in the early 1790s. She married Ezekiel DeCamp in 1799 and bore 17 children, ten in Westfield and seven after they migrated to Butler County, Ohio.

The sampler remained with her family in Westfield, passing through members of the Clark and Pierson lines to her great grandniece, Catherine Pierson Turner, grandmother of Chris Turner. "It is deeply meaningful to see this sampler return to where so many generations of my family began," said Mr. Turner. "It represents not only my family's story, but the story of Westfield itself—of resilience, education, and everyday life in the Revolutionary era. I'm thankful to the Westfield Historical Society for recognizing its significance and for welcoming it back as part of America's 250th anniversary."



It will be on Friday March 6th and Saturday March 7th and held at St. Bartholomew in Scotch Plains.

**WHAT IS CORNERSTONE?**

Cornerstone is an opportunity to hit the "pause button" in life and a chance to renew and strengthen your faith and grow in your experience in the Christian faith. It is led by a team of parishioners from various backgrounds and ages who themselves have experienced an increased presence of Christ in their lives.
