MYSTERY READERS SPARK JOY OF READING AT SCHOOL NO. 2

Linden Public Schools

One by one, the mystery unfolded.

Gasp quickly turned to cheers inside classrooms at School No. 2 as surprise guests stepped through the doors, each carrying a book, a smile, and a shared mission: to spark a love of reading.

The special visits (Feb. 27) were part of the school's "Mystery Reader Day," a lively literacy initiative designed to build excitement around books while connecting students with community leaders and role models.

Among the surprise readers were Superintendent Dr. Atiya Y. Perkins, Board of Education President Malaysia Thomas, board members Craig Halloran and Lymari Cintron, Maria Boulton from Mayor Derek Armstead's office, and Danie Orelie, director of the district's Multilingual Learners Department.

For students, the experience felt like part guessing game, part celebration. When the mystery guests finally appeared, the room filled with anticipation and delight. Each reader visited at least two classrooms, sharing stories with students across multiple grade levels, from Pre-K through fourth grade, bringing books to life through expressive storytelling and lively conversation.

The message of the day was simple but powerful: reading opens worlds.



STUDENTS OFFERED UP TO \$2,000

Scholarship applications are open for local high school seniors

For the year 2026, the Bayway Complex Community Advisory Panel (CAP) is offering high school seniors who are residents of Linden, Rahway, Elizabeth, and Staten Island the opportunity to be awarded a CAP scholarship. Several one-year scholarships will be awarded in the amount of \$2,000 each, to students in these four municipalities represented by the CAP. It is a onetime \$2,000 award.

The winners will be selected by the CAP Scholarship Committee, who will be taking the following areas into consideration when reviewing the applications: The applications must have all sections completed; Academics (transcript); Essay (AI generated prohibited); Science/Math Teacher Recommendation Letter(s) and confirmation of the student's area of study.

This scholarship is open to candidates who will be pursuing a college, university, career, or vocational school education in the Industrial,

Process Technology, Computer Science or Engineering, i.e., Chemical, Civil, Mechanical, Electrical, or Environmental fields. Please contact your high school guidance counselor for more information or go to shorturl.at/01b41 to access the application. The deadline to submit applications is April 17, 2026.

The Bayway CAP is a committee of interested stakeholders including community representatives from Linden, Rahway, Elizabeth, and Staten Island representing various sectors of the community including neighbors, educators, retirees, public officials, emergency responders, and environmental organization representatives. Harvest Quilters of Central NJ will present their 42nd annual Quilt Show on Saturday, April 11, 2026. Sharing the Quilts 42 will be held at the Willow Grove Presbyterian Church, 1961 Raritan Road, Scotch Plains, NJ from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Admission is \$8 for adults and \$3 for children under twelve.

At 10:30 a.m., Katherine Evans will present "My Journey - Stitching Together an International Community of Quilters." Evans' talk will cover her years living in Brazil, Costa Rica and Mexico from 2007 to 2025. She'll highlight her outreach to local women who together developed sewing and design skills creating one-of-a-kind group quilts, many of which will be on display.

Wendy Sheridan of Rahway will be recognized as 2026's Featured Quilter.

Sheridan is an award-winning multidisciplinary artist whose work spans fiber, watercolor, ink, and acrylics. With a lifetime of experience in fabric and fiber arts, she has created quilts, housewares, and costumes, serving as costume mistress for the Union County Academy for the Performing Arts from 2008-2012.

Her fiber art installation "What We Did This Summer," in collaboration with Lauren Reidy, has been on display at the New Jersey Transit Rahway station in the fall/winter of 2025-2026. "I love bold color, an explosion of color shows up in all my art forms," said Sheridan, a retired electrical engineer and technical writer.



STANDING IN FORMATION, LOOKING TOWARD THE FUTURE

Linden Public Schools

Before a packed gymnasium of families, military leaders, and community officials, more than 550 Linden High School NJROTC cadets, the largest unit in the world, assembled on March 5, 2026 for their annual military inspection, a ceremony that highlighted a year of discipline and leadership while honoring 10 graduating seniors who have committed to serve in the United States Armed Forces.

The event marked the ceremonial phase of the 2026 Annual Area Manager’s Inspection (AMI), a comprehensive evaluation and celebration of the Linden High School Naval Junior Reserve Officers Training Corps program.

Serving as inspecting officer was Commander Eric Humphreys, NJROTC Area 2 Manager and United States Navy (Ret.), who joined a team of military representatives to observe the cadets during a daylong showcase of precision, professionalism, and teamwork.

For Commander Boyd C. Decker, USN (Ret.), the school’s Senior Naval Science Instructor, the annual inspection represents far more than a formal military tradition.

“This event is really the culmination of all the care and hard work the kids have put in throughout the year.”

Linden’s NJROTC program has grown dramatically since its beginnings. Founded in 1986 with just 92 students, the unit has expanded into a global model for youth leadership and character development. Today, the program’s 550 cadets surpass more than 641 NJROTC units nationwide, along with additional programs operating overseas.



(above) cadets presented the regimental colors and led the audience in the national anthem.

Inspectors evaluated cadets on uniform presentation, grooming standards, military bearing, and knowledge of naval science principles, asking questions that ranged from leadership traits and general orders to current events and the national chain of command.

Parents, school leaders, military recruiters, and elected officials filled the gymnasium as cadets performed precision drill demonstrations, participated in rank promotions, and received awards recognizing leadership, academic achievement, and service.

This year, 10 graduating cadets from Linden’s NJROTC program have committed to serving in the United States military, a milestone that underscores the program’s leadership pipeline.

According to Decker, six cadets will enlist in the United States Marine Corps, two will join the United States Navy, one will enter the United States Air Force, and one will serve in the National Guard.

The numbers carry particular significance when viewed within the program’s graduating class. Linden’s NJROTC program will graduate more than 90 seniors this year, meaning roughly one in nine cadets is choosing to enter military service, a percentage significantly higher than what is typically seen among graduating seniors nationwide.

During the ceremony, Superintendent Perkins reflected on the broader meaning of the moment, reminding cadets that their journey began not in uniform, but in the classroom.

“As a wife of a Navy veteran and as an educator, it is worth remembering that before you wore uniforms, you sat in classrooms. Every soldier serving today and every veteran who protected our freedom was once a student taught by a teacher -- some right here in Linden Public Schools.”

For Decker, the ceremony ultimately reinforces the deeper mission of NJROTC: preparing young people for lives of leadership, responsibility, and service — whether their future leads them to the military, college, or other career paths.

Still, the moment that resonates most deeply is watching those seniors step forward to commit themselves to serving their country.

“For me,” Decker said, “watching those seniors step forward and commit to serving their country is always the highlight.”
