# DONATE BIKES AND SEWING MACHINES - JUNE 6

## Faith Lutheran Church

Give your unused bikes and sewing machines a new home by bringing them to Faith Lutheran Church's collection for Pedals for Progress (P4P) and Sewing Peace on Saturday, June 6th from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

Adult and children's bicycles in rideable or repairable condition are welcome and will be distributed internationally to those who rely on them for transportation to jobs, markets, medical care, and schools. Donations of working sewing machines also provide income opportunities for those living in developing countries.

If you are unable to drop by on June 6th, you may still leave your bicycle(s) in Faith Lutheran's lower lot next to the utility shed. If you are donating a sewing machine, please leave it underneath the sheltered alcove by the main doors at the bottom of the parking lot. Faith will make sure these items get to P4P for this collection or will hold them until the next one. Please note that "bikes for parts" or disassembled bicycles will not be accepted.

On average, it costs \$52 to collect, process, and ship each bicycle and sewing machine. A donation toward shipping costs is necessary for P4P's continued success and a minimum \$20 donation is suggested per bike and/or machine. All monetary donations (cash or check) and material donations are fully tax deductible, and a

receipt will be provided on site on June 6th. Monetary donations can also be made directly via [p4p.org](http://p4p.org).

To date, Pedals for Progress has shipped over 172,000 bicycles and 7,200 sewing machines to partner agencies in Central America, Africa, and Eastern Europe.

Additionally, Pratima joined the club and took the lead in forming a women's cricket team in New Providence, recognizing the need for inclusivity and equal opportunities for female cricket enthusiasts.

As Helen, 48, walked down the aisle in a fitted dress with a tastefully exposed back, heads turned. Conversations paused. By the time the reception was underway, it was clear this mother of the bride had made an impression few would forget.

It wasn't just that she looked great. She looked strong. Defined. Confident. Guests kept asking the same question throughout the night:

What does she do to look like that?

That question is how this story begins.

Each Veteran Welcome Home Kit costs approximately \$1,800 and is purchased through fundraising events, donations, and grants from the Elks National Foundation. They are given to the veteran free of charge.

Nationwide, an estimated 40,000 veterans experience homelessness on any given night. In partnership with the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs, the Elks National Veterans Service Commission has pledged to help end veteran homelessness by ensuring veterans have access to safe, stable housing.

Here in New Jersey, dozens of Veteran Welcome Home Kits have been delivered since the beginning of the year. And year round, Elks volunteers provide direct services to more than 1,000 veterans at VA facilities across the state and continue to connect with veterans and active military members in their local communities, offering assistance wherever it is needed.

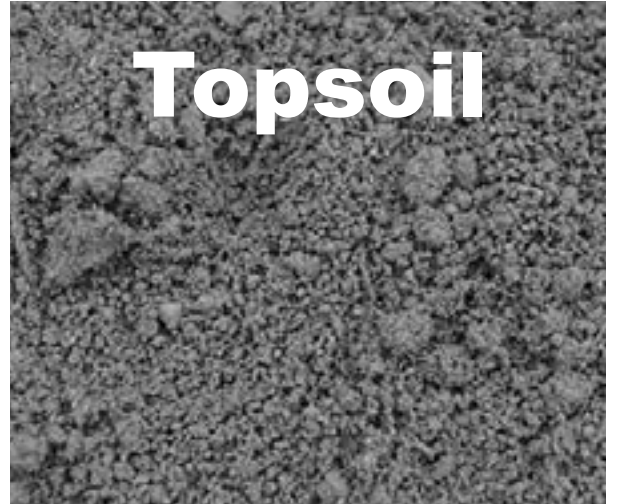

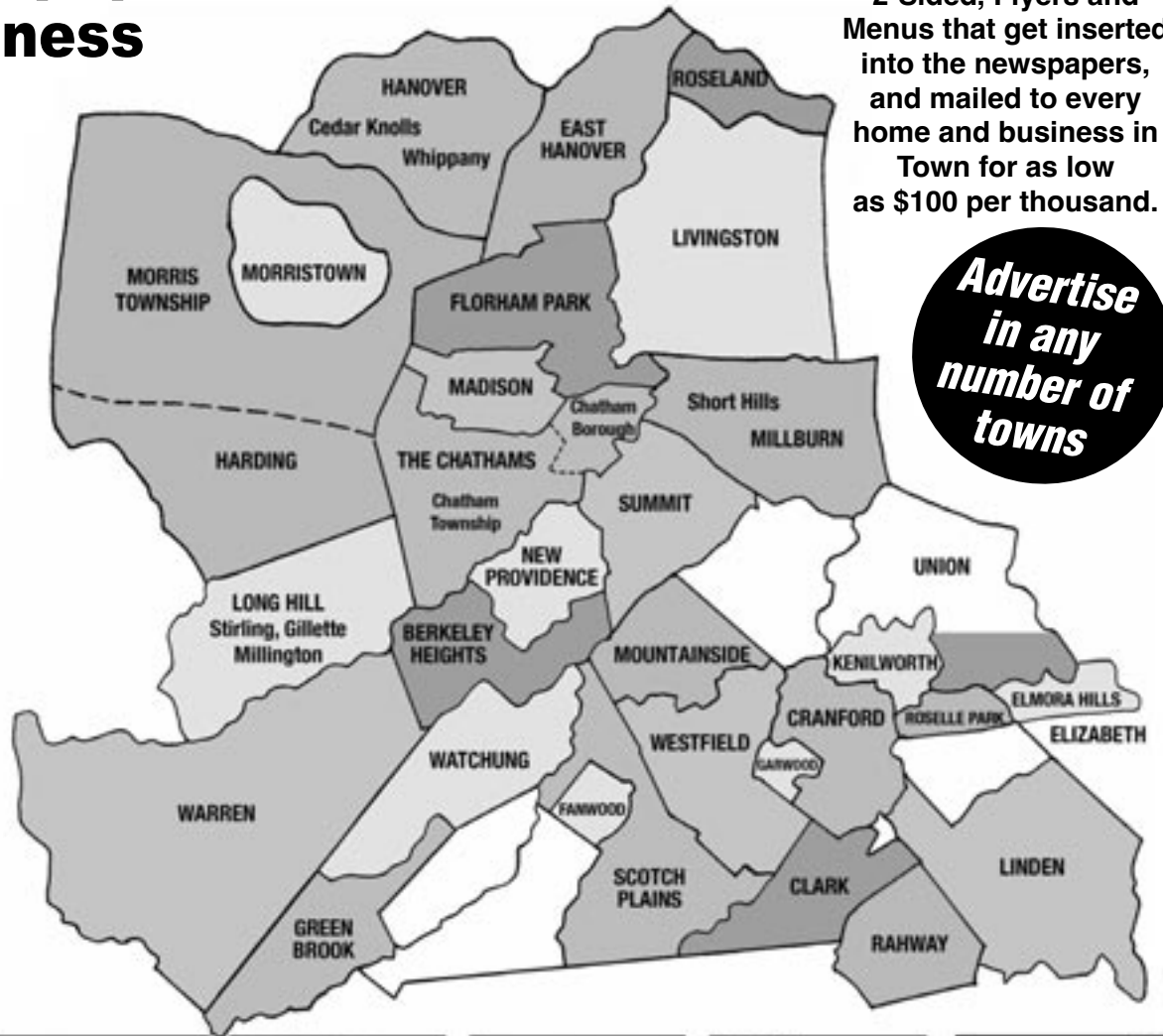

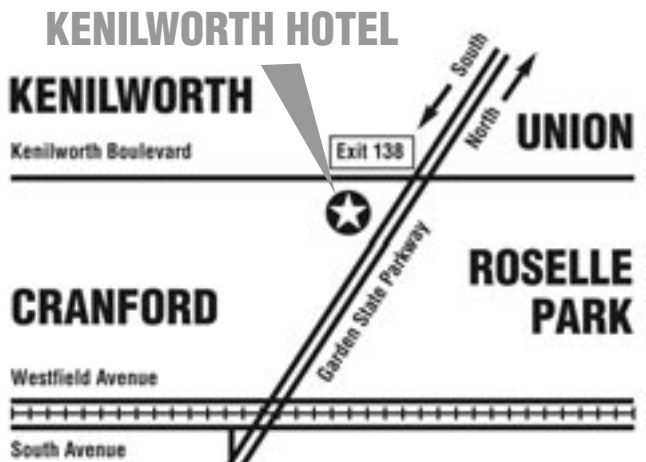
