SQUAD SEEKS VOLUNTEERS TO SUSTAIN LIFESAVING MISSION

The Berkeley Heights Volunteer Rescue Squad (BHVRs) is calling on members of the community to step forward and answer a critical need: adult volunteers.

For decades, BHVRs has provided around-the-clock emergency medical services at no charge to the patients they serve. Whether responding to medical emergencies and accidents or being present at public events, the squad plays an essential role in keeping the community safe. But like many volunteer organizations across the country, BHVRs is facing a growing challenge: maintaining enough active adult members to meet increasing demand. “Volunteering isn’t just about answering calls—it’s about being part of something bigger,” said Chuck Kleinberg, BHVRs president, “We rely on dedicated adults in our community who are willing to give their time and energy to help neighbors in their most critical moments.”

While the squad has a strong and active cadet program made up of high school students, adult volunteers are vital to maintaining operational readiness during daytime hours, overnight shifts, and leadership roles. Adults bring experience, stability, and availability that are crucial for consistent emergency response. For many, the biggest barrier is simply getting started. The idea of responding to emergencies can feel intimidating, and the time commitment can seem

overwhelming at first glance.

BHVRs is made up of individuals from all walks of life who do volunteering work alongside their everyday responsibilities. Members include working professionals, parents raising families, and community members with busy schedules who still find time to give back. “Flexible scheduling allows volunteers to balance service with work and family commitments,” says Chief Birnbaum.

No prior medical experience is required to join. BHVRs provides comprehensive training, as well as opportunities to assist with administration, fundraising, and community outreach. In an increasingly digital world, where so much of daily life happens through screens, volunteering with BHVRs offers something rare and meaningful: real human connection. Members form strong bonds with one another while making a tangible difference in the lives of their patients and community members they encounter during their volunteer shifts.

SHE WAS A 48-YEAR-OLD MOM FROM BERKELEY HEIGHTS... TERRIFIED TO WEAR A LITTLE BLACK DRESS AT HER DAUGHTER'S WEDDING - UNTIL THIS HAPPENED

When guests gathered for a recent summer wedding in town, expectations were clear: a beautiful bride, proud parents, heartfelt speeches, and a lively dance floor.

What no one expected was that one of the most talked-about moments of the night would involve the bride's mother.

As Helen, 48, walked down the aisle in a fitted dress with a tastefully exposed back, heads turned. Conversations paused. By the time the reception was underway, it was clear this mother of the bride had made an impression few would forget.

ELKS WELCOME VETERANS TO THEIR NEW HOMES

Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks

Formerly homeless veterans who are transitioning from temporary housing... A veteran who was in a nursing home for six years... A disabled veteran escaping domestic violence... In addition to honorably serving our country, they all have something else in common. Each is moving into a new apartment with little more than a few personal belongings.

This is when the Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks steps up to help - turning empty rooms into a home.

Recently, members of the NJ State Elks East Central District, with lodges in Stirling, Summit, Springfield, Mountainside, Union, Cranford, and Rahway, have delivered four Veteran Welcome Home Kits, transforming bare apartments into comfortable living spaces. Each kit includes a full-sized bed, couch, end tables, coffee table, dining table and chairs, dresser, nightstands, microwave oven, toaster, coffee maker, lamps, towels, cleaning supplies, kitchenware, and more. Within two hours, the furniture is assembled, the kitchen cabinets are filled, and the apartment is fully set up and ready for its new resident to move in.

Each Veteran Welcome Home Kit costs approximately \$1,800 and is purchased through fundraising events, donations, and grants from the Elks National Foundation. They are given to the veteran free of charge.

Nationwide, an estimated 40,000 veterans experience homelessness on any given night. In partnership with the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs, the Elks National Veterans Service Commission has pledged to help end veteran homelessness by ensuring veterans have access to safe, stable housing.

Here in New Jersey, dozens of Veteran Welcome Home Kits have been delivered since the beginning of the year. And year round, Elks volunteers provide direct services to more than 1,000 veterans at VA facilities across the state and continue to connect with veterans and active military members in their local communities, offering assistance wherever it is needed.

HIGHLANDER ROBOTICS REACHES NEW HEIGHTS ON NATIONAL STAGE

Governor Livingston High School's (GLHS) Highlander Robotics Team, FTC 10785, made history by competing at the FIRST Tech Challenge (FTC) New England (NE) Premier on April 17-18, 2026.

This marks the first time in school history that a Governor Livingston robotics team has reached the national level. This year's NE Premier brought together 55 teams from 17 states, and Highlander Robotics earned 5th place in the

TARA ROY CHOUDHURY HEADED TO FINALS

The Center for Excellence in Education (CEE) has announced the names of high school students who will compete in the USA Biolympiad (USABO) National Finals at Harvard University in Cambridge, Massachusetts, from June 21 to July 2, 2026.

Among them will be Berkeley Heights resident Tara S. Roy Choudhury, a student at Union County Vocational Technical High Schools' Academy for Allied Health Sciences in Scotch Plains. She is New Jersey's only representative in the prestigious USABO competition.

As the premier biology competition for high school students in the United States, USABO enriches the life science education of nearly 12,000 talented students annually. It provides the motivation, curricular resources, and skills training to take them beyond their classroom experience to the level of international competitiveness. After two rounds of challenging online exams, 20 finalists are invited to a residential training program where they learn advanced biological concepts and exacting lab skills at the USABO National Finals at Harvard.

Last year, at the 2025 National Finals, Hengzhou Li, Eric Liu, Cloris Shi and Kian Dhawan earned the right to join the USA Biolympiad Team to represent our country at the 2025 International Biology Olympiad (IBO) in The Philippines, where they received three gold medals and one silver. Since CEE began administering the USABO, every member of the USA Biolympiad Team has continued to medal at the IBO.

"These students are some of the highest achieving biology students in the USA," said Joann DiGennaro, president and co-founder of CEE. "Our USA Biolympiad program encourages excellence in biology education and challenges students and their teachers to reach the gold standard in science."

The finalists will participate for ten days in high-level biology instruction inclusive of laboratory training and conceptual understanding followed by two days of testing. Four students

will earn the honor of representing the U.S. at the 37th International Biology Olympiad, a worldwide competition involving student teams from over 80 countries. It will take place July 12-19 in Vilnius, Lithuania.

"This is an incredible journey these students take, and it demonstrates the passion these students have for biological sciences," said Kathy Frame, director of the USA Biolympiad. "For high school USABO Finalists to experience this level of excellence is an exceptional opportunity."

The Center for Excellence in Education (CEE), a nonprofit 501(c)(3) charitable organization, was founded in 1983 by the late Admiral H.G. Rickover and Joann P. DiGennaro, President of the Center. The Center's mission is to nurture high school and university scholars to careers of excellence and leadership in science, technology, engineering, mathematics (STEM) and business, and to encourage collaboration between and among scientific and technological leaders in the global community

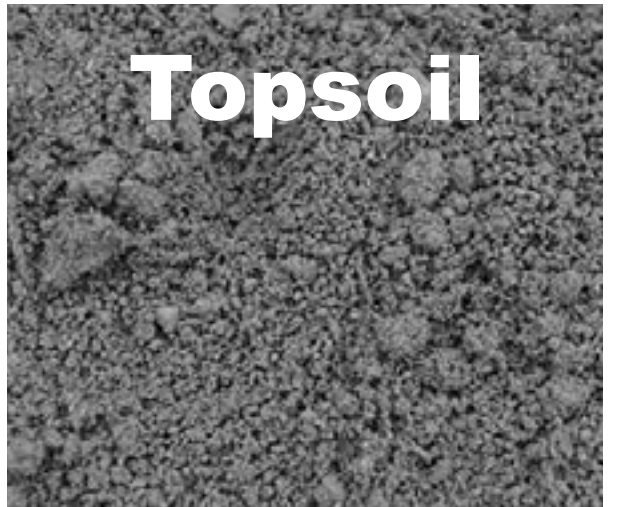

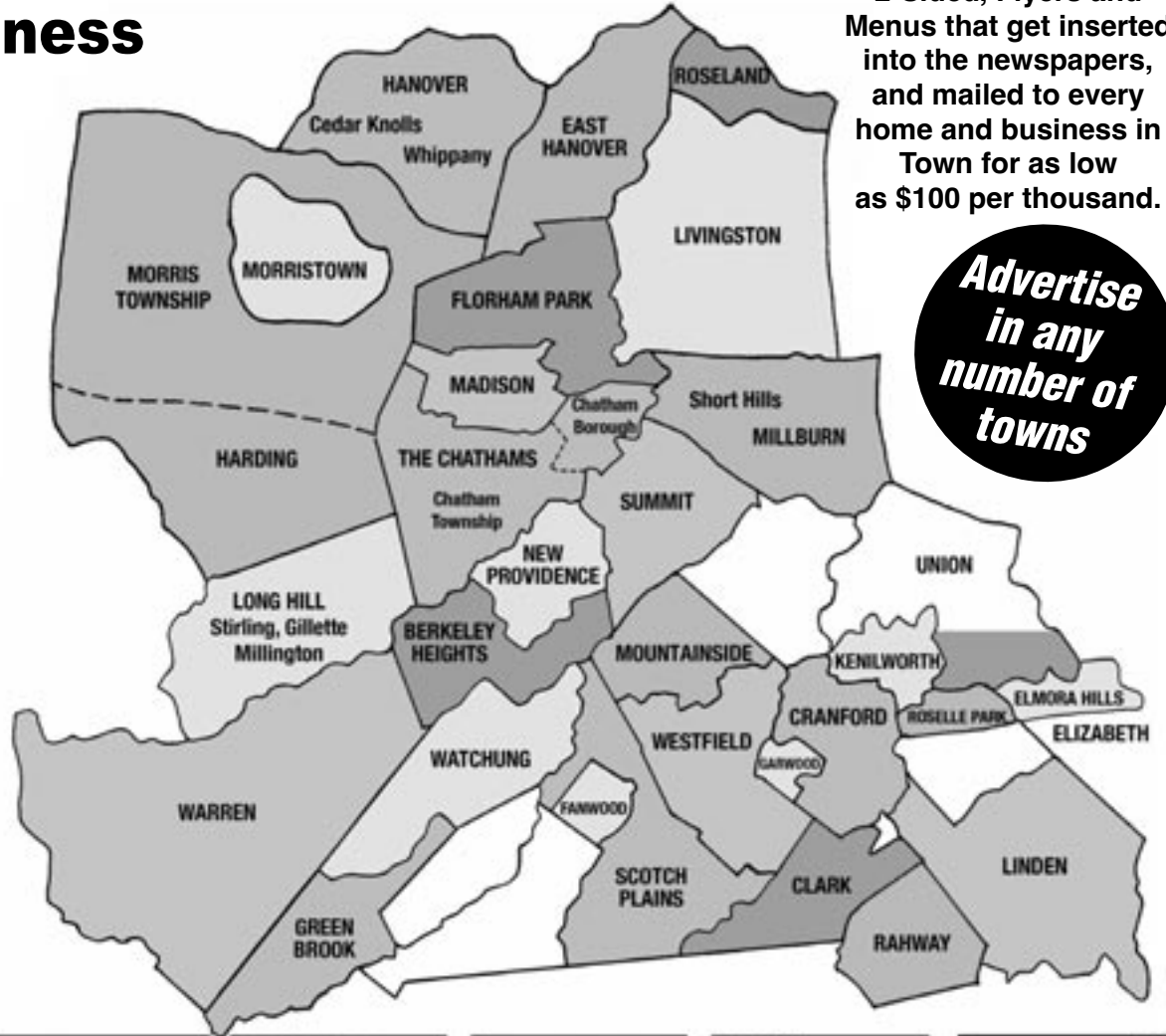

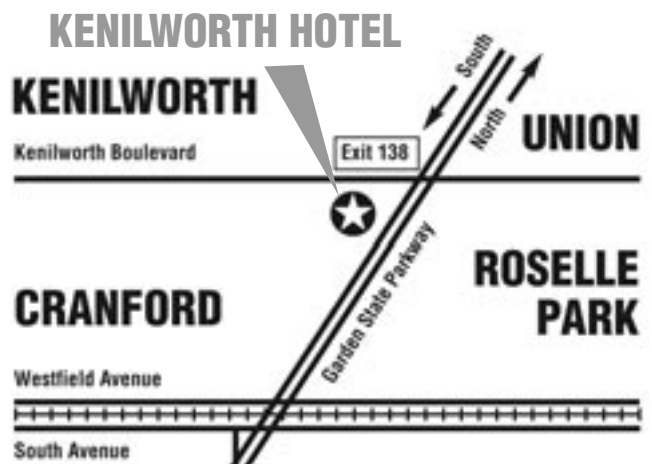
