PAVILION AT BOY SCOUT PARK TO BE DEDICATED TO JAMES D. VIGLIOTTI - MAY 3

The Borough of Roselle Park will be honoring long-time borough resident James "Jim" D. Vigliotti with a pavilion dedication at Boy Scout Park.

The public is invited to celebrate the pavilion dedication and honor the life of Jim Vigliotti with a ceremony beginning at 1 p.m. on Sunday, May 3 at 538 West Lincoln Ave., Roselle Park.

Vigliotti was a distinguished combat veteran who joined the United States Army Air Corps in 1942. He attained the rank of Staff Sergeant serving as an aerial gunner. He held positions as a tail gunner, turret gunner, waist gunner, and nose gunner, taking part in 34 missions.

As a result of his service, Vigliotti earned the

Aerial Gunner Wings, a Distinguished Flying Cross, an Air Medal, a Presidential Unit Citation, a Good Conduct Medal, and a European Theater Medal. He enlisted in the Air Force Reserves after he was discharged in 1945. He was called back into active service for one year during the Korean War.

He was a long-time member of the VFW Post #9119 and an active member of the Roselle Park community. He was well-known by residents for his rendition of "God Bless America," which he performed at many town events.

The event will feature the pavilion dedication and ribbon-cutting ceremony to celebrate the upgrades recently completed at Boy Scout Park.

FIREHOUSE ADDITION GROUNDBREAKING

Borough of Roselle Park

A ceremonial groundbreaking was held on Tuesday, March 31st for the long-awaited addition to Firehouse #3, also known as the Faitoute Hose Company, in Roselle Park. Borough officials and members of the Roselle Park Fire Department were on hand to break ground and mark the ceremonial beginning of the historic project.

“This groundbreaking marks an historic investment in not only the Fire Department, but the long-term safety of Roselle Park,” said Fire Chief Steven A. Thompson. “I want to thank

Mayor Signorello and the Borough Council for their support and for sharing in our vision for this Department.”

The approximately 1,600 square foot addition will accommodate an additional firefighting apparatus, and will include new training, storage, reporting, and office spaces for the Fire Department. The project will also include the reconfiguration of certain aspects of the existing structure to optimize the space.

“This groundbreaking marks more than a start of a new addition – it honors nearly 125 years of service, sacrifice, and commitment within these

walls,” said Deputy Fire Chief Raymond J. Kuterka, who serves as the Deputy for Firehouse #3. “As we look ahead, this expansion ensures we continue protecting our community with the strength, readiness, and pride that have defined this department for generations.”

The project, engineered by the Neglia Group, and designed by Netta Architects, will be constructed by AB Contracting based in Wharton, New Jersey. As awarded, total construction costs for the project are \$1,938,401.

Project completion is expected mid-2026.

HISTORIC UNVEILING PART OF 125TH BIRTHDAY FESTIVITIES

Borough of Roselle Park

On March 22, 2026, Roselle Park Borough engaged local dignitaries and the public in a dual-location celebration commemorating the day, March 22, 1901, when the community officially became an independent borough. The festivities started at 11:00 a.m. in true birthday fashion—complete with cake, speeches and a proclamation commemorating the 125th anniversary - at the Casano Community Center.

The party then traveled to the newly open Fernmoor Mi-Place® at First Radio luxury apartment complex, which is located on the site of the former lab and factory complex of the Marconi Wireless Telegraphy Company of America, built in 1916. Among other milestone achievements, the building was home to New Jersey's first radio broadcast in 1921 and one of the first radio stations licensed in the country. The factory also produced much of the commercial wireless equipment used in the U.S. as well as equipment used by the U.S. Navy during World War I. Central to this celebration was the unveiling of a plaque installed on the exterior of Mi-Place at First Radio and commemorating the location's historical significance in driving progress and innovation in regional and national communications.

Celebrants gathered at the location at 450 West Westfield Avenue and enjoyed an inspiring and moving story told by Ed Leonard, a long-time

Roselle Park resident who fondly remembers experiencing exciting activities happening at the Marconi Wireless Building.

Leonard advocated for the installation of the plaque replicating the original by the Roselle Park Bicentennial and Anniversary Committee in 1976 that he helped install. After their remarks,

the VIPs joined in unveiling the plaque that commemorates the landmark's impact on the evolution of both radio and American society. At the conclusion of the ceremonies, people were invited to return to Mi-Place® at First Radio this summer, when it becomes the new home of the Roselle Park Museum.

FREE VETERANS INITIATIVE AT THE YMCA

Last year, The Gateway Family YMCA launched a new Veterans Wellness Initiative, offered at the Wellness Center Branch in Union, NJ and at the Elizabeth Branch in Elizabeth, NJ. Beginning this Spring, the free Veterans Wellness Initiative program will continue with new sessions in Union and Elizabeth and will expand to include an additional session at the Rahway Branch, 1564 Irving Street, Rahway. Each program will meet weekly for in-person exercise and wellness, led by a wellness coach, as well as virtually, online to discuss their health in mind, body and spirit.

Open to active military, military veterans, and their spouse or partner, the free 12-week Veterans Wellness Initiative program provides participants access to health and wellness opportunities, as well as meaningful social connection with those who share the bond of military service. Participants benefit from 24-hour access to the YMCA360 virtual platform, an adult couple membership to the Y during the 12-week session, and an additional six-month individual adult

membership following successful completion of the program.

“I have seen first-hand the impact this program has had on our veterans and their families,” shared Susan Butler, Director of Community Wellness. “I am excited to continue to expand the Veterans Wellness Initiative throughout our YMCA branches.”

The Veterans Wellness Initiative began as a way to create community and wellness opportunities for veterans. During the 12-week course, classes will focus on balance, nutrition, tai-chi, mental health, working out with tension bands, stretching and the circuit course, as well as other weight machines. 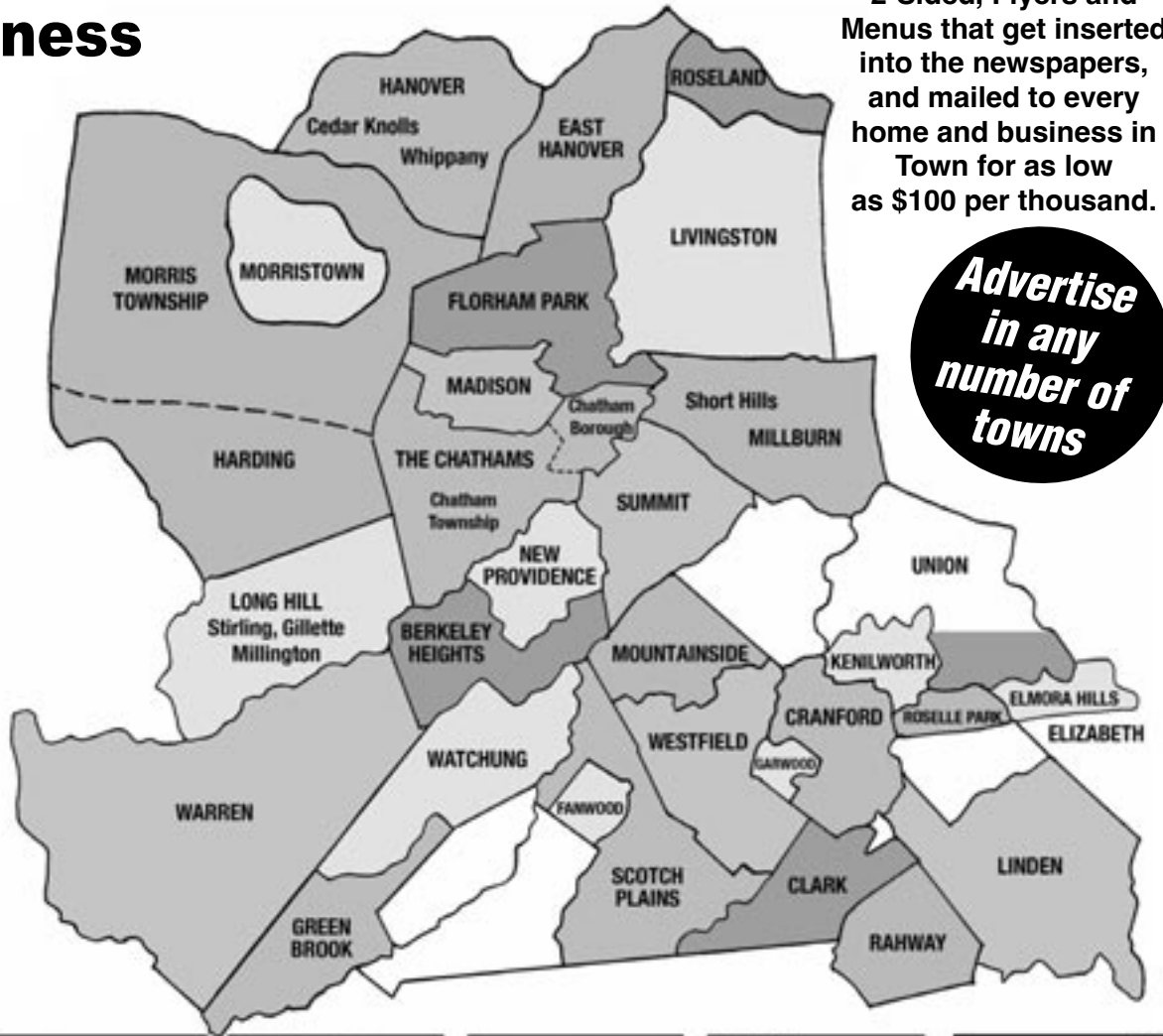

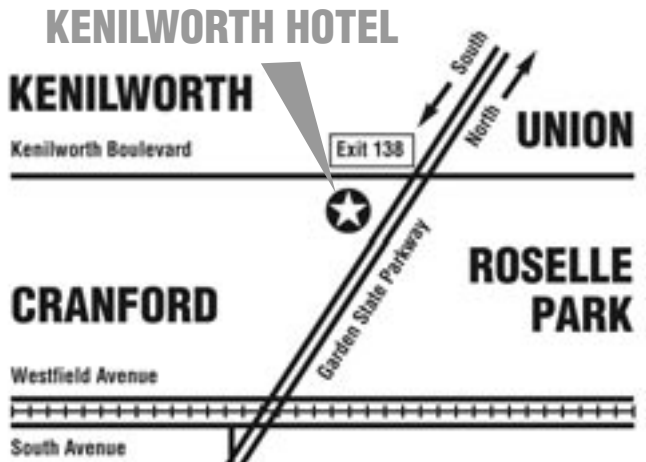
