Sheriff James M. Gannon is proud to announce that eight K9 teams have successfully completed certification in various detection disciplines through the United States Police Canine Association (USPCA) Region 15.

According to the USPCA, the USPCA is the Nation's oldest and largest police canine organization. Since 1971, the USPCA has been training and certifying police dogs in General Patrol Dog use, Tracking, Protection, Narcotic Detection, Explosive Detection, Arson, Fish and Game, and Search and Rescue disciplines. Regional and national certifications have been upheld by U.S. Supreme Court and Federal District Court rulings as a "Bona-Fide" test for police use evaluations. The USPCA represents the finest in police dog training and certification in the nation and strives for constant improvement. It is important for canine teams to be evaluated and certified by an unbiased organization such as the USPCA. The testing incorporated line searches, room searches and vehicle searches.

Sheriff James Gannon stated, "These noteworthy accomplishments reinforce the professionalism exhibited every day by the officers of the Morris County Sheriff's Office and specifically the Patrol Division's Canine Section. We want the people of Morris County to be assured their Sheriff's Office is there and ready if they need us. Congratulations to all our K9 teams and their success!"

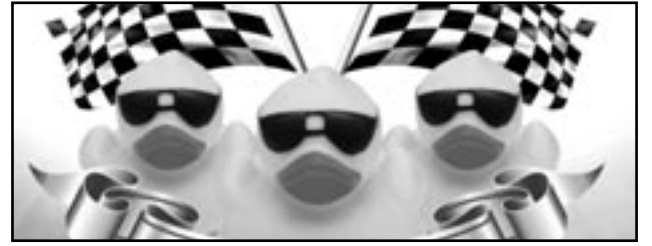

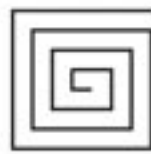

COUNTY MEMORIAL DAY OBSERVANCE SET FOR NOON ON MAY 20

The Morris County Board of County Commissioners invites the public to attend its annual Memorial Day Observance on Court Street, between the historic Morris County Courthouse and the Administration and Records Building in Morristown.

The ceremony will begin at noon on Wednesday, May 20, and will include the presentation of Morris County Distinguished Military Service Medals to local veterans.

The event will also be livestreamed on the county's Facebook page.

In recognition of the nation's 250th anniversary, the program will also feature a special commemoration honoring Continental Army soldiers who lost their lives at Jockey Hollow.

The keynote speaker is James Ferguson, a Vietnam veteran and Mountain Lakes resident who served on active duty in the U.S. Navy from 1963 to 1966. During his first two years of service, he was part of a small-boat amphibious fleet in the Atlantic, supporting Army and Marine Corps operations in Europe and the Caribbean. He later extended his service, volunteering as an officer aboard Swift boats in a newly established program, patrolling coastal waters and rivers in Vietnam from 1965 to 1966. Following active duty, he completed his service in the Naval Reserve in New York, attaining the rank of lieutenant.

For his service, he received the Vietnam Service Medal, Vietnam Campaign Medal, National Defense Service Medal, Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal (Cuba) and the Navy Unit Commendation Ribbon.

The Morris County Distinguished Military Service Medals are unique to the county and feature the county seal encircled with the words, "Morris County Distinguished Military Service" on the front. The reverse side displays an outline of the county alongside the American flag.

More than 10,000 medals have been presented to veterans or to their surviving family members since Morris County began the medal program in 1999, initially to honor WWII veterans on the 55th anniversary of the D-Day invasion.

GO NATIVE IN YOUR LANDSCAPE - MAY 9

The Garden Club of Morristown

Across the country, many states, including New Jersey, have designated April as Native Plant Month. As we prepare to spruce up our yards this spring, consider adding or replacing with natives. Trees, shrubs and plants native to New Jersey and the northeast offer several benefits. They help sustain ecosystems, pollinators, and a diverse wildlife. Native plants require less maintenance in terms of mowing and cleaning up leaves, and don't need pesticides or herbicides. That's a win-win!

It's not necessary to convert an entire yard (although that would be very beneficial!) to make a difference. A large container, a small patch of yard, or a bed filled with "superstar" plants is a great way to begin. Smaller tree seedlings establish better than larger plants, so this need not be an expensive enterprise. One or two trees, surrounded by native shrubs, will offer excellent habitat for birds and insects. To get started on this project, these native superstar plants are good

options: Oak trees, Hickory trees, Swamp milkweed, Black-eyed susan, Cone flowers, Cardinal flowers

Native plants will be available at the Garden Club of Morristown's Annual Plant Sale, Saturday, May 9th, 8:30am - 3pm at the New Vernon Fire House.

Expert gardeners will be wearing Go Native badges to assist with plant selections. Proceeds from this sale support community projects.

You can also visit Foote's Pond Wood, a 24-acre park at 128 James Street in Morristown, to see native trees, shrubs, and flowers.
