REPAIR CAFE RETURNS TO MADISON

Madison Rotary Club

Repair Cafe returns to Madison on 4/25/2026! Get your valued items back in working order and out of the landfill. Volunteer repair experts will be helping you to fix your household items for free at Grace Church in Madison (4 Madison Ave.), from 11 a.m. until 3 p.m. All types of items can be brought in: lamps, bicycles, clothing and other fabric items, phones and computers, small appliances, wooden things, watches needing batteries, jewelry, toys, knives in need of sharpening, and many other kinds of repairs. As a bonus, you will get to meet your neighbors from Madison and surrounding towns!

The Repair Cafe is central to Rotary International's focus on protecting the environment, and furthers our club's mission of partnering with other organizations to keep Madison one of the "Best Places to Live in New Jersey." This event is also an important part of Grace's outreach program.

The repairers will show you how the repairs are made and what tools are needed. Most of the time they can get your things working for you again, keeping them out of the landfills, and saving you some money. You can even learn how to do the repairs yourself. Items should be small enough to be carried in by one person. No gasoline motors or hazardous materials, please. Also, please note: We start our last repair at 2:30. First come, first served! And if you can, it's helpful if you send us an email ahead of time

telling us what you will be bringing in for repair.

This event is a follow-up to our first five, very successful, Repair Cafes in Madison. Our volunteers and our visitors came from Madison and many surrounding towns. We had almost 200 items brought in for repair last fall, and we succeeded on getting most of them fixed! Our repairs at our recent events ranged from lamps, to bikes and teddy bears, but also included bird feeders and giant skulls.

And once again we will feature our Kids' Take-Apart Table. Kids get to take apart everyday items (under supervision) to see what's inside and to learn how to use tools.

And we are always looking for new volunteers to join our team. Whether you are an expert repairer with your own tools, or someone who wants to help out on logistics and organization, we would love to have you! There is no age requirement. Our volunteers have ranged in age from their teens to their eighties. This is a feel-good event where you get to meet and help your neighbors from Madison and surrounding towns. SENIOR CITIZENS' CLUB

FIRST LADIES OF THE UNITED STATES - WEDNESDAY, APRIL 8TH, 2026

The Florham Park Senior Citizens' Club members on Wednesday, April 8, 2026, at 11:00 a.m, at the Florham Park Community Center, our program is sponsored by the Morris Museum and the topic is "First Ladies of the United States" (FLOTUS). Although the first lady's role has never been codified or officially defined, she figures prominently in the political and social life of the United States. The first lady traditionally acts as hostess of the White house. Not all first ladies were the wife of the president and each dealt in her own way the inherent tension between the public nature of the role and the discomfort of society with women in public position. Historically, when a president is unmarried or a widower, he usually asked a relative to act as White house hostess. Since the 1900s, the role of first lady has changed, to include, involvement in political campaigns, management of the White House, championship of social causes, and representation of the president at official and

ceremonial occasions. Over the years first ladies have influenced fashion, public opinion and advocated for female empowerment. Often some of the women have been overlooked for the valuable contributions that helped shape the presidency of their husband, brother, or father. Since the 1920's, many first ladies have become public speakers, adopting specific causes. It also became common for the first lady to hire staff to support her agenda. Dr. Jill Biden causes: "Joining Forces", military families; White House History. The current first lady is Melania Trump and her causes: "Be Best", and Cyberbullying Awareness.

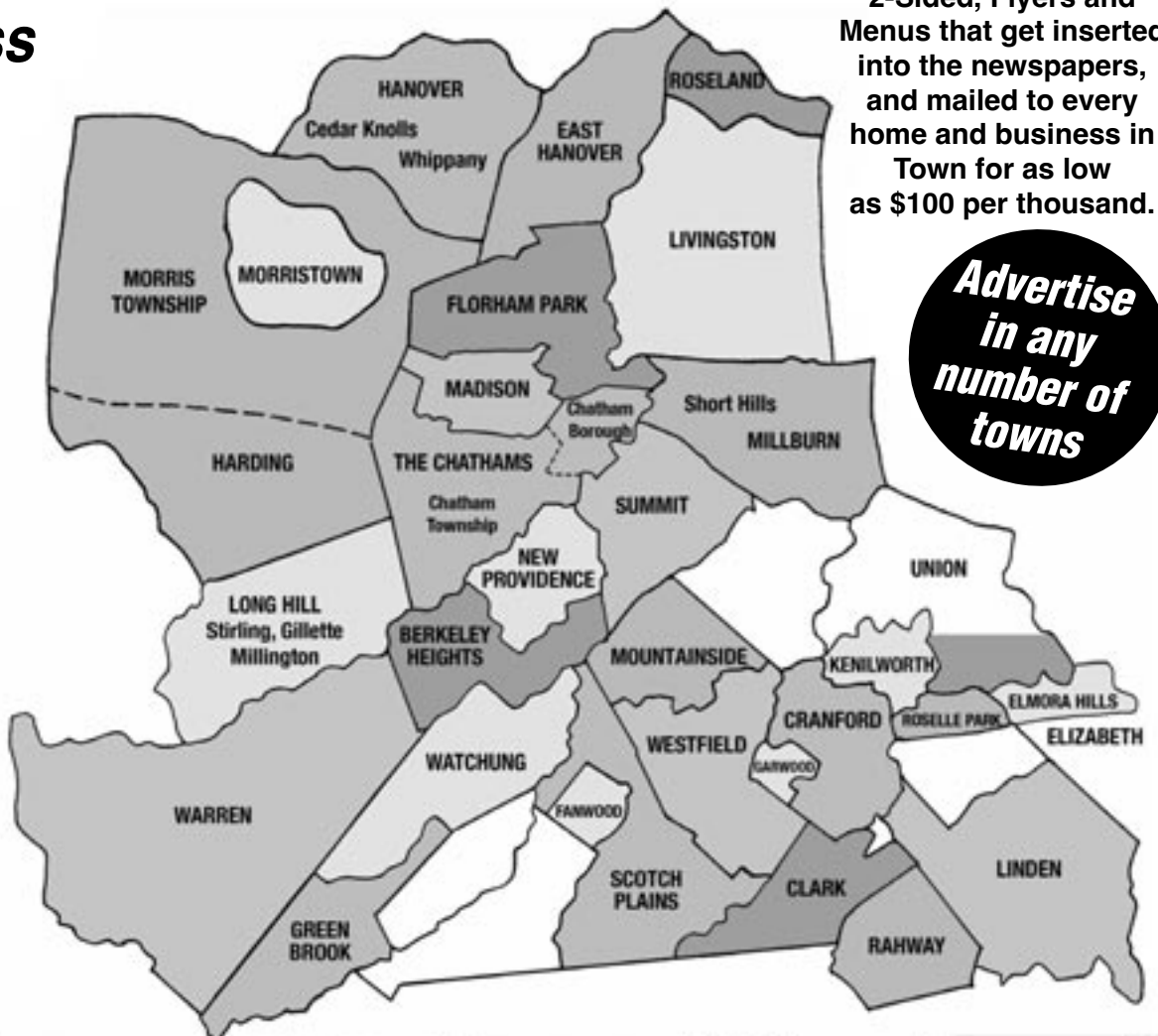

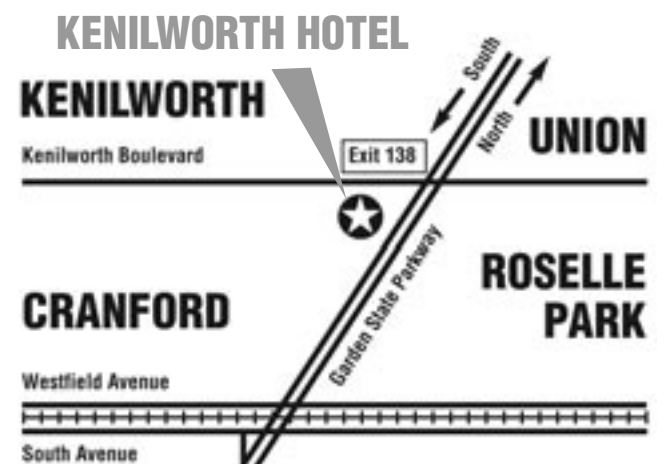
